

LETTER OF APPOINTMENT

Dear Lieutenant General Gaye,

I am pleased to offer you an appointment as an Assistant Secretary-General in the Secretariat of the United Nations. This will be a fixed-term appointment, in accordance with the terms and conditions specified below and subject to the provisions of the Staff Regulations and the Staff Rules, together with such amendments as may from time to time be made to such Staff Regulations and such Staff Rules.

Tenure of Appointment

This fixed-term appointment is for a period of two years from the effective date of appointment shown above. It therefore expires on the 12th day of September 2012.

This fixed-term appointment is subject to review at the end of the first year.

This appointment may be terminated prior to its expiration date in accordance with staff regulation 9.3, in which case you will be given 30 days' written notice. This appointment is also subject to termination in the interest of the Organization, as determined by the Secretary-General, in which case you will be given three months' written notice. Should your appointment be terminated prior to its expiration date, the United Nations will pay such indemnity as may be provided for under the Staff Regulations and the Staff Rules. Please note that the normal expiration of the appointment at its term does not require the payment of any indemnity. This fixed-term appointment does not carry any expectancy of renewal or of conversion to any other type of appointment in the Secretariat of the United Nations.

Information

Your particular attention is drawn to Staff Regulation 3.3 relating to the Staff Assessment Plan and to the Regulations and Rules relating to the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund and to the Annex to this letter explaining various United Nations allowances and entitlements.

Special Condition


This is a fixed-term appointment on secondment from Government service. The conditions governing appointments with the United Nations are set out in this Letter of Appointment. The conditions governing your right to return to Government service are specified in the communication from the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Senegal to the United Nations which is attached to this Letter of Appointment. By signing this Letter of Appointment, you specifically acknowledge that you have agreed to serve the United Nations on secondment from the service of your Government on the conditions specified in this Letter of Appointment and its attachment.
