4. **HUMANITARIAN AFFAIRS**

a. KIVUYE COMMUNE. AMREF AND CARITAS ARE THE ONLY NGOS STILL OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE. AMREF RUNS THE COMMUNE HEALTH CENTRE. IT HAS COMPLETED TRAINING FIVE LOCAL NURSES WHO NOW MAN THE CENTRE. SIX PATIENTS WERE FOUND ON ADMISSION. COMMON DISEASES TREATED HERE INCLUDE MALARIA, DIARRHOEA AND BRONCHITIS. THE BOURGREMESTRE HELD A MEETING WITH AMREF OFFICIALS TODAY. DETAILS OF THE MEETING ARE UNKNOWN. CARITAS DISTRIBUTES HIGH PROTEIN FOOD TO MALNOURISHED CHILDREN AND FARMING IMPLEMENTS TO FARMERS.

b. CYUMBA COMMUNE. AMREF SPONSORS THE CYUMBA HEALTH CENTRE AND HAS NINE NURSES, THREE OF WHOM ARE QUALIFIED. THREE PATIENTS ON ADMISSION WERE VISITED BY MILOB PATROL. COMMON DISEASES HERE ARE MALARIA, BRONCHITIS, PNEUMONIA, KWASHIORKOR AND RHEUMATISM.

c. BWISIGE COMMUNE. THREE NGOS, CARITAS, WORLD VISION AND REMANIE PALANTINA, OPERATE IN THIS COMMUNE. CARITAS DISTRIBUTES SEEDS AND AGRICULTURAL TOOLS TO THE LOCALS. WORLD VISION RUNS THE BWISIGE HEALTH CENTRE AND PROVIDES DRUGS WHILST PALANTINA GIVES TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE NYAGAHANGA SECONDARY SCHOOL.

d. BUYOGA COMMUNE. MILOB PATROL CONVEYED ELECTROGAS WORKERS TO THE BUYOGA COMMUNE TO INSPECT ELECTIRC POLES AND LINES IN ORDER TO RECTIFY FAULTS. THIS ASSISTANCE WILL CONTINUE FOR THE NEXT THREE DAYS.

5. **CIVILIAN AFFAIRS**

a. WATER PUMP. THE WATER PUMP SERVING THE BWISIGE COMMUNE HAS BROKEN DOWN. NIBATT ENGRS INSPECTED THE ENGINE BUT COULD DO NOTHING ABOUT IT.


b. RETURNEES. EIGHT (08) RETURNEES WITH 78 COWS FROM UGANDA CROSSED THE BORDER TO GATSIBO IN BUTARO COMMUNE OF SECTOR 5. THE RPA IN THAT LOCATION GAVE THEM PASS TO GO TO NYAGATARE THROUGH KIVUYE AND MUKARANGE TODAY.

6. MISC.

a. WITHDRAWAL OF OUTPOST PERSONNEL. NIBATT PULLS OUT FROM NGARAMA AND NYAGATARE TOMORROW. DUE TO THE SHORT NOTICE AND LACK OF IMMEDIATE ALTERNATE ACCOMMODATION, THE TWO MILOB PATROL TEAMS LOCATED IN THESE TWO TOWNS WILL BE WITHDRAWN TOMORROW FOR PROPER ARRANGEMENTS TO BE MADE FOR LIVING AND OFFICE ACCOMMODATION IN NYAGATARE.

a. KIVUYE COMMUNE. AMREF AND CARITAS ARE THE ONLY NGOS STILL OPERATING IN THE COMMUNE. AMREF RUNS THE COMMUNE HEALTH CENTRE. IT HAS COMPLETED TRAINING FIVE LOCAL NURSES WHO NOW MAN THE CENTRE. SIX PATIENTS WERE FOUND ON ADMISSION. COMMON DISEASES TREATED HERE INCLUDE MALARIA, DIARRHOEA AND BRONCHITIS. THE BOURGREMESTRE HELD A MEETING WITH AMREF OFFICIALS TODAY. 4. **HUMANITARIAN AFFAIRS**

a. KINYAMI COMMUNE. WORLD VISION SUPPLIES DRUGS TO MUNYINYA HEALTH CENTRE (GR 1520) AND GISIZA HEALTH CENTRE (GR 1322).

b. RUTONGO COMMUNE. GTZ REMAINS THE ONLY NGO ASSISTING THIS COMMUNE. MOST OF THE COMMUNE OFFICE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECTS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED. IT HAS NOW STARTED ORGANIZING INFORMAL AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION FOR THE LOCALS.

c. NGARAMA COMMUNE. MILOB PATROL AT NGARAMA TODAY ASSISTED ACCORD IN DISTRIBUTING AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS TO THAT COMMUNE. A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION CALLED METHODIST LIBERTY HAS BEGUN CONSTRUCTION OF A CHURCH COMPLEX AT MATIMBA. WHEN COMPLETED, IT WILL ALSO CATER FOR THE MEDICAL, AGRICULTURAL AND VETERINARY NEEDS OF THE COMMUNE. OXFAM IS DRILLING BORE HOLES IN NYABWESHONGWE (GR 4590), KAGITUMBA (GR 5093) AND MATIMBA (GR 4786). THIS PROJECT IS HOWEVER, SAID TO HAVE BEEN STOPPED BY THE PREFECT OF BYUMBA.

