COUNCIL OF MINISTERS MET IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION YESTERDAY UNDER CHAIRMANSHIP OF PM ADOULA AND MADE FOLLOWING DECISIONS: ONE, TO LIFT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE QUOTE ALL ADMINISTRATIVE MEASURES TAKEN AGAINST CITIZENS FOR POLITICAL OFFENCES; UNQUOTE; TWO, TO RAFFIRE, IN INTEREST OF NATIONAL UNITY, GOVT'S DESIRE TO COOPERATE WITH ALL INSTITUTIONS AND CALL UPON ALL POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS TO COOPERATE WITH GOVT; THREE, TO PAY THE ARREARS IN TEACHERS' SALARIES DURING THE MONTH OF DECEMBER. NO DETAILS HAVE BEEN GIVEN.

BBB. MR GARDINER HAS SUBMITTED TO SECGEN REPORT ON EFFORTS MADE BY ONUC WITH CENTRAL GOVT AND KATANGA AUTHORITIES FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF U THANT PLAN. REPORT DEPICTS MR TSHOMBE AS REPEATEDLY BALKING AT KEY PROVISIONS OF THE PLAN, DESPITE HIS FORMAL ACCEPTANCE OF IT IN SEPTEMBER.

CCC. BRIGADIER RIKHYE IS FLYING TO CONGO TODAY AND WILL LATER GO ON TO NEW DELHI.

1. Further to our cable Kinleo 511, I am attaching a copy of Proces-Verbal with regards to the above-mentioned.

2. I have taken the action of keeping him under ONUC protection as he is a government official of the Province of Lomami.

3. At the moment Mr. Synphorien is wanted by the local authorities for trial. This trial would take place in Kalima. I doubt if Mr. Synphorien would survive it.

4. As he requests further transportation to Leopoldville, please advise as what action we should take.

Q.- Quand, comment et pourquoi êtes-vous venu à Kindu ?

R.- Nous avons quitté Kabinda le 10 Novembre 1962 dans un véhicule ONUC No. 8024.

Q.- Qui vous a donné ce véhicule et sur la demande de qui ?

R.- La Cotonco de Kabinda sur la demande du Président du Gouvernement Provincial de la Lomami, Mr. MANONO Dominique.

Q.- Dans quel but a-t-il demandé ce véhicule et pour combien de jours ?
