Recently, we were informed that you may have such tankers.

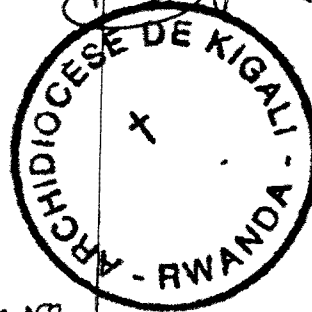

1. To HAC arrives a frequent and solid lot of requests regarding health and sanitation of local population, vulnerable groups, orphans and children especially.
2. These requests are for medical attention, supply of medicines (mefloquine especially) and transport of patients (ambulance).
3. The supply of water and electricity, essentials for obvious reason in the health centres over all the country are a big problem to solve.
4. The prevention of malaria through mosquito netting was done in sporadic and insufficient cases.
5. HAC acting under restrictions, can afford very few of the necessary efforts to improve the sanitation and health of the population.
6. Request. We request from UNAMIR Medical Branch through DCOS Support, an assessment about the best way of answering the requests in order to bring an adequate humanitarian support, procedures to follow and capacities that we have in that sensitive matter.

REFERENCE: Milob team visits to health centers.

1. Milob teams have visited several health centers in this Prefecture on many occasions and have found that some of them are consistently short of blankets and sheets. These small health centers have attempted to request additional blankets and sheets through their own support systems for several months without success. Two of these many locations are in particularly desperate need.

2. The following blankets and sheets are requested from UNAMIR resources:

- a. 50 x blankets and 100 x sheets for Karengera health center (134511).
- b. 50 x blankets and 100 x sheets for Murunda health center (3088).

3. Karengera does not have any NGO support at this time and Murunda was sponsored by MEMISA however they stopped providing support as a result of an increased mine threat in this area. It is requested that the above mentioned blankets and sheets be delivered to Milobs Kibuye so that milob patrols can deliver them to the health centers during our patrols.

4. If UNAMIR could provide these supplies it would provide excellent support to our citizens and secondly improve our credibility in supporting our new mandate and improve our relations in this prefecture.



2. I went to the orphanage and saw the tanks on 26 Sep 95. These are at the moment open, and are something like a trap that could kill the children if they fall in it. The problem may be obviated by construction of a top to cover it. I would like to request for a recce by the Force Engineers and if possible subsequently construct such a protective cover ASAP, regarding the current danger for children's life.



2. We agree that it is a high risk for the security of the children, but we think that emptying the tanks will not be a solution since with the rain it could be filled again. Also even if they are empty they could still be dangerous for children.

3. We think that the solution is to cover the tanks with an appropriate top to avoid accidents. We have asked the assistance of our Engineers to go as soon as possible to attend the request and if possible, to construct the above mentioned cover. In the mean time I hope you will do the best to avoid the presence of children near the tanks.

An alternative course of action may be the utilization of some of the funds given by the UK Government and UNREO (US\$80,000) to hire the services from an outside firm.



Parents Association has been formed in 1981 and has its headquarter at Gitwe, in the commune of Murama - Gitarama. It is non governmental association which has as objectives:

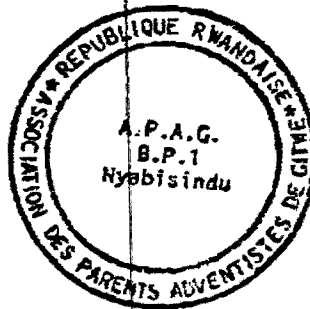
- 1° To promote of education in primary , secondary and high schools.
- 2° To participate with local population to improve the living condition in establishing a health center and hospital in rural area.

As well as there are few places in the public secondary schools in comparafison with the big number of children who finish the primary school, the parents initiated the project of having a private secondary school which offers diplomas recognised by the government . The school has three branches:

- 1° Nursing school
- 2° Pedagogy
- 3° Scientific: Maths and Physics.

As well as nursing school needs to practice in the Hospital, the Parents association (APAG) initiated an application rural hospital which is needed in this region of five communes inhabited by 250 000 people (Murama, MASANGO, Kigoma, Mukingi and Tambwe).

There is no hospital near in these Communes. The patients who are transferred to hospital by health centers have to do a long distance to reach the hospital and many of them are not able to attend it : there are some who make 45 km to reach the nearest hospital.

The population of these communes suffer from different diseases as well as : Malaria, respiratory pathology as pneumonia, bronchitis, gastritis, gastro-enteritis malnutrition, worms, Rheumatism, some of them need surgical treatment.

This hospital will be of great help for this poor population. It is going to be the hospital center of the region and all the health center in these communes will have the nearer hospital to which they are going to ^{send} patients who need specialized treatment or surgical treatment as well as it is in government schedule in Gitarama prefecture. The government promised to send a doctor paid by the government to this hospital. *The APAG has already 2 Doctor paid by APAG*

The operating budget in the first two years is going to be around \$ 5000.

Unfortunately during the war every medical and surgical equipment has been taken, nothing left, even the window glasses.

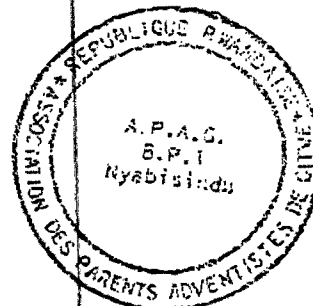
