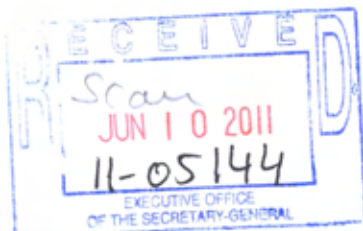

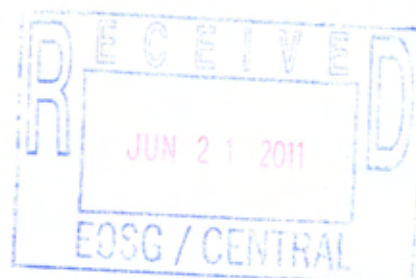
While in New York the Minister is expected to interact with other stakeholders to collect their views on how best to deliver positive outcomes in Durban.

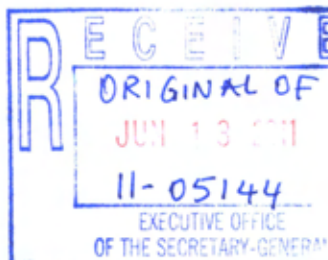
