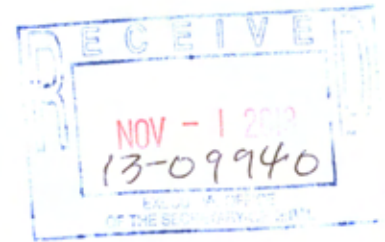

✓ The Permanent Representatives of Rwanda and The Netherlands would like to invite you to speak at a lunch meeting of the Group of Friends of the Responsibility to Protect on Friday 22 November, from 1:00-3:00PM, at the Netherlands Permanent Mission.

We would greatly appreciate it if you could give the Group an overview of the Internal Review Panel and the status of implementation of your Plan of Action: "Rights Upfront: A Plan of Action to strengthen the UN's role in protecting people in crises - Follow-up to the report of the Secretary-General's Internal Review Panel on UN Action in Sri Lanka". Also, we would like to ask you to share the steps the EOSG has taken and plans to take to mainstream R2P across the UN Secretariat.

The Special Adviser for R2P, Jennifer Welsh, will also participate. She will be invited to respond to your presentation, after which there will be time for an open discussion with all participants.

The Group of Friends of R2P consists of over 40 countries from the Global South and North and meets regularly to discuss and advance the principle of R2P. Representatives of several NGO's and the Joint Office for Genocide Prevention and R2P also attend the meetings.
