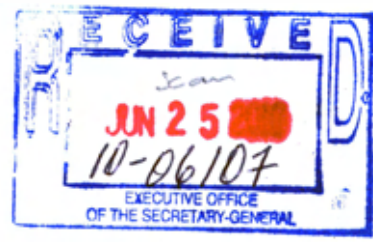

### *Verbal Message*

- *“I trust that you are following the recent Israeli actions in Jerusalem including steps taken towards demolishing 22 Palestinian houses in the “Alsilwan” neighborhood.*
  - *Egypt is concerned over these actions. We are beyond calling them unlawful and inconsistent with peace efforts. They are provocative and seriously undermine any trust of the Palestinian and Arab publics in such efforts.*
  - *Israel, through these actions, makes it increasingly difficult for any party to believe in its will for achieving peace. On the contrary, such actions can not be perceived but as clear evidence to the absence of such will.*
  - *I urge you, in view of your special responsibility, to intervene in this regard and stop such actions from taking place as soon as possible. We stand ready to assist if needed”.*
