(i) ONE TEAM ON 'A' PATROL VISITED THE COMMUNES OF NYAMYUMBA 2106 AND KANAMA 2712. THE TEAM NOTICED A SIT OF UNEASY CALM PREVAILING IN THE COMMUNE DUE TO RECENT INCIDENTS OF SABOTAGE AND ANTI PERS MINES. A SECURITY MEETING WAS HELD BY THE RPA AND COMMUNE AUTH NEAR THE COMMUNE OFFICE.

(ii) ONE TEAM ON B1 PATROL VISITED THE COMMUNES OF RWERERE 2722 AND MUTURA 3123. THE LOCALS OF KABATWA SECTOR 3228 COMPLAINED OF HARSH TREATMENT BY THE COUNCILLOR. THEY COMPLAINED THAT ARABLE LAND WAS BEING TAKEN AWAY BY FORCE. ON 06 FEB SOME INFILTRATORS ENTERED A HOUSE IN RUSIZA SECTOR 3028 AND TOOK AWAY MOST OF THE OWNER'S BELONGINGS.

(iii) ONE TEAM ON HELI PATROL TO BUTARU 8144. THE SIT WAS

REPORTED AS CALM BY THE COMMUNE AUTH. WFP HAS INITIATED A FOOD FOR WORK PGME IN KAYANGE 8144 SECTOR. HOWEVER DUE SHORTAGE OF FOOD AND NON ARRIVAL OF CORRUGATED TIN SHEETS PROMISED FROM UNHCR THE PROJECT IS STALLED. HOWEVER ANOTHER SOURCE STATED THAT SHEETS HAD ARRIVED AND HAVE BEEN KEPT IN A CARITAS SHED. FOUR SCHOOLS CONSTRUCTED BY AAA ( AID AND ACTION) AT KABAZA 8443, NYAMUCUCU, BUYANGA 7943 AND GASWEYA 8147 WERE OPENED ON 08 FEB.

(i) ONE PERSON WAS KILLED BY RPA IN NYAKINAMA 5827 WHEN HE REFUSED TO STOP AFTER BEING CHALLENGED DURING CURFEW HRS.

(ii) CURFEW HAS BEEN IMPOSED IN MUKUNO SECT 6828 OF RUHONDO COMMUNE 6829.

(iii) ARMED ROBBERY CONTINUES TO BE ON THE INCREASE IN NYAKINAMA 5827.

(iv) THE RPA DEMINING TEAM HAS COMMENCED WORK IN KINIGI 5440 ALONG THE TRACKS AND FOOTPATHS AND WOULD SOON MOVE ON TO CYERU 8035 AND BUTARO 8144.

(i) ONE TEAM ON 'A1' PATROL VISITED THE COMMUNE OF KAYOVE 2792. THE SIT IS REPORTED AS CALM. THE PATROL LEARNT FROM THE LOCAL RPA CDR THAT THERE WAS SECOND ANTI

PERS MINE INCIDENT ON 06 FEB NEAR KINHIRA RESETTLEMENT CAMP 2896. THE INCIDENT OCCURED WHEN PEOPLE RUSHED TO HELP THE INJURED PERSON IMDTLY AFTER THE FIRST INCIDENT AT 0800 H. IN THIS A WOMAN LOST HER LEG AND MAN WAS INJURED. THEY HAVE BEEN ADMITTED TO GISENYI HOSPITAL.

(ii) ONE TEAM ON C1 PATROL ROUTE. THE SIT IS REPORTED AS CALM. THE ASST BOURGMESTRE OF SATINSYI 5800 REPORTED THE DEATH OF AN UNKNOWN PERSON IN MATYAZO SECTOR 5908. HIS BODY WAS FOUND BY THE LOCALS ON THE ROAD SIDE AND COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED BY LOCALS OF THE SECTOR.

(iii) ONE TEAM ON F ROUTE VISITED THE COMMUNES OF NYAKINAMA 5827, NYAMUTERA 5719 AND NDUSU 6212. THE TEAM LEARNT FROM THE BOURGMESTRE OF NYAMUTERA OF INCREASING INFILTRATION IN THE SECTORS OF CYANIKA 5519, RUGERA 5519, MARAGARA 5521 AND KAJELI 5319. IN CYBINGO COMMUNE SECTOR NYUNDO 6123 THREE FRGF WERE KILLED BY LOCALS WITH MACHETES EARLY THIS MORNING. THEY WERE REPORTED TO HAVE INDULGED IN STEALING FROM THE LOCALS IN THE AREA. TWO PERSONS SUSTAINED MACHETE WOUNDS IN CYBINGO COMMUNE ON 06 FEB. THERE IS UNCONFIRMED INFO OF THE KILLING OF AN RPA SOLDIER ON 07/08 FEB BY INFILTRATORS IN CYABINGO.

