Dear Congressman Banta:

Thank you for forwarding to us the letter you received from the Shannondale Community House in connection with the shipment of milk goats.

Unfortunately, UNRRA's entire shipping schedule was delayed by the Maritime strike last fall. The milk goats contributed by the Shannondale Community House are scheduled to be shipped to Albania on the SS Henry Dearborn. Included in the shipment will be some cattle and horses procured by UNRRA because it would have been too expensive to ship the goats by themselves.

Our latest information is that the SS Henry Dearborn will be ready to load about the 15th of January. This is a tentative date and it may be a few days later before this ship is ready to load.

Let me assure you that we deeply appreciate the contribution of the Shannondale Community House to the needy people of Europe.

Please feel free to call on us at any time that we can be of assistance.
