1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS CALM ALTHOUGH FEAR AND APPREHENSION OF INSECURITY PREVAILS AMONG THE LOCALS IN THE PREFECTURE AS BEFORE.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES

A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED RUTSIRO COMMUNE YESTERDAY AND VISITED BWIZA SECTOR GR (3693) IN COMPANY OF BURGOMASTER OF RUTSIRO COMMUNE AND A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL HABILITATION . THE SITUATION IS CALM . THE TEAM SAW THE AREAS WHERE 700 REFUGEES WHO ARE STRANDED AT RUTSIRO COMMUNE CENTRE WILL BE RESETTLED . THE REFUGEES WILL BE RESETTLED IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS :

1. FIRST SITE : GR (3794 ) AND (3795) .

2. SECOND SITE : GR (3494) AND (3495) .

B. THE SECOND MILOB TEAM PATROLLED NGOMA GR (4170) AND GITWA (4071) IN MABANZA COMMUNE , THE SITUATION IS REPORTED CALM . LOCALS IN THE TWO SECTORS TOLD THE MILOB TEAM THAT LOCALS ARE BEING HARASSED AND ARRESTED FREQUENTLY . THE LOCALS FURTHER TOLD THE TEAM THAT NINE PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED IN THE MONTH OF JUNE NAMELY , MUNYANHONGORE , BIHUTA , NTIBAZIGANYA , SINZABAKWIRA , HATEGEKIMANA NSEKERABANZI , KAKUZE AND MUKURALINDA . THE ARRESTED LOCALS ARE ACCUSED OF PARTICIPATION IN LAST YEAR'S GENOCIDE , THEY CURRENTLY DETAINED AT MABANZA PRISON .

C. THE THIRD MILOB TEAM VISITED MUTUNTU HOSPITAL GR (3653) AND MUSANGO PRIMARY SCHOOL GR (3760) IN MWENDO COMMUNE . THE TEAM TOLD THAT THE HOSPITAL IS RUN BY CARITY SISTERS ( FROM FRANCE) AND SPONSORED BY CARITAS . THE HOSPITAL IS FUNCTIONING PERFECTLY ,HOWEVER THE FOLLOWING DISEASES ARE MOST PREVALENT IN THE AREA , MALARIA , DISENTRY AND TOO MANY LUNG DISEASES . THE SAME ORGANISATION IS RUNNING A DISPENSARY AT MUSANGO GR (3760) TWO TIMES A WEEK . THE SCHOOL AUTHORITIES TOLD THE TEAM THAT THE SCHOOL HAS NO QUALIFIED TEACHERS AND LACK OF TEACHING MATERIALS .

D.THE HUMANITARIAN TEAM COORDINATED WITH MALAWI COY AND SENT A TRUCK TO L'ESPERANCE ORPHANAGE AT NGOMA GR (2158) TO COLLECT FIREWOOD AND CARRYING TIMBER FROM GISOVU SAWMILL .

E. THE SUB SECTOR COMD ATTENDED SECTOR COMD'S CONF IN BUTARE TODAY .

A. RPA. IT IS REPORTED THAT THE PLATOON WHICH WAS DEPLOYED IN RUSTIRO (3083) HAS BEEN MOOVED TO KAYOVE (2729).

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. GITARAMA TEAM

i) THERE WAS SOME SHOOTING IN GITARAMA PRISON DURING THE NIGHT 28/29 JUNE AT ABOUT 0100 HRS. A MILOB AND HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO THE PRISON THIS MORNING TO INVESTIGATE THIS INCIDENT. THE TEAM WAS TOLD BY THE SENIOR PRISON WARDENER THAT, SOME INMATES WANTED TO ESCAPE AS A RESULT 4 INMATES WERE SHOT DEAD AND THREE WERE WOUNDED. AMONG THE THREE, ONE WAS SERIOUSLY INJURED AND HE WAS TRANSPORTED TO KABGAYI MSF HOSPITAL. THE OTHER TWO ARE BEING TREATED IN THE PRISON DISPENSARY.