(iii) ONE TEAM ON E PATROL TO KINIGI 5341 AND NKUMBA 6639. THE TEAM LEARNT OF A KILLING IN NKUMBA ON 04 FEB WHERE FOUR PERSONS, KNOWN TO BE INFORMERS OF THE RPA, WERE

KILLED. ABOUT 20 BANDITS SOME OF THEM ARMED WITH AK 47 RIFS WERE SEEN PERPETRATING THE CRIME. IT WAS LEARNT THAT ONE OF THE VICTIMS INFORMED THE RPA OF THE ARMS CACHE DISCOVERED AT NKUMBA ON 09 JAN. ONE PERSON HAS BEEN ARRESTED SO FAR. IN KINONI SECTOR 7042 THERE WAS A REPORT OF INFILTRATION BY ANOTHER GROUP. HOWEVER THEY DID NOT FIND THE INTENDED VICTIMS AND FLED BACK TO ZAIRE THROUGH UGANDA.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. FOR THE HAC. THE SECT CDR HAD A MEETING WITH THE CHIEF OF THE UNHCR, GISENYI TODAY. THE SEPTIC TANKS OF THE COLLEGE TRANSIT CAMP ARE FULL AND NEED TO BE EMPTIED. 

GICIYE COMMUNE ON 27 JAN 96 IN BIREMBO SECTOR (4814) TWO PERSONS BY NAME RUTERANA THE'ONESTE AND NVUNABANDI JEAN WERE KILLED BY A GROUP OF FOUR PEOPLE WHO WERE DEMANDING MONEY. ON THE SAME DAY AT 1630 HRS IN GIHIRA SECTOR (4612), GAHUNGERI CELLULE (4610) TWO PERSONS BY NAME NTONDWE AND RUZITATIRA WERE KILLED. THE NEXT MORNING THE RPA WENT TO

INVESTIGATE THE INCIDENT AT GAHUNGERI CELLULE . TWO PERSONS BY NAME SIMBIZI AND NTAWUKAMENYA ATTACKED THE RPA AND IN THE PROCESS THE PERSONS WERE KILLED BY THE RPA. SINCE 01 JAN 96 TO DATE 125 REURNEES HAVE ARRIVED IN THE COMMUNE.

GASEKE COMMUNE ON 23 JAN 96 IN GASIZA CENTRE (5408) SIX PEOPLE IN MILITARY UNIFORM CAME AND STOLE 30,000 FRANCS, RADIO AND OTHER ITEMS FROM THE HOUSE OF MR HABAMENSHI. 1 IT WAS REPORTED THAT ON WEDNESDAY 24 JAN 96 AT ABOUT 1230HRS 3 RED BERRETS SOLDERS FROM ZAIRE WERE KILLED IN MASISI.THE ASSAILANTS ARE UNKNOWN.ON 25 JAN 96,1 OR 2 CORPES WERE BROUGHT TO GOMA.THIS ACTION INFURIATED THE MILITARY.

2.FURTHER MORE,SOME ZAIRIAN RED BERRETS SOLDERS WERE HIRED BY THE TUTSI IN MASISI TO ESCORT THEM FROM MASISI TO THE RWANDA BORDER.THE SOLDERS DROVE WITH SPEED AND ON REACHING MUGUNGA CAMP,THEY STARTED FIRING IN THE AIR.THEY WERE STOPPED BY THE ZAIRIAN SECURITY TROOPS.AFTER SHORT NEGOTIATIONS THEY WERE ALLOWED TO PASS.ON REACHING GOMA,THEY ALSO FIRED IN THE AIR BUT THE FIRING WAS NOT HEARD IN GISENYI.ONE ROUND PASSED THROUGH THE UNHCR OFFICE IN GOMA.STAFF OF UNHCR WERE ORDERED TO GO HOME.MARKETS AND SHOPS IN GOMA WERE IMMEDIATELY CLOSED.PRESENTLY,THE SITUATION IN GOMA IS RELATIVELY CALM.MARKETS AND SHOPS HAVE RE-OPENED AND ARE OPERATING NORMALLY.HOWEVER,MASISI REMAINS CLOSED TO UN AGENCIES AND NGOs.

3. ADDITIONALLY,IT WAS LEARNT THAT ZAIRIAN TROOPS FROM KINSHASA HAVE BEEN SENT TO KIBUMBA CAMP.THESE SOLDIERS HAVE BEEN REPORTED TO HAVE SURROUNDED THE REFUGEE CAMP.THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY THAT THE REFUGEE

CAMP WOULD BE CLOSED WITHIN THE FOLLOWING FEW DAYS, PROBABLY THE FIRST WEEK OF FEBRUARY 1996.

4. THE SURROUNDER OF KIBUMBA CAMP BY THE ZAIRIAN TROOPS FROM KINSHASA SHOULD BE OF CONCERN TO SECTOR 5 GISENYI. FROM RELIABLE SOURCE, ABOUT 80% OF THE REFUGEES ARE FROM GISENYI AND RUHENGERI PREFECTURES. ALTHOUGH IT IS NOT THE FIRST TIME WHEN WE ANTICIPATE THE MASS REPATRIATION OF THE REFUGEES FROM ZAIRE, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT ALL UN AGENCIES AND NGOs ASSOCIATED WITH OF REPATRIATION OF REFUGEES BE MADE TO STAND-BY.


