FIRST. HE WAS A KALONDJIST.

SECOND. THE ATTACK BY VILLAGERS AND JEUNESSE TOOK PLACE AT

CHARLIE. SUBSEQUENT RECCE BY CHOPPER FOUND AN ANC PATROL AT TSHIKAPA (NOT ON MAP) APPROX 10 MILES SOUTH WEST KATENDE. STATED THEY HAD BEEN ATTACKED THERE BY JEUNNESSE, NO CASUALTIES EITHER SIDE? AND ON INSTRUCTIONS OF ADMINISTRATOR DIMELANGE BURNT VILLAGE AS PUNISHMENT. ENQUIRIES OF VILLAGERS LATER PROVED JEUNNESSE CAME FROM NORTH NOT THE VILLAGE.

DELTA. ABOUT 20 PRIMITIVELY ARMED CIVILIANS CLOSER TO KATENDE WERE SEEN HOLDING ROAD AGAINST ANC. LATER RECCE THEY HAD DISPERSED.

ECHO. DIMBELENCE. ANC NOW CONCENTRATED THERE WITH 1 PATROL ONLY OUT. AFTER COMBINING ANC AND ONU INFO RESULT IS 1 ANC DEAD, 2 MISSING. ANC COULD GIVE NO INFO ON WEAPON LOST BUT BY DEDUCTION AT LEAST 6

FOXTROT. IT WOULD APPEAR THAT ONCE FIRE IS OPENED ANC ARE UNABLE TO NOTE NUMBERS AND TYPES OF WEAPONS OF THEIR OPPONENTS.

HOTEL. TSHIKAPA. SITUATION NOW CALM BUT EVERYONE EXPECT FIGHTING TO BREAK OUT WHEN UN TROOPS LEAVE IN NEXT FEW DAYS. FURTHER BELIEF THAT IF FIGHTING STARTS IN TSHIKAPA THERE WILL BE OUTBREAKS OF FIGHTING AT MANY POINTS ON LULUABOURG/ UNITE KASAI BORDER. (GENERALLY CONSIDERED TROUBLE LARGELY DUE TO INEPTITUDE OF CENTRAL GOVT OVER FAILURE TO CLARIFY THESE BOUNDARIES)

BACK CHIEF MIL INFO FROM PACKHAM.

LULU PREMIER BOURGMESTRE HAS ADDRESSED A CIRCULAR TO REPRESENTATIVES OF FIRMS AND HEADS OF SERVICES IN LULU DEMANDING THEY DISMISS ANY BALUBAS EMPLOYED AND THREATENING HEAVY PUNISHMENT FOR ANY CONTRAVENTION OF THIS INSTRUCTION DISCOVERED BY A CHECK TO BE MADE FROM 2 DECEMBER. FOLLOWING SERIES OF DISCRIMINATORY MEASURES AGAINST NON LULUAS ALREADY TAKEN. DISMISSAL OF NOT LULUAS FROM POLICE, POSTAL AND OTHER SERVICES (MY SECRET 1118 DATED 15 NOV). PROHIBITION OF RESIDENCE IN LULU OF NON LULUAS ORIGINATING FROM FORMER KASAI PROV UNLESS IN POSSESSION OF TEMPORARY RESIDENCE PERMIT (MY SECRET 1120 DATED 16 NOV). I ALSO UNDERSTAND SAME CATEFORY OF PERSONS MAY NOT RENT OR BUY ANY PROPERTY IN LULU. THESE MEASURES, CLEARLY BASED ON RACIAL OR TRIBAL DISCRIMINATION, ARE LIKELY TO PROVOKE CIVIL DISTURBANCES. ACCORDINGLY

INVITING PRESIDENT LUAKABWANGA TO REQUIRE PREMIER BOURGMESTRE TO WITHDRAW THESE MEASURES, BUT HAVE LITTLE HOPE THEY WILL IN FACT BE WITHDRAWN AS THEY ARE INSPIRED BY LULU GOVT. CHIEF COMMISSIONER OF POLICE HAS INFORMED ME THAT SUPPORTERS OF INTERIOR MINISTER WAFWANA AND MUKENGE ARE PLANNING DEMONSTRATIONS AGAINST LUAKABWANGA. THOUGH NO DATE FIXED. HE ALSO SAID WAFWANA HAD ORDERED RE-ARREST OF LUBAYAS CHEF DE CABINET AND OTHERS. LUBAYA RECENTLY INFORMED ME HIS SUPPORTERS WOULD ALSO DEMONSTRATE (IN COMMUNES) AGAINST LULU GOVT ACTIONS. HE ALSO SAID LUAKABWANGA WOULD PRESS FOR REPLACEMENT OF MAJOR MENA AS ACTING COMMANDER FIRST GROUPEMENT BY COLONEL MULAMBA (APPARENTLY A LULU) NOW AT STAN. AND ALSO OF COMMANDANT OF GENDARMERIE MUNZIBA (AND MYSELF). SECRETARY OF STATE FOR INFORMATION ANDRE GENGE SAYS CENTRAL GOVT RADIO TEAM ARE APPREHENSIVE IN VIEW OF ATTITUDE OF LULU GOVT TO NON LULUAS, AND ALSO THAT LULUA PERSONNEL OF STATION ARE ADOPTING UNCOOPERATIVE ATTITUDE. HE LEAVES FOR LEO THURSDAY TO REPORT. POLITICAL SITUATION HERE IS OBVIOUSLY LIKELY TO DETERIORATE INTO DISTURBANCES UNLESS PROV GOVT ILLEGAL AND DISCRIMINATORY ACTIONS ARE SOON CURSED AND THOSE RESPONSIBLE SEEM TO BE IMMUNE TO REASON.
