

3. RPA. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) REPORTED FREQUENT HARASSMENT OF LOCALS OF INNGANZO (GR 2202) AND GAHUMBA (GR 2292) BY RPA.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) REPORTED INCREASED INFILTRATION OF INSURGENTS FROM THE PARC DES VOLCANS INTO THE AREA OF KABATWA (GR 3228). ON 13 DEC THE RPA ENCOUNTERED ONE OF THESE GROUPS. HOWEVER THE INSURGENTS MANAGED TO ESCAPE LEAVING BEHIND SOME GRENADES AND ANTI PERSONNEL MINES.

(2) INDBATT TRANSPORTED 11 TONS OF RATIONS FOR RPA FROM KIGALI TO BUTARE AND PROVIDED TWO TRUCKS TO ASSOCIATION ACTION HUMANITAIRE FOR SHIFTING STORES.

(3) INDBATT MED STAFF TREATED 77 MEDICAL AND 13 DENTAL PATIENTS AT OWN CLINIC.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

3. RPA. MILOBS SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) REPORTED THAT SINCE OCT 95, LOCALS WERE BEING FORCEFULLY EVICTED FROM THEIR HOUSES IN AREA ALONG THE RUSIZI RIVER (GR 7422) AND CYIMBOGO COMMUNE WITH THE AIM OF CREATING A BUFFER ZONE TO RESTRICT THE INFILTRATION. THE LOCALS ARE GIVEN THREE HOURS TO LEAVE THEIR HOUSES AND OCCUPY HOUSES FURTHER INLAND VACATED BY THOSE WHO HAD FLED TO ZAIRE. THESE EXPULSIONS ARE GENERALLY SOUTH OF RUSIZI II ALONG THE BORDER AREA UPTO 1-2 KM INLAND FROM THE RUSIZI RIVER.

A. REFERENCE TO THE ROBBERY INCIDENT AT THE ICRC OFFICE IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU) ON 15 DEC 95. MILOBS FURTHER REPORTED THAT THE RPA AND GENDARMERES ARE CONDUCTING EXTENSIVE INTERROGATION OF THE ICRC SECURITY GUARD AND THEIR OWN SOLDIERS /GENDARMERES BUT NO RESULTS HAVE BEEN OBTAINED SO FAR. INVESTIGATION CONTINUES.

B. MILOBS SECTOR 5A (RUHENGARI) REPORTED THAT THE COUNCILLOR OF KAVUMU SECTOR (GR 6224) WAS KILLED BY UNKNOWN PERSONS ON NIGHT 15/16 DEC 95. MOTIVE BEHIND THE KILLING COULD NOT BE ESTABLISHED.

C. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) REPORTED THAT TWO PERSONS WERE ARRESTED FROM BUNYONI CELLULE (GR 2206) OF BUDAHA SECTOR (GR 2206) ON 13 DEC 95 FOR THEIR ALLEGED LINKS WITH THE INTERAHAMWE.

NTONDE SECTOR. SIMILAR CEREMONIES WERE CONDUCTED IN SHYTANDA (GR 7680) AND GIKO (GR 7883) SECTORS WITH THE BOURGMASTRES IN ATTENDANCE. A TOTAL OF 200 VICTIMS WERE REBURIED.



2. OVERVIEW. NSTR.

3. RPA.

A. IN SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA), 323 INMATES OUT OF 341 IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT OF MUGINA COMMUNE GR 9267, ARE ACCUSED OF HAVING PARTICIPATED IN THE GENOCIDE. THE IPJ OF THE COMMUNE EXPLAINED THAT THE SPATE OF ARRESTS WAS DUE TO THE FACT THAT THE PEOPLE WERE BEING FORCED TO RETURN AND REGISTER IN THEIR HOME COMMUNE WHERE THEY ARE SCREENED AND ARRESTED.

(2) MILOB TEAM SECTOR 2A (BYUMBA) REPORTED THAT 15 MEN WERE ARRESTED BY RPA FOR THEIR ILLEGAL ASSOCIATION UNDER THE PRETEXT OF WORSHIPPING AT NIGHT ON 11 DEC 95 IN THE RUTARE COMMUNE. IN MUKARE COMMUNE 18 RETURNEES WERE ARRESTED FOR TRYING TO FLEE BACK TO ZAIRE.

A. IN SECT 5A RUHENGARI, MILOB PATROL TO KIGOME COMMUNE REPORTED THAT IN KABAYA SECT, GR 5833, UNKNOWN PEOPLE TRIED TO SABOTAGE ELECTROGAS SUB-STATION ON 102000 DEC 95. AN ANTI TANK ROCKET WAS FIRED AT THE SUB-STATION AND DAMAGED THE TRANSFORMER. FURTHER DETAILS BEING OBTAINED.

B. MILOBS SECTOR 5A (RUHENGARI) REPORTED THAT ON 06 DEC 95 TWAGIRAYAZU (ASST. COUNCILLOR) AND MR PIERRE CELESTIN (A PRIEST) WERE SHOT DEAD BY FRGF ELEMENTS (REF SITREP OF 07 DEC 95). ON 10 DEC 03 MEMBERS OF FRGF WERE ARRESTED BY RPA FROM KABERE 1 SECTOR ON SUSPICION OF INVOLVEMENT IN THE MURDERS. THE IPJ INFORMED THE PATROL ABOUT THE ARREST OF ONE MR. BIRIMWABAGOBO FOR ILLEGAL POSSESSION OF HAND GRENADE.







IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU), RELIABLE SOURCES INFORMED MILOBS THAT THE RPA HAVE RECEIVED ORDERS TO SEIZE AND IMPOUND ALL VEHS BELONGING TO MEDICINES DU MONDE (MDM), ONE OF THE 38 NGOS WHO HAVE BEEN ASKED TO SUSPEND OPS AND LEAVE RWANDA. NO SUCH ACTION HAS BEEN TAKEN YET. SECTOR COMDR HAS REQUESTED FOR UNAMIR ESCORTS FOR THESE VEHS FROM CYANGUGU TO KIGALI.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECTOR 5A (RUHENGERI) BANDITS ATTACKED TWO HOUSES ON THE NIGHT OF 06 DEC AND FIRED AT THE OCCUPANTS, INJURING TWO OF THEM. DETAILS OF PROPERTY ROBBED ARE NOT KNOWN.

C. CIVPOL PTL TO MWENDO COMMUNE IN KIBUYE PREFECTURE, WAS INFORMED BY THE COMMUNAL POLICE THAT THE COUNCILLOR OF GASAYURA SECTOR WITHIN THE COMMUNE, WAS ARRESTED BY RPA FOR ORGANISING INSURGENT ACTIVITIES. HR INFORMED.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECT 3A, GIKONGORO, MILOB PATROL TO MUSEBEYA COMMUNE (GR 4033) REVEALED THE PRESENCE OF FORMER GOVT SOLDIERS IN THE COMMUNE. A CAMPAIGN HAS BEEN LAUNCHED TO CONVINCE THEM TO SURRENDER THEMSELVES, THEIR EQUIPMENTS AND WEAPONS.

6. POLITICAL.

A. THE SRSG ATTENDED THE HEADS OF AGENCIES MEETING AT THE UNDP COMPOUND. THEREAFTER, MR. DEGNI SEGNI, SPECIAL RAPPOREUR UNHFOR CALLED ON THE SRSG AND DISCUSSED THE GENERAL SITUATION AND CURRENT DEVELOPMENTS CONCERNING RWANDA. LATER, THE SRSG HELD A MEETING WITH THE FORCE COMMANDER AND EXCHANGED VIEWS REGARDING THE FORCE LEVEL AND UNAMIR'S MANDATE.

B. 3. RPA.

A. SECTOR 2A - REF THE REPORTED INCIDENT OF 30 NOV IN WHICH A TRUCK GOT STUCK IN THE MUD AT GAKUMA (GR 225539) WHILE DELIVERING SCHOOL MATERIAL TO MUVUMBA COMMUNE. THE MILOB TEAM LEADER OFF LOADED THE MATERIAL IN THE TRUCK INTO THEIR PICK-UPS AS THE RECOVERY COULD NOT BE ORGANISED THE SAME DAY AND LEFT AN ARMED ESCORT TO GUARD THE TRUCK. WHEN THE TEAM ARRIVED AT THE COMMUNE OFFICES AFTER 2100 HRS, THE ARMED ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE NAMED BOSCO MANZIA AND ANOTHER PERSON NAMED STANCLLAS MUBASHAKIWAYA BOTH DRESSED IN MILITARY UNIFORMS, IMMEDIATELY ARRESTED THE SCHOOL INSPECTOR AND ORDERED THE MILOBS TO LEAVE. WHEN THE TEAM LEADER EXPLAINED THAT THE INSPECTOR HAD THE KEYS TO THE STORE ROOM WHERE THEY HAD TO DEPOSIT THE ITEMS, THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE FIRED TWO SHOTS INTO THE LEGS OF THE ARMED ESCORT FROM GHANCOY BUT FORTUNATELY MISSED. THE TEAM LEADER CONTACTED THE HQ AND WAS TOLD NOT TO FIRE BACK BUT TO WITHDRAW TO A NEARBY CLINIC AND PROCEED BACK TO BYUMBA WITH THE REST OF THE PARTY AND MATERIAL LEAVING ONLY THE ROOFING SHEETS AND THE INSPECTOR IN THE HANDS OF THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE. ON 01 DEC 95, THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMESTRE AND HIS ACCOMPLICE WERE ARRESTED AND ARE BEING HELD AT BYUMBA GENDARMERIE. THE INSPECTOR WAS RELEASED AND THE SCHOOL ITEMS WILL BE DELIVERED TO MUVUMBA COMMUNE TODAY.

