IN MY CONVERSATION YESTERDAY WITH TSHOMBE I WAS ABOUT TO RAISE
MERCENARY QUESTION WHEN HE RAISED IT HIMSELF, AND SAID HE WANTED TO
DISCUSS IT NEXT WEEK. HE ASKED IF AND WHEN DUMONTET WAS RETURNING
AS HE HAD SAID HE WOULD DO AT SWEDISH PARTY. IN THIS CONNECTION I
MET CONSULS SWITZERLAND PORTUGAL AND NETHERLANDS LAST NIGHT AS WELL
AS MEMBERS LOCAL EUROPEAN COMMUNES. ALL TOLD ME INDEPENDENTLY THAT

BRAVO GAP BETWEEN THE 2 AREAS HAS TO BE CONSTANTLY PATROLLED

CHARLIE UNION MINIERE FACTORY AREA VERY EXTENSIVE AND PRESENTLY
HELD BY TPS GUARDING VITAL AND COMMANDING PTS AND ENTRIES ONLY WHICH
ENTIRELY IN FACTORY AREA. WE ALSO COMD KIPUSHI AND COMMUNE ALBERT RDS
BOTH OF WHICH CAN BE COVERED BY FIRE FROM PRESENT POSNS WITHOUT PHYSICALLY
DEPLOYING TPS ON THEM. THERE ARE BARELY SUFFICIENT TPS FOR THIS AND
THESE ALSO EXTENDED TO LIMIT

SECONDLY UNION MINIERE REQUIRE TPS TO VACATE FACTORY AREA TO
ENABLE FREE FUNCTIONING FACTORY AND ATTACHED OFFICES AND INSTALLATIONS.
THEY ARE PARTICULARLY ANXIOUS ABOUT THIS AS THEY FEAR NERVOUSNESS AMONG
WORKERS. THIS HAS FOLLOWING IMPLICATIONS. IN CASE WE HAVE TO VACATE

THE LUBUMBASHI STREAM AT THEIR BACK. THIS HIGHLY UNDESIRABLE TO ACCEPT AND WE LOSE CONTROL OF ELECTRIC POWER DISTRIBUTION YARD AND WATER PUMPS WHICH BOTH LOC IN FACTORY AREA AND VITAL TO OUR PURPOSES AS POWER FOR KIPUSHI MINES CONTROLLED FROM HERE BESIDES WATER AND POWER FOR ELI. IT WILL ALSO BE NECESSARY TO DEPLOY TPS TO COVER THE 2 RDS AS OUTER PERIMETER ON LOWER GROUND

3 INSPITE INCREASED TP REQUIREMENTS WE WILL STILL BE UNABLE TO ADEQUATELY COVER APPROACHES AND EXITS WHICH ARE NUMEROUS AND FAIRLY CONCEALED DUE BROKENNESS OF GROUND

FOURTHLY WITH APPROX 1000 WORKERS ENTERING AND LEAVING PER SHIFT NOT POSSIBLE TO MAINT SATISFACTORY SECURITY CHECK. IN ANY CASE TPS NOT QUALIFIED FOR THIS TASK

FIFTHLY ONLY POSSIBLE SOLUTION SEEMS TO BE TO VACATE FACTORY AREA AND MOVE 35 ETH AT LIDO. CIV SECURITY STAFF COULD THEN CIRCULATE IN FACTORY WITH MIL PATROLS OUTSIDE PERIMETER. FROM MIL VIEWPT THIS ALSO HIGHLY UNSATISFACTORY AS THIS GIVES NO REAL CONTROL OF ANYTHING APART FROM BEING TO SOME EXTENT OF DETERRENT VALUE.
