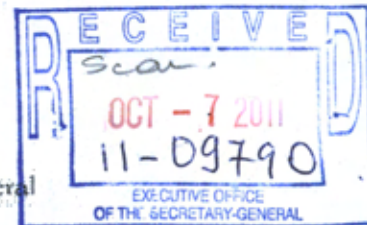

Invitation to G20 Labour Summit (L20), Cannes, France, 2-3 November 2011

Dear Mr Secretary general,

I am writing to you to invite you as a guest speaker to address the 2011 Labour Summit (L20) to take place on the occasion of the G20 Leaders' Summit in Cannes in November 2011.

The agenda of the Labour Summit (L20) of some 60 senior trade union leaders from the whole of the G20 includes meetings with Heads of State and with the heads of major international organisations such as the International Labour Organisation (ILO), the World Bank, the International Monetary Fund (IMF), the World Trade Organisation (WTO) and the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).

In view of the key role of the United Nations with regard to the economic crisis, I would like to invite you to address the L20 Summit. The trade union movement has sought since the start of the crisis to enable the situation of working people to be taken into account by the G20 Leaders, and we believe it would be extremely important for you to be able to inform our Summit about your actions in that regard.

Your speech would be particularly valued in order to enable us to hear your own views on key matters of concern to working people and their trade unions with regard to the role of the United Nations in its response to the economic crisis.

As you know, the ITUC is a strong supporter of multilateralism and the role of the United Nations in advancing the objectives that we share. The international trade union

movement has consistently and strongly promoted the central role of the UN both in discussion of economic and social issues and on questions of peace and security.

I look forward to hearing from you and hope to see you as our guest speaker in Cannes.


