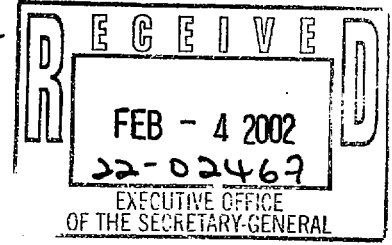

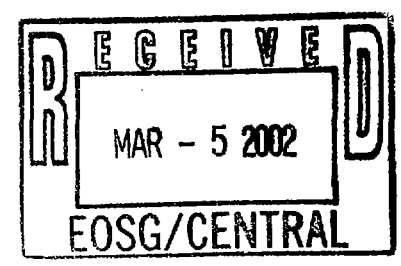
Further to the information provided to your office concerning the provisional programme for CEB in Rome (enclosed), I hope that any meetings that the Secretary-General may find it necessary to have with the Italian authorities can be organized so as not to clash with the programme of the session. If this proves impossible, I would recommend that any such meetings be scheduled on Thursday, 11 April, when the "retreat" is scheduled, rather than on Wednesday, 10 April, when the private meeting and the formal session are to take place. The organization of the retreat is still open and is generally rather flexible. It could therefore more easily be adjusted to accommodate the Secretary-General's engagements.
