CONSTRUCTION OF HOUSES FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

1. Name of project: Construction of houses for secondary school teachers Programme D-10.5 (b)
2. Location: Inongo, Lac Leopold II
3. Type of facilities: The construction of 6 houses at Inongo, chief-town in Lake Leopold II province
4. Estimated cost: Estimated cost is CF 10,000,000
5. Duration of works: 10 months
6. Date when works can be begin: September 10, 1963
7. Priority in relation to other projects: high
8. Why facility is needed:

During the school year 1962/63, the census of the Ministère de l'Education Nationale indicated the number of teachers at 77 for a school population of 1580 students.

The increase in the number of students expected for the 1963/64 school year requires additional members of the teaching staff, which for this school year will be 18.

Considering the bad conditions in which teachers were living during the 1962/63 year because of the housing shortage, the construction of these new houses is necessary to assure the new teachers a minimum standard of comfort.

9. Estimated annual maintenance costs:

Maintenance of these buildings will be incumbent upon the budget of the Ministère de l'Education Nationale.
