## 2. NTR

3.A. ONE TEAM PATROLLED AREA OF GISENYI AND BORDERPOSTS AND LIAISED WITH TUNBATT HQ.

3.B. ONE TEAM PATROLLED AREA OF RUHENGARI AND CYANIKA (GS 7152). MILOBS LIAISED WITH IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS AT BORDERPOST CYANIKA AND NGO'S IN RUHENGARI.

3.C. ONE JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM INVESTIGATED THE KILLING OF 2 YOUNG MEN ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN KILLED BY THE RPA IN CUSTODY AT THE BIGOGWE MILITARY CAMP (3520) ON THE 15 FEB 95. THE VICTIMS BELONGED TO THE GAKARARA (3921) SECTOR. THE INVESTIGATION REVEAL THAT THE 2 VICTIMS WERE KILLED WHILE IN THE CUSTODY OF THE RPA WHO STATES THAT THEY WERE SHOT IN AN ATTEMPT TO ESCAPE. HOWEVER THE WOUNDS ON THE BODY OF THE VICTIMS DOES INDICATE AND TORTURE. THE INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONTINUED.

3.D. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREA GISENYI, RUHENGARI, NYARUTOVU (7718), TARE (9109) AND SHYORONGI (9894). THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO LIAISE WITH THE NGOS ENROUTE.

3.E. ONE MILOB TEAM CONDUCTED A PARLIAMENTARIAN TEAM TO THE RESETTLEMENT AREA FOR REFUGEES IN THE MUTURA (3223) AND THE RWERERE (2722) COMMUNES. THE TEAM BRIEFED THE THE VISITORS REGARDING THE VARIOUS HUMANITARIAN ASPECTS OF THE RESETTLEMENT BEING MADE AVAILABLE TO THE RETURNEES. THE TEAM ALSO HIGHLIGHTED THE VARIOUS PROBLEMS BEING FACED BY THE RETURNEES WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO THE SECURITY PROBLEMS AND THE HUMANITARIAN ASPECTS.

3.F. THE TUNBAT HAS REPORTED THAT ONE OF THE SUSPECTS OF THE FIRING INCIDENCE HAS BEEN ARRESTED BY THEM AT ABOUT 1600 H. ONE JOINT MILOB AND HUMAN RIGHT TEAM HAS BEEN DESPATCHED TO THE TUNBAT

THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO INVESTIGATE THE KILLING OF A MAN NGENZA ALAZAR, AGE 30, WHO IS ALLEGE TO HAVE BEEN KILLED BY THE RPA ON THE 12 FEB 95 AT BATUKA. THE PATROL WAS ALSO TASKED TO INVESTIGATE A REPORT RECEIVED THAT A COUPLE HAD BEEN KILLED ON THE 7 FEB 95 IN THE SECTOR OF KABATWE BY SOME ARMED CIVILIANS WHO CAME FROM ZAIRE. THE MATTER WAS INVESTIGATED BY THE PATROL AND THE KILLING WAS CONFIRMED. THE KILLING OF THE COUPLE AT KABATWE WAS ALSO CONFIRMED. ACCORDING TO THE EYEWITNESSES THE KILLING WAS THE WORK OF THE INTERHAMWE. THE INVESTIGATION WILL BE CONTINUED WITH A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM.

3.D. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF RUHENGERRI, NYARATOVU (7718), TARE (9109) AND SHYORONGI (9894). THE TEAM LIAISED WITH THE NGOS WORKING ENROUTE.

3.E. ON MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF GISENYI, MUKAMIRA (4521), KARAGO (4516), GICEYE (5111), GASEKE (4904) AND SHYIRA (5713). THE TEAM WAS TASKED TO LIAISE WITH THE RETURNEES WHO ARE BEING SETTLED IN THESE AREAS TO CHECK THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THEY ARE LIVING AND THE REQUIREMENT OF AID TO THESE PEOPLE. THE TEAM WAS ALSO TASKED TO CHECK THE SECURITY SITUATION IN AT SHYIRA. THE PATROL REPORTS THAT THE RETURNEES ARE SUFFICIENTLY WELL TAKEN CARE OFF. HOWEVER THEY FACE A ACUTE SHORTAGE OF FOOD. THE SAME HAS BEEN COMMUNICATED TO THE UNHCR

WHO IS COORDINATING THE NGO ACTIVITY IN THE AOR.