ii) ONE TEAM WENT TO MUSAMBIRA (8274) AND TABA ( 8883) COMMUNES AND REPORTED THAT, THERE IS A NATIONAL REGISTRATION THAT IS TAKING PLACE IN THE TWO COMMUNES. THE TEAM WAS BRIEFED BY BOTH BOURGMESTRES THAT THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION AND CERTIFICATE IS BEING ISSUED TO PERSONS WHO ARE 16 YEARS AND ABOVE. THESE PEOPLE ARE PAYING 600 FRANCS IN ORDER FOR THEM TO BE ISSUED WITH THE CERTIFICATE. THE TEAM COULD NOT GET ANY FIGURES FOR BOTH THE ORPHANS AND WIDOWS BECAUSE THE BOURGMESTRES DID NOT HAVE THEM HAND BUT PROMISED TO GIVE THE REQUIRED DETAILS IN 3 WEEKS TIME.

iii) ONE TEAM WENT TO MUSHUBATI COMMUNE (6970) AND VISITED NYARUSANGE SECTOR (6489). THE TEAM ESTABLISHED THAT, THERE ARE 1160 WIDOWS AND 2010 ORPHANS WHO ARE LIVING IN THE COMMUNE. THESE PEOPLE ARE NOT LIVING AT A CENTRAL POINT BUT

THEY ARE LIVING WITH THEIR RELATIVES IN THE COMMUNE. THE TEAM MANAGED TO SPEAK WITH SOME OF THE WIDOWS WHO TOLD THEM THAT, SOME OF THEM ARE STAYING IN GROUPS OF FOURS IN THE HOUSES OF THOSE WHO ARE BELIEVED TO BE IN ZAIRE. THESE WIDOWS AND ORPHANS LAST RECEIVED FOOD AND BLANKETS FROM CRS AND CARITAS IN APRIL 95. THE BOURGMESTRE CONFIRMED THIS, AND FURTHER REQUESTED FOR ASSISTANCE IN FORM OF FOOD, CLOTHING, BLANKETS, SOAP AND COOKING UTENSILS.



SUBJECT: SITREP COVERING PERIOD 281800 TO 291800 JUN 95.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION IS CALM ALTHOUGH FEAR AND APPREHENSION OF INSECURITY PREVAILS AMONG THE LOCALS IN THE PREFECTURE AS BEFORE.

2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES NTR

A. RPA. CONTINUING WITH FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS IN THE PREFECTURE.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES

A. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED MUBUGA GR (2463) IN GISHYTA COMMUNE. THE TEAM MET BOUGOMEISTER WHO TOLD THEM THAT 699 REFUGEES HAVE SO FAR RETURNED TO THE COMMUNE FROM THE MONTH OF MARCH TO DATE. HE FURTHER SAID THAT SOME OF THE RETURNEES HAVE BEEN ALLOCATED EMPTY HOUSES AND OTHERS ARE COHABITING WITH THEIR RELATIVES. THE RETURNEES ARE FACED WITH THE PROBLEM OF FOOD, SEEDS, CLOTHING AND FARMING TOOLS. THE MILOB REPORTED THAT THE BURGOMASTER WAS VERY EVASIVE TO QUESTIONS AND UNCOOPERATIVE. THE MILOB TEAM PROCEEDED TO MARA GR (2068) AND ON THEIR WAY STOPPED AT KARORA GR (2166) TO TALK TO LOCALS. THE LOCALS TOLD THE TEAM THAT PEOPLE HAVE STOPPED COMING FROM ZAIRE BECAUSE RPA TAKE THEM AWAY WHEN THEY COME BACK. AT THIS JUNCTURE BURGOMASTER CAME AND CONFRONTED THE MILOB TEAM AND TOLD THAT THE NEW MANDATE DOESN'T ALLOW MILOBS TO PATROL IN HIS AREA WITHOUT HIS PERMISSION. AFTER A LENGTH DISCUSSION WITH HIM, THE MILOB TEAM CAME BACK WITHOUT REACHING ITS FINAL DESTINATION. THE SUB SECTOR COMD IN COMPANY OF THE SOUS PREFECT DROVE TO MUBUGA TO VERIFY THE BURGOMASTER'S STATEMENT ABOUT THE NEW MANDATE. THEY DECIDED TO RESOLVE THE ISSUE WHEN THE PREFECT WHO WAS OUT IS BACK IN THE OFFICE.

B. THE SECOND MILOB TEAM WHICH WAS PROCEEDING TO ROBOREZA GR (1158) IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE WAS STOPPED BY RPA AT A CHECK POINT AT NGOMA GR (2159) AND WAS DENIED ACCESS TO PASS. AFTER A LENGTH DISCUSSION WITH RPA COMD, EFFORTS TO SECURE PASSAGE PROVED FUTILE. THIS IS THE SECOND TIME A MILOB TEAM HAS BEEN DENIED PASSAGE AT THIS RPA CHECK POINT.