B. RPA CONDUCTED CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION IN THE NYAKINAMA COMMUNE (GR 5827) ON 30 NOV 95 FROM 0600 HRS TO 1800 HRS. ONE WEAPON WAS FOUND IN THE HOUSE OF ONE OF THE TWO COUNCILLORS WHO WERE ARRESTED FOR NOT MAINTAINING SECURITY IN THEIR AREAS. TWO CIVILIANS WERE ALSO ARRESTED DURING THE OPERATION FOR ALLEGEDLY HARBOURING FRGF SOLDIERS IN THEIR HOUSES.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. SECTOR 3A - MILOBS RECEIVED REPORTS THAT PEOPLE HAVE BEEN KILLED IN THE FOREST NEAR SHABA SECTOR (GR 397155) OF KIVU COMMUNE. PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT ON 17 AUG 95, CONSEQUENT TO THE ARREST OF THE LARGE NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN RWAMIKO COMMUNE (4914), LOCALS HAD FLED TO THE FOREST AND ESTABLISHED A CAMP WEST OF SHABA OF WHICH PEOPLE ON THE COMMUNE WERE NOT AWARE. LOCALS REPORTED HAVING HEARD FIRING ON 25 NOV 95 BETWEEN 0900 HRS TO 1600 HRS FROM THE DIRECTION OF THE CAMP. LOCALS ALSO REPORTED THAT THEY HAD SEEN ABOUT 08 PEOPLE IN UNIFORM IN SHABA AREA AND THESE HAD LEFT ON 26 NOV 95. ON RECEIPT OF ABOVE INFO, A TEAM OF MILOBS, HR AND ABOUT 40 TO 50 LOCALS WENT TO THE CAMP SITE WHICH HAD BEEN DESTROYED AND COUNTED UP TO 20 DEAD BODIES. ONE OF THE SURVIVORS SAID THAT PRIOR TO THE INCIDENT, ABOUT 135 PEOPLE WERE LIVING IN THE CAMP AND DURING THE SHOOTING,

THE PEOPLE HAD FLED INTO THE FOREST. THE EXACT NUMBER OF CASUALTIES COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED AS A NUMBER OF BODIES ARE SUSPECTED TO HAVE BEEN DISPOSED OFF BY THE ATTACKERS. THE RPA SECOND IN COMMAND WHEN CONTACTED, DENIED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF THE INCIDENT. HR INVESTIGATING.

SECTOR 5B - MILOB PATROL TO KIVUMU SECTOR (2303) REPORTED THAT SEVEN INDIVIDUALS HAD COME TO RWANDA FROM MUGUNGO CAMP IN ZAIRE CARRYING THREE ATK MINES, SIX HAND GRENADES AND TWO AK 47 RIFLES AND ASSORTED UNIFORMS. THE INFILTRATORS WERE SUSPECTED TO BE HIDING IN THE FOREST. ALSO IN THE SAME SECTOR ON THE NIGHT 29/30 NOV 95, SUSPECTED INTERHAMWE SURROUNDED THE HOUSE OF THE COUNCILLOR AND DEMANDED ENTRY. THE LOCALS RESPONDED TO THE SITUATION AND CHASED THE INSURGENTS AWAY.

C. MILOBS PATROL TO KANZENZE SECTOR GR 3019 WERE INFORMED BY LOCALS THAT 50 INTERHAMWE HAD INFILTRATED INTO THE COMMUNE CLOSELY FOLLOWED BY THE RPA. THE INSURGENTS HOWEVER ESCAPED INTO THE NEARBY FOREST.

SECTOR 1B (GITARAMA) - MILOB TEAM TO TABWE COMMUNE REPORTED THAT A CORDON AND SEARCH OPERATION WAS CARRIED OUT BY RPA ON 21 NOV 95 TO APPREHEND LOCALS WHO DID NOT BELONG TO THE COMMUNE BUT WERE STAYING THERE AS A RESULT OF THEIR PROBABLE INVOLVEMENT IN CERTAIN OFFENSES DURING THE WAR. 26 PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED AND LATER SENT TO THEIR RESPECTIVE COMMUNES. IN MOST COMMUNES THESE PEOPLE ARE SAID TO BE TREATED AS PRISONERS AND ON ARRIVAL, ARE IMMEDIATELY DETAINED IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT.

4. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECTOR 4 (CYANGUGU), UNSUBSTANTIATED REPORTS RECEIVED BY MILOBS INDICATE THAT A TRUCK LOADED WITH LEAFLETS CARRYING NAMES OF PEOPLE IN RWANDA WHOM THE INTERHAMWE INTENDS TO ASSASSINATE, WAS SEEN IN NYAMASHEKE SECTOR. INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS.

SECTORS OF CYIMBOGO COMMUNE AND ALSO MET WITH OTHER RETURNEES. THE VISIT WHICH WAS ARRANGED BY UNHCR, WAS REPORTEDLY SUCCESSFUL.

(3) MILOBS REPORTED THAT ABOUT 1615 HRS ON 26 NOV 95, AN ICRC VEH WAS STOPPED AT AN RPA CHECKPOINT AT GISAKURA GR 9829 AND ITS OCCUPANTS (TWO NURSES) WERE SUBJECTED TO SERIES OF QUESTION PERTAINING TO THE VEH APPARENTLY IN A BID TO TAKE THE VEH FROM THEM. THE SOLDIERS BACKED OUT WHEN THE GERMAN AMBASSADOR'S VEH ON ITS WAY TO CYANGUGU, ARRIVED AT THE CHECKPOINT.


