UNQUOTE WAS INSTITUTED BY AN ORDINANCE OF THE KATANGA MINISTRY OF INTERIOR IN 1960. PREVIOUSLY THE VARIOUS UNION MINIERE INSTALLATIONS AND FACTORIES HAD SEPERATE TEAMS OF WATCHMEN AND IT WAS WITH AN OBJECT TO COORDINATE AND ORGANIZE THEIR WORK THAT THE PRESENT SETUP WAS CREATED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A EUROPEAN OFFICIAL WHO IN TURN IS RESPONSIBLE TO THE UM MANAGEMENT. (2) THE INDUSTRIAL GUARD NUMBERS 195 POLICEMEN, OF WHICH 24 WORK AT KAMBOVE 18 AT KAKANDA AND 6 AT LUENA. (3) THE GUARD COMMISSIONER IS AT PRESENT ILUNGA IDESPALD WHO IS RESPONSIBLE TO MR WILLIAM STOCK, SINCE 3 MONTHS THE EUROPEAN SUPERVISOR OF THE GUARD. THE COMMISSIONER HAS UNDER HIM 20 SECTION LEADERS (CHERS D'EQUIPE). (4) THE INDUSTRIAL GUARD CARRY A GREY GREEN UNIFORM BUT WEAR A GREEN BERET. THE SECTION LEADERS HAVE THE SAME UNIFORM BUT WEAR A CAP. ON THE RIGHT ARM THEY CARRY A WHITE BADGE WITH THE INITIALS UMHKM (5) SINCE THE ANC RAID ON THE GUARD ARSENAL ON 24 APRIL IT NO LONGER POSSESSES ANY ARMS. FORMERLY THESE ARMS WERE ONLY ISSUED TO THE GUARDS IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS AND WERE ORDINARILY KEPT UNDER LOCK AND KEY. ON DUTY THE GUARDS PATROL WITH A BLUDGEON AND WITH HANDCUFFS. (6) THE DUTIES OF INDUSTRIAL GUARDS ARE TO PATROL THE INSTALLATIONS OF THE UM. THEY ALSO PATROL THE RESIDENTIAL QUARTERS

OF THE EUROPEAN STAFF TO PREVENT THEFT. IN THE EVENT OF BRAWLS OR QUARRELS IN THE RESIDENTIAL AREAS OF THE CONGOLESE WORKERS, THE GUARDS ARE SOMETIMES CALLED UPON TO INTERVENE. 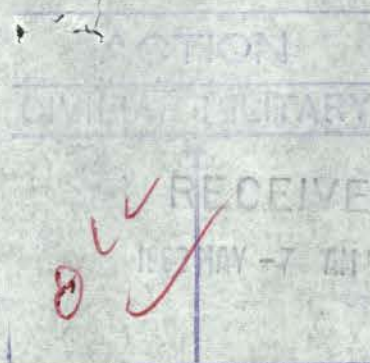

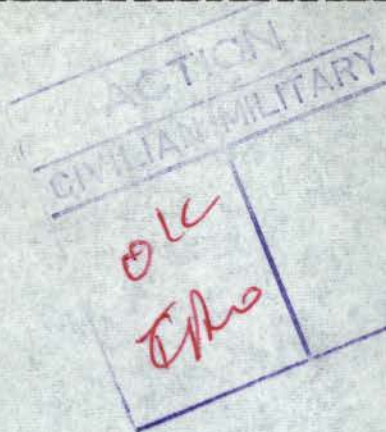
