Attention is invited to the Project 01-07 under which the following provision has been made:-

(a) Daily allowance for 3 instructors	7,500
(b) Travel of 3 instructors	2,500
(c) Congolese secretary	680
(d) Travel of students	500
(e) Teaching material	500
(f) Board and lodging of 25 students	14,000
(g) Unforeseen contingencies	320
Total	26,000

2. I am afraid the item (d) will have to be stepped up due to ONUC air services having been replaced by Air-Congo.

3. I will be grateful if the imprest account which stands in the name of Mr. M. Dupuy is transferred to the name of Mr. R.A.B. Jeannin with effect from August 7, 1963.

A sum of 35,000 Congolese francs is to be placed at the disposal of Mr. Jeannin each month. This would cover students allocation 25,000 frs and incidentals 10,000 francs.

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4. The Finance may please be also informed that the names of the 3 instructors are:

Mr. M. Serrain  
Mr. G. Josset  
Mr. J. Dubois.

They should be permitted to draw their mission subsistence allowance at the rate of 19.5 dollars a day for the first 60 days, and 17.5 dollars a day for the rest of their stay. Of these, Mr. Josset is not married.

\$5 million grant (account 197)

1. Please refer to the attached correspondence from the Chief, FAC Mission and the proforma invoice concerning the training programme of Congolese workers on a rubber plantation at Mantantale Lac Léopold II.
2. You will know that CF 800,000 have been set aside for agricultural projects, deducted from the remaining balance of the \$5 million grant, for which the approval of the U. S. Government has been obtained. (ref. letter of American Ambassador to Chief, Civilian Operations dated 29 May 1962).
3. Under these circumstances I should be grateful if you would advance the amount CF 115,000 to Foresoon, account No. 901. 182 at the Banque du Congo, Léopoldville which subsequently will be justified in detail.
4. You will notice that the project submission and the proforma invoice have been countersigned by the Secretary General of the Ministry of Agriculture according to the established procedure.
5. An early attention to this matter would be highly appreciated.

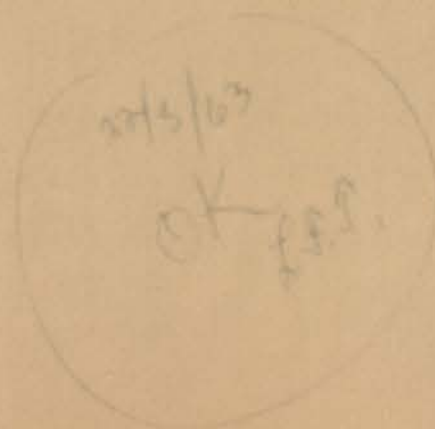

PROJET NO.7 - 1963 - ENTRAINEMENT DE TECHNICIENS POUR  
UNE PLANTATION D'HEVEAS.

A Mantantale (Territoire d'Oshwé), une plantation d'hévéa fut établie sous l'Administration Belge et les travailleurs recrutés par l'imposition. La superficie en est de 185 hectares. La plantation est vieille de 17 à 20 ans et les arbres prêts pour la saignée. La saignée des arbres a déjà été commencée par un personnel non entraîné.

2. Avant d'entreprendre la saignée des arbres et l'usinage du caoutchouc, il est nécessaire de recruter et d'entraîner de jeunes travailleurs des trois villages environnants (Balinga, Bokwa et Mantantale).

3. Des arrangements ont été faits pour l'entraînement de jeunes techniciens congolais, avec la FORESCOM, qui possède de grandes plantations d'hévéa à Niki ainsi qu'une usine.

4. On se propose d'entraîner:

6 hommes pour 4 mois (cueillette du latex)  
1 homme pour 4 mois (séchage du latex)  
2 hommes pour 4 mois (usinage du caoutchouc)

L'entraînement de 9 hommes pour 4 mois coûtera:

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TRAINING OF MONITORS

While we have set up a training centre for an accelerated course for Agricultural Assistants in collaboration with the B.D.P.A. (vide Project No. 01-07), we have so far not undertaken the training of Monitors - the field workers. The chief reason why we have not been able to take the matter of training monitors in hand is that there is still no knowing whether the monitors will be employed by Provincial Governments after training. The Provincial Governments seem to have no funds for the employment of monitors.

2. It is proposed to set up one pilot centre for the training of monitors at MIKONDO. It is at Mikondo that we have the Poultry Centre. We have at this campus large grounds, a vegetable garden, and a number of wooden houses for accommodating the students. In the first instance, it is proposed to set up a course for 30 monitors only. No catering for food will be undertaken. The course will cover a period of 3 months.