5. **CIVILIAN AFFAIRS**

a. MARRIAGES. ONE MAGISTRATE, MR PAUL MBUGULIJE, TODAY REGISTERED 5 MARRIAGES IN THE RUTONGO COMMUNE.


b. LAW AND ORDER. EVENTHOUGH THERE IS A MAGISTRATE IN RUTONGO COMMUNE, THE COMMUNE COURT IS NOT FULLY FUNCTIONAL. THE MAGISTRATE JOINTLY SITS ON CASES WITH THE BOURGREMESTRE. AT PRESENT THERE ARE 72 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CELLS. THEY WERE ALL ALLEGED TO BE INVOLVED IN THE GENOCIDE. THE INCREASING NUMBER OF PRISONERS WAS THE RESULT OF THE ARRESTED MENTIONING NAMES OF OTHERS. IF THIS TREND CONTINUES, SO MANY INNOCENT PERSONS MAY BE ARRESTED.

c. IDPS. ELEVEN (11) IDPS WERE RECEIVED AT THE BYUMBA PREFECTURE FROM GIKONGORO TODAY. NIBATT PROVIDED TRUCKS TO CONVEY THEM TO THEIR VARIOUS HOME COMMUNES.

RPA CONTINUES TO CONDUCT VEH AND FOOT PATROLS IN THE AOR BOTH BY DAY AND NIGHT.

3. **OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES**

PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE FOLLOWING COMMUNES AND AREAS:

4. **HUMANITARIAN AFFAIRS**

a. **MUVUMBA COMMUNE.** THE CLINIC BEING CONSTRUCTED BY ARC AT TABAGWE HAS REACHED WINDOW LEVEL.

b. **KIBALI COMMUNE.** WORLD VISION AND PAM JOINTLY SPONSOR THE URUMULI ORPHANAGE WHICH IS CLOSE TO THE COMMUNE OFFICES. THE HOME HAS 126 CHILDREN. WORLD VISION PAYS THE SALARIES OF THE STAFF AND PROVIDES MEDICINE FOR CLINIC ATTACHED TO THE HOME. PAM SUPPLIES FOOD TO THE HOME.

c. **KIYOMBE COMMUNE.** CARITAS HAS SUPPLIED 460 CORRUGATED ROOFING SHEETS FOR THE RENOVATION OF TWO SCHOOLS : ONE EACH LOCATED AT KIYOMBE (GR 0946) AND NGABIRA (GR 1041). WORK ON THE CLASSROOMS IN KIYOMBE HAS BEEN COMPLETED. GOAL RUNS THE HEALTH CENTRE AT RUSHAKI (GR 1138). THE CHEST DEPARTMENT HELD A TB CLINIC TODAY AND TREATED 18 TB PATIENTS, 9 OF WHOM ARE CURRENTLY ON ADMISSION. AN OUTREACH TEAM FROM GOAL IRELAND, ALSO GO OUT WEEKLY TO EDUCATE THE LOCALS ON PERSONAL HYGIENE. THE CENTRE IS PRESENTLY FACING SHORTAGE OF ESSENTIAL DRUGS.

5. **CIVILIAN AFFAIRS**

a. **KIYOMBE COMMUNE.** SCHOOL TEACHERS IN THIS COMMUNE COLLECTED THEIR SALARIES FOR THE MONTHS OF APRIL AND MAY LAST WEEK AS A RESULT OF THE BOURGREMESTRE'S MEETING WITH THE FORMER. FOUR SCHOOLS RUN BY THE CATHOLIC MISSION AT NGABIRA (GR 1041), KIYOMBE (GR 0946), KIRAHURA ((GR 0738)) AND KABARE (GR 15439) HAVE BEEN SUPPLIED WITH SCHOOL UNIFORMS AND BOOKS BY CARITAS.

b. LAW AND ORDER. ONE DETAINEE CHARGED FOR DRUNKENNESS IN THE KİYOMBE COMMUNE WAS RELEASED TODAY BY THE COMMUNE AUTHORITIES WHEN MILOB PATROL INTERVENED ON HIS BEHALF.

c. SECURITY. DURING NIGHT OF 20/21 JUN 95, FIVE (5) ARMED BANDITS ATTACKED AND WOUNDED ONE MR NSENGIYUMUA, A MALE FARMER AT NKANA (GR 1345) IN THE KİYOMBE COMMUNE. THEY TOOK AWAY 12,000 FRW AND SOME PERSONAL EFFECTS. THE BANDITS ARE BELIEVED TO HAVE COME IN ACROSS THE UGANDAN BORDER.

d. KIBALI COMMUNE. THE POPULATION IN THE COMMUNE HAS RISEN FROM 41,325 TO 51,743 AS AT DATE. 399 RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE, TANZANIA AND BURUNDI AS WELL AS 8 IDPS FROM GIKONGORO CAME IN DURING THE WEEK.


