THE GNUC EXPECTED MILITARY POLICE TO BE TRAINED IN CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION - THIS HAS BEEN CONFIRMED WITH GNUC HEADQUARTERS, LEOPOLDVILLE. THE NIGERIAN POLICE ASSUMED, ON BEHALF OF THE NIGERIAN ARMY SOME THREE YEARS AGO, THE DUTY OF THE INVESTIGATION BRANCH OF THE NIGERIAN MILITARY POLICE SO ;


Your Excellency,
