Subject : Transportation of merchandise, LEO to EVILLE.

I had a visit today from Mr. Eisenstein of BATA, requesting ONUC assistance in flying supplies of shoes to EVILLE. I informed him that we would provide such transportation at cost on a space available basis in accordance with our usual system.

In the course of conversation, he pointed out that a much cheaper alternative route (until the Iubilash and Bukama railway bridges are repaired) would be to ship the merchandise from LEO via MATADI and LOBITO. This would, however, involve a small expenditure of hard currency in respect of the section of the journey LOBITO/DILOLO. It occurs to me that, in the present exceptional circumstances, it might be worth allocating some foreign exchange for this purpose, and I would appreciate your comments.

SUBJECT: PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN CONNECTION WITH TRANSPORTATION
BY ONUC AIRCRAFT OF CONSUMER GOODS ON BEHALF OF PRIVATE FIRMS

1. Business firms wishing to transport essential consumer goods by Onuc Aircraft should address their requests in writing to Mr. D. Norman, Senior Procurement Officer, ONUC HQ, Elisabethville (Room 420, tel. 5403 ext. 42), for decision, specifying nature of goods, quantity and destination.
2. The Senior Procurement Officer will decide whether the request can be accepted. In doubtful cases, he should consult Mr. Harrington.
3. The Senior Procurement Officer will contact Movement Control (tel. 3282) to make the necessary reservation. It is understood that these transport facilities can only be granted on a space available basis.
4. Movement Control will inform the firm in question of the expected time of departure of the plane. The firm will make their own arrangements to have the goods delivered to Movement Control at the airport.
5. Movement Control, after verification, will issue a detailed waybill which should reconcile with the delivery note prepared by the firm.
6. One copy of the waybill and the delivery note should be sent to the Senior Procurement Officer (HQ Room 420) who will in turn, after checking, forward them to the Elisabethville Finance Officer for action.
7. The Finance Officer will bill the firms as follows:

DC-4	or	CF. 31.000	Per hour	Per aircraft
		CF. 2	Per lb.	Per hour
DC-3	or	CF. 11.000	Per hour	Per aircraft
		CF. 4	Per lb.	Per hour

Cheques are payable to ONUC-Elisabethville.

8. It is understood that the procedure outlined above is in effect only in cases where normal means of commercial transportation are unavailable or not in effect, and it applies only to local flights, i.e., flights within the Katanga Province.
9. The Senior Procurement Officer will issue report at the end of each week listing all such shipments, indicating firm, nature of goods, weight and destination, for submission to Mr. Harrington, with copy to the Chief of Civilian Operations in Léopoldville.
