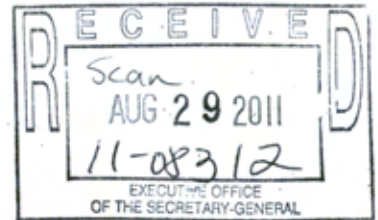

Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono, President of Indonesia, I am writing to enquire on the Secretary-General's availability to present the trophy of Global Champion for Disaster Risk Reduction to H.E. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono during the East Asian and ASEAN Summit on 19-22 November in Bali, Indonesia.

As you will recall, as part of the Global Platform ceremony, the Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Disaster Risk Reduction (SRSG), Margareta Wahlstrom, handed a Letter of Commendation to the President via his Envoy to the Global Platform Syamsul Maarif, Chief of the Indonesian National Disaster Management Agency. The Government of Indonesia has now expressed the desire for the UN Secretary-General to hand over the trophy to H.E. Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono in person. The ASEAN Summit on 21-22 November 2011 in Bali represents the first real opportunity to physically present the trophy of the Global Champion to the President.
3. The Government of Indonesia also plans, during the handover of the trophy, for the President to hand a book about his involvement in disaster management and climate change to the UN Secretary-General as a symbolic gesture of Indonesia's achievements in disaster risk reduction.

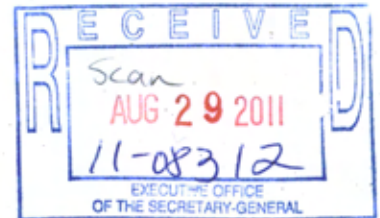

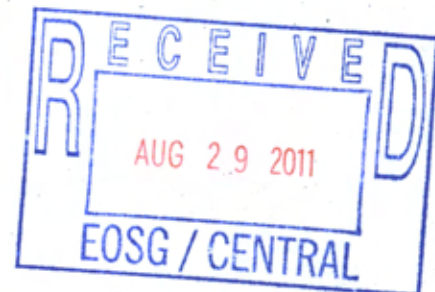
