INFORMATION WAS RECEIVED AT SECTOR HQ THAT THE SITUATION AT KAMBOVE WAS TENSE AND THERE WAS LIKEYHOOD OF INTER TRIBAL CONFLICTS. THIS INFORMATION WAS ALSO RECEIVED BY THE ANC COY AT CAMP SHINKOLOBWE. THE ANC COMDR WANTED TO SEND AN ANC PATROL TO KAMBOVE. PERMISSION WAS NOT RPT NOT GRANTED TO SEND THE ANC PATROL. A STRONG UN PATJOL WAS SENT TO KAMBOVE ON 30 APR AT 0100H AND REPORTED THE SITUATION CALM AND UNDER CONTROL. TWO UN PATROLS WILL BE SENT AGAIN TO KAMBOVE FOR CARRYING OUT A SEARCH FOR UNAUTHORISED WEAPONS IN POSSESSION OF THE LOCALS.

CHARLIE. ON 29 APR AFTERNOON BALUBA GROUPS LEFT COMMUNE KIKULA AND CAME TO UN HQ FOR PROTECTION AS THEY FEARED THAT THEY WOULD BE ATTACKED. THE CREDIT FOR THIS MOVE GOES TO SENDWE. WE HAVE GIVEN HIM EVERY ENCOURAGEMENT AND ANY ASSISTANCE HE HAS ASKED US IN THIS OPERATION. THE REFUGEES HAVE LIVED UNDER VERY DIFFICULT CONDITIONS SINCE AUGUST LAST YEAR WHEN WE HANDED OVER THE CAMP TO THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THE PERSONS CONCERNED HAD INSISTED THAT WE SHOULD AIRLIFT THEM TO THEIR HOME AREAS AS WE DID IN RESPECT OF SEVENTY THOUSAND OF THEIR COMPATRIOTS. WE ON OUR PART ARGUED THAT WE CANNOT DO THIS BECAUSE THEY HAD THEIR HOMES OF ORIGIN IN SOUTH KATANGA.

BOURGOMASTER, MESSRS MBISU AND KANDU COMMISSIONERS OF POLICE, AND MR DEMERRE UNHK REP. THE UN REP STATED THAT TEMPORARY ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AND ELECTRICITY AND WATER SUPPLIES HAVE BEEN RESTORED TO CAMP SHINKOLOBWE. HE GAVE HIS ASSURANCE THAT THE DAMAGED PYLON WOULD BE REPAIRED AND ELECTRICITY AND WATER SHOULD BE RESTORED ON A PERMANENT BASIS WITHIN A WEEK. ARRIVED CAMP SHINKOLOBWE AND WERE MET BY MR OBOLENSKY, THE DIRECTOR OF UMHK AT KAMBOVE, AND MR MOLOKO CHIEF OF POLICE, KAMBOVE. COL BOBOSO ASKED HIS COY CMDR TO PRODUCE THE PRISONERS THAT HE HAD ARRESTED. AFTER DISCUSSION WITH THE CHIEF OF POLICE THE BURGOMASTER AND UN REP THE FOLLOWING ACTION WAS ORDERED. 13 POLICEMEN WHO WERE FROM KAMBOVE POLICE STATION WERE HANDED OVER TO MR MOLOKO.
