Subject: Travel on UN aircraft

*C/ADM 450/4*

- 1 There have been a number of instances where unauthorized personnel have travelled on UN aircraft. The regulations in this regard are as follows.
- 2 Normally all personnel travelling on UN aircraft must be in possession of properly authorized travel orders.
- 3 In case of emergency where travel orders are not available, UN personnel may be carried, provided satisfactory evidence is given to show that they are UN personnel and are travelling on UN business.
- 4 Transportation of non-UN personnel on UN aircraft requires the personal authorization of either the Force Commander or the Special Representative. Under no circumstances are captains of aircraft to allow non-UN personnel to travel in UN aircraft without appropriate authorization.

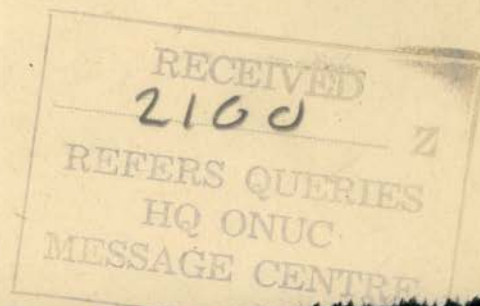



2. It is once again notified in the interest of the individuals concerned that they must comply in toto with the instructions issued in the above quoted letter. Movement Control Detachments concerned have been given clear-cut instructions not to allow anyone to proceed or make use of any UN or UN chartered aircraft unless all instructions on the subject have been fully complied with.

3. Please acknowledge receipt of this letter and give it as wide a publicity as possible.

1. It has been reported by Movement Control, Pisa, that military personnel invariably arrive in Pisa without any identification papers or passports, carrying excess baggage and requesting money for their transit expenses. In addition, they have been reported to have asked for commercial tickets without any covering travel authorizations to support such demands. In order to overcome these complaints the following procedure will be adopted by all military personnel proceeding out of the Congo on the completion of their tenure:-

- a. All requests for movement will be initiated by the OC units/contingents/Liaison Officers on the ONUC Movement Order which will then be approved by the Chief of Military Personnel and certified by the Chief Administrative Officer.
- b. The ONUC Movement Order duly completed will be submitted to the Chief Movement Control Officer who will indicate availability of ONUC transportation to Pisa. If there is no space available on the North Star flight this will be endorsed on the Movement Order which will then be taken to the Chief Accommodation and Travel Officer to arrange commercial transportation.
- c. If space is available on the North Star flight the date and flight number will be indicated by the Movement Control and further transportation (that is from Pisa to final destination) will be arranged by UNEF in Pisa in accordance with ONUC Travel Officer's instructions as provided on the Travel Authorization (PT8). UNEF Pisa will not provide any form of transportation to any ONUC member, whether civilian or military, who fails to present the legal Travel Authorization document (PT8) which should be delivered to him by the Travel Officer prior to his departure from the Congo.

- d. It is emphasised that the baggage entitlement given by the Travel Officer must be strictly followed otherwise the passengers will have to pay for any excess baggage from Pisa onwards.
- e. It is the responsibility of unit and contingent Commanders to ensure that all personnel leaving the mission settle their accounts in the Finance Office and that they are in possession of sufficient funds for the journey period. Movement Control, Pisa, will not make any payment to any military personnel under any circumstances.
- f. The Chief Movement Control Officer will also be given a list of personnel who are not in possession of international passports. A UN certificate will be issued by the Chief Movement Control Officer to these passengers to enable them to proceed without a valid passport. These certificates will be personally signed by the Chief Movement Control Officer and will be valid for a limited period only.
- g. All passengers proceeding on the North Star flights will turn in their identity cards to the Movement Control office at N'Djili. They will be issued boarding tickets on presentation of the passenger processing card which must be collected from the Chief Movement Control Officer for each individual.

#### Leave

2. As a matter of policy UN military personnel are authorised to use the North Star flight whilst proceeding on leave out of the Congo strictly on a space available basis. It is emphasised that duty passengers and freight will be given priority over leave passengers and the Chief Movement Control Officer will ensure that this policy is strictly followed. It must be clearly understood that due to the heavy backlog of cargo now held up in Pisa it will not be possible for Movement Control, Pisa, to send any passengers on the UN flights to Leopoldville. Consequently all military personnel should be informed that they will have to return by commercial aircraft at their own expense and they should not rely on obtaining any space from Pisa.