- 3.F THE SECTOR COMD TODAY MET WITH COL WILLIAM BAGIRA, BRIGADE COMD OF THE RPA BRIGADE LOCATED AT RUHENGARI. THE MEETING WAS ARRANGED AT THE RPA CAMP AT MUKAMIRA. THE MEETING WAS A COURTESY CALL TO PAY COMPLIMENTS TO THE BRIGADE COMD AS THE SECTOR COMD HAD NOT BEEN ABLE TO MEET HIM SO FAR. IT WAS DECIDED TO MEET IN THE NEAR FUTURE TO ENSURE CLOSE COOPERATION AND ESTABLISH A GOOD WORKING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE RPA AND THE UNAMIR.
4. THE UNHCR HAS FORECASTED ORGANIZED RETURNEE MOVEMENT FROM THE MUGANGO, KIBUMBA AND THE KATALI CAMP ON THE 15, 16 AND THE 17 FEB 95. IT IS ESTIMATED ON ALL THESE THREE DAYS THERE WOULD BE NEARLY 1000 RETURNEES BEING TRANSPORTED ACROSS TO RWANDA FROM ZAIRE.

3.E. NDUNGUTSE EMMANUEL, RESIDENT OF GASEKE COMMUNE (4904), WHO SEEKED ASYLUM IN THE TUNBAT 2 COY AT NYUNDO WAS HANDED OVER TO THE OFFICE OF THE PROSECUTOR AT RUHENGARI. THE HANDING OVER WAS DONE IN PRESENCE OF THE MILITARY POLICE, HUMAN RIGHTS AND THE ICRC. THE CASE HAS BEEN ALSO INVESTIGATED BY A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS.

3.F. ONE MILOB TEAM PATROLLED THE AREAS OF RUHENGARI, CYANIKA (7152), KIDAHU (7247), BUTARO (8243), KIRAMBO (8335) AND BUSHOKA (7223). THE PATROL WAS TASKED TO LIAISE WITH THE VARIOUS MEDICAL TEAMS WORKING IN THE AREA AND FIND THE STATUS OF THE VARIOUS MEDICAL UNITS ENROUTE.

3.G. THE ASSISTANT SECERATARY GENERAL MR KOUYATE ACCOMPANIED BY DR KABIA ARRIVED AT THIS LOCATION AT ABOUT 1630 H BY HELICOPTER. THEY WERE RECIEVED AT THE HELIPAD BY THE POLITICAL INFORMATION MRS ZENA, REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNHCR AND THE MILOBS. 3.B. ONE TEAM PATROLLED AREA OF RUHENGIERI AND CYANIKA (GS 7152). MILOBS LIAISED WITH IMMIGRATION OFFICIALS AT BORDERPOST CYANIKA AND NGO'S IN RUHENGIERI.

3.C. A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHT TEAM CONDUCTED INVESTIGATION IN THE INCIDENT OF NDUNGUTSE EMMANUEL, RESIDENT OF COMMUNE GASEKE (4904) ASKING FOR ASYLUM AT THE TUNBAT 2 COY AT NYUNDO (2411). THE TUNBAT WAS ADVISED TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS AS PER "FCS DIRECTIVE ON THE LEGAL JURIDICION APPLICABLE TO UNAMIR AND RWANDAN AUTHORITIES-VERSION II DATED 31 JAN 95. AT THE SAME TIME THE ICRC RUHENGIERI, WAS ALSO INFORMED ABOUT THE INCIDENT AND IS PRESENTLY STANDING BY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HANDING OVER PROCESS.

3.D. INFORMATION WAS RECIEVED THRU THE UNHCR REGARDING THE VISIT OF THE PRESIDENT OF REPUBLIC OF RWANDA TO MONT MUHE (4013) ON 11 FEB 95 AT ABOUT 1100 H. ALL NGOS WERE INVITED TO BE PRESENT FOR THE MEETING. ONE MILOB TEAM WAS DESPATCHED TO THE LOCATION OF THE MEETING TO MONITOR THE PROCEEDING. THE MEETING WAS AIMED AT ACHIEVING REINTEGRATION OF THE LOCAL POPULATION. THE MEETING WAS ATTENDED BY SEVERAL MINISTERS FROM KIGALI AND THE OFFICIALS OF THE LOCAL ADMINISTRATION FROM THE GISENYI AND RUHENGIERI PREFECTURES. SUBSEQUENT TO THE MEETING OF THE OFFICIALS, MEETING WAS HELD WITH THE LOCAL POPULATION.

3.E. THE INTRASECTOR ROTATION OF THE MILOBS WAS CARRIED OUT BETWEEN GISENYI AND RUHENGIERI TO DISTRIBUTE THE NEWLY ROTATED MILOBS AND TO ACHIEVE A BALANCE OF DEPLOYMENT IN THE TWO SUBSECTOR. A TOTAL OF FIVE MILOBS WERE REDEPLOYED AT RUHENGIERI.

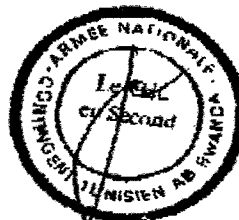

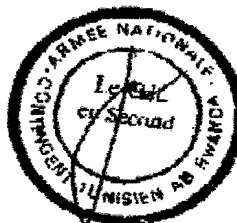