6. MISC.

a. NEW UNAMIR MANDATE. REACTION FROM THE LOCALS IN THE COMMUNES VISITED WAS POSITIVE. THEY WANT UNAMIR TO STAY FOR AT LEAST TWO YEARS TO ENABLE THE COUNTRY STABILIZE. THE LOCALS CLAIM THEY FORESEE CHAOS IF UNAMIR SHOULD WITHDRAW IN DECEMBER.

b. VISITS. THE DFC/CMO PAID HIS MAIDEN VISIT TO THIS SECTOR TODAY. HE DEPARTED FROM LOCATION AT APPROXIMATELY 1600 HRS LT. MS LEILA ALI, UNAMIR ACCN OFFR, WAS ALSO HERE TODAY TO FINALISE ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE LANDLADIES OF THE NEW MILOB OFFICE ACCOMMODATION.

4. **HUMANITARIAN AFFAIRS**

a. MUGAMBAZI COMMUNE. THERE ARE THREE HEALTH CENTRES IN THE COMMUNE. THEY ARE MURAMBI (GR 0400), KIYANZA (GR 0705) AND KAJEVUBA (GR 1400). PHARMACIE SANI FRANCAISE (PSF) PROVIDES THE CENTRES WITH DRUGS. COMMON DISEASES PREVALENT IN THE COMMUNE INCLUDE; MALARIA, AMIBIOSIS, ASTHMA AND SKIN DISEASES. THESE HEALTH CENTRES GENERALLY LACK BEDS, TRANSPORT, ELECTRICITY AND WATER.

b. CYUNGO COMMUNE. AMREF OPERATES A HEALTH CENTRE AT MYOVE (GR 9622). IT SUPPLIES DRUGS AND MEDICAL EQUIPMENT TO THE CENTRE. IT IS NOW ORGANISING HEALTH AWARENESS LECTURES FOR THE LOCALS.

5. **CIVILIAN AFFAIRS**

a. MUGAMBAZI COMMUNE. A PATROL VISITED THE COMMUNE PRISON WHERE 31 PRISONERS WERE DETAINED AMONG WHOM WERE 3 WOMEN AND A CHILD. THE PRISONERS WERE ACCUSED OF VARIOUS OFFENSES INCLUDING TAKING PART IN THE GENOCIDE, POISONING AND STEALING. UNFORTUNATELY, NO JUDICIARY SYSTEM IS SET UP TO TRY THE CASES. THE PRISONERS WILL THEREFORE BE HELD IN THIS PRISON TILL THEY ARE CONVEYED TO KIGALI.

(b) GITI COMMUNE. A GERMAN NGO CALLED MALTESER HILFSDIENST SPONSORS AN OUT-PATIENT CLINIC AT GITI. IT SUPPLIES DRUGS TO THE CLINIC AND ITS QUALIFIED PHYSICIANS VISIT THE CENTRE TWICE EVERY WEEK. SERIOUS CASES ARE NORMALLY REFERRED TO RWESERO HEALTH CENTRE (GR 1901). THE CLINIC HAS A GOOD STORE OF DRUGS WITH 8 HEALTH WORKERS.

AS AT NOW, THERE ARE 800 PEOPLE IN THE TRANSIT CAMP. APPROXIMATELY 40 RETURNEES COME IN EVERY DAY. THEY ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO STAY IN THE CAMP FOR A MAXIMUM OF 4 WEEKS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THOSE WHO ARE NOT ABLE TO FIND IMMEDIATE RESETTLEMENT AREAS.

(d) NGARAMA COMMUNE. THERE ARE THREE NGOS NAMELY *ACCORD*, ADRA AND ICRC OPERATING IN THIS COMMUNE. *ACCORD* PROVIDES ROOFING MATERIALS AND GENERAL REHABILITATION OF SCHOOLS . IT ALSO PROVIDES AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS, SEEDS AND CLOTHES TO THE ORPHANS AND THE POOR. ADRA PROVIDES FOOD TO RETURNEES AND REHABILITATES ROADS. ICRC PROVIDES RECEPTION AND FOOD DISTRIBUTION TO RETURNEES.

- (i) The commune received 3,029 pieces of hoes, rakes and axes each.

 - (d) Minor Surgery.

- (iv) Acute water shortage is being faced. The commune has three water pumps but all operating engines have been stolen.

(v) 08 primary schools with 2,323 children are functioning well. However, they lack furniture, teaching aids and qualified teaching staff. Out of 32 only two are trained.