C. THIRD MILOB TEAM CONDUCTED A HELI PATROL TO CYANAZA GR (5464) TO CONFIRM ANY BANDITRY ACTIVITIES IN THE AREA. THE MILOB TEAM SPOKE TO THE LOCALS WHO TOLD THEM THAT RPA USUALLY COME IN THE NIGHT AND GRAB COWS AND PROPERTY. THEY FURTHER TOLD THE TEAM THAT ONE PERSON NAMED FRANCIS WAS ARRESTED FOR STEALING COWS AND IS CURRENTLY IN BWAKIRA PRISON. THE TEAM THEN FLEW TO MUREHE GR (5668) WHERE LOCALS TOLD THEM THAT THERE ARE PEOPLE WHO ARE STEALING CATTLE AND ARE OPERATING ALONG NYABARONGO. THE LOCALS ALSO TOLD THE TEAM THAT THERE IS AN OUT BREAK OF EYE DISEASE AND DISENTRY IN THE AREA.

D. THE RPA BN COMD WAS CONTACTED TO VERIFY WHY THE MILOB TEAM PROCEEDING TO RWAMATAMU HAD BEEN DENIED PASSAGE BY RPA SOLDIERS AT NGOMA CHECK POINT. HE WAS VERY EVASIVE TO THIS DEMAND AND ISSUED A LETTER AUTHORIZING PASSAGE TO MILOB TEAMS, HE WAS REPORTED BUSY ATTENDING A MEETING. THE SUB SECTOR COMD HAS SORT A MEETING WITH RPA BN COMD AND THE PREFECT TO IRON OUT THESE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS AFFECTING OUR SMOOTH OPERATIONS IN THE PREFECTURE.

E. FOURTH MILOB TEAM WHICH WENT TO BWIZA IN COMPANY OF BURGOMASTER OF RUTSIRO COMMUNE TO VISIT WHERE THE REPORTED REFUGEES STRANDED AT RUTSIRO COMMUNE CENTRE WILL BE RESETTLED, IS STILL OUT.

REFERENCE : SECURITY MEETING AT KIBUYE PREFECTURE 19 JUN 95

1. At my request, following the theft of the SWISS DISASTER RELIEF FUND vehicle on night 17/18 june 95, reference meeting took place at 1630 hrs. This meeting was presided by M. le Préfect, and attended by myself, my Ops O and OC MALAWI COY. The other members of this meeting were the individuals responsible for the security of this prefecture:

- a. The Prefecture Security Chief;
- b. The RPA Bn Secur O; and
- c. The Head of the local Gendarmerie.

2. During this meeting, I asked that the local authorities take measures to provide a secure atmosphere in KIBUYE both for UNAMIR and international members of aid agencies .

3. M. le Préfect was pleased that such a meeting took place and at it's conclusion the following measures were instituted:

- a. RPA patrols in the city of KIBUYE will be increased and reenforced;
- b. RPA checkpoints in the prefecture will be increased and reenforced;
- c. All persons will limit their movements past midnight to only those for reasons of duty;
- d. As soon as a security incident occurs, the above mentioned security officers are to be contacted soonest; and
- e. A security meeting presided by M. le Préfect will take place once each month.

4. I welcome your comments, if any, on this matter.



SUBJECT : ROBBERY INCIDENTS OF UNAMIR'S CARS (1044, 1004) IN  
GITARAMA SECTOR

1. As was discussed yesterday afternoon, I am to inform you, and to purpose some measures to be taken in prevention of incidents like those happened in the Sector.
2. All evidences shows that the robbery was done by RPA developing a banditry action, as follow :
  - a. Not any RPA high rank officers nor liaison officer were at home when requested because of the incident (like the last one before).
  - b. All check points were open for us when in a normal behavior we are always stopped, no strings were at the check points.
  - c. The soldiers of RPA were around that evening in an unusual number, it was totally impossible to act like was done by other people than themselves.
3. A complete investigation by Military Police is carried out and we, as sector are expecting its results.
4. Regarding measures to prevent incidents :
  - a. All vehicles movements outside of HQ has to be done with armed escort even during light hours.
  - b. Is strongly recommended the installation in all UNAMIR cars, of commercially available security devices that works stopping the influx of fuel or electricity and consequently the engines a couple of meters after the car was stolen.
5. Scheme of patrols including additional patrolling by Mali Coy was changed, to show presence in Gitarama urban zone since yesterday until Monday.
