B. HR TEAM IN LOCATION CONTINUE WITH THEIR INVESTIGATIONS INTO THE MASSACRES OF APRIL TO JULY AND ARE RECEIVING ALL THE ASSISTANCE AND COOPERATION FROM THIS HQ. FROM 1700 HRS, WITNESSES TO SOME OF THE MASSACRES BEGAN APPEARING BEFORE THE TEAM IN THIS LOCATION.

7. LOGISTICS: THERE IS AN URGENT NEED TO PROVIDE A 10,000 LITRE WATER TANK FOR THE MALAWIAN PLATOON WHICH IS NOW DEPLOYED IN KIGEMBE. THE ROUTE TO THE PLATOON POSITION AND ITS SHEER DISTANCE FROM BUTARE MAKE THIS DEMAND IMPERATIVE.

8. MISC. SOLDIERS FROM THIS HQ NOTICED A VEHICLE BELONGING TO CARITAS BEING UNLOADED OF FOOD ITEMS AT A SHOP IN BUTARE AT APPROX 1400 HRS 05 NOV. ON A SECOND RETURN TO THE SHOP THE VEHICLE HAD

GONE. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE FOOD ITEMS BEING UNLOADED INCLUDED FLOUR AS SEVERAL BAGS OF THIS ITEMS WERE SEEN PACKED IN THE SHOP. THE SHOP IS NOTED TO BE HEAVILY INVOLVED WITH THE RPA IN THE PAST.IT IS WORTH NOTING THAT ON 03 NOV, A CARITAS VEHICLE OF A SIMILAR MAKE WAS CONFISCATED BY RPA PERSONNEL IN GITARAMA. THE VEHICLE WAS THEN CARRYING 10 TONS OF FOOD ITEMS ENROUTE TO KIGALI. SECTOR 3 HQ HAS NOT YET TRACKED THIS CONFISCATED VEHICLE.
