I refer to your memorandum CTR/M2210 of 9 November 1964 addressed to Mr. Gilpin.

At the time the evacuation orders were lifted, it was ruled that authorization would not be given for the return of evacuated dependants of staff members or experts whose contract would expire shortly.

Mr. Naccache, whose contract expires on 31 December 1964, falls within this category. I regret therefore that we cannot reimburse his wife's return fare from England to the Congo.

Subject: Mr. A. Moïse - Return of dependants

.... On 14 November 1964 Mr. Moïse requested that the return of his dependants to the Congo be authorized (copy of his memo enclosed).

We do not find it possible to authorize the return of dependants of staff members or experts whose contracts are due to expire within a very short period of time, in the present case, one and a half months. As you know, the magistrates' contracts will not be extended beyond 31 December 1964.

There is a possibility, however, that some of the magistrates will remain in the Congo under a contract with the Congolese Government. If Mr. Moïse should accept such a contract, we are prepared to recommend to Headquarters that his family's return at UN expense be authorized.

I should be grateful if you would apprise Mr. Moïse orally of the foregoing, making it clear that there is, at this stage, no commitment on our part since the final decision would rest with Headquarters.

Subject : Security

1. After the meeting of chiefs of missions on 18 November, the following cable No. ONUC 3628 was sent to Dr. Bunche:

"1. At meeting this morning with all chiefs of missions it was agreed unanimously

AAA. I should recommend to you permission be given for return to Congo dependents those staff members and experts posted to towns Coquilhatville, Bukavu and Luluabourg, subject to prior verification housing accommodation available. The recommendation covers dependents of experts posted in one or other of the towns, but not those of experts posted in the regions outside the towns. In latter case, situation in each duty station should be considered on its merits, as and when state of security improves;

BBB. a similar recommendation could not yet be made regarding Albertville but that I should enquire into the security and housing situation there to see whether there would be a possibility of making such a recommendation soon;

CCC. chiefs of missions would copy this cable to executive heads their agencies.

"2. Appreciate approval arrange return dependents mentioned one AAA above."

2. I have received the following reply from Dr. Bunche:

"Your 3628 return to Congo of dependents of staff members and experts posted Coquilhatville, Bukavu and Luluabourg approved as specified your para AAA!"

3. As soon as you have the approval of the executive heads of your agencies, you are therefore free to arrange the return of the dependents mentioned above according to the procedure already established for Leopoldville and Elisabethvill.

4. I should be in touch with you again as soon as I have some advice on the situation in Albertville.

Subject: Mr. J.J.G. Kanski
Request for Return of dependants - his memo of 26 October 1964

In a conversation with Mr. Kanski in my office today, I informed him that a decision could not be taken at this time on the above request.

If he accepts a contract with the Congolese Government and remains in the Congo, we are prepared to submit his request to Headquarters with a favourable recommendation. If, however, he does not accept further service with the Congolese Government, the period until the end of his present contract with the United Nations, 31 December 1964, is too short to justify the return travel of his family at UN expense.

Mr. Kanski agreed that the foregoing was a reasonable view.

I also told him that Mr. Laurent, the Senior Adviser, hoped to have the Minister's final approval of the draft contract to be offered to the magistrates before the end of this month.

SUBJECT : SECURITY - ALBERTVILLE

I refer to your cable TAB 899 concerning the proposal to allow dependents to return to Albertville.

1. Seen in the context of CNL rebellion, security at Albertville is probably no worse than at Bukavu or Luluabourg, now clear of the danger zone, and I would not attach very much importance to the proximity of the Fizi-Kabambare region, from which the insurrection sprang early this year and where military operations are still going on.

2. One element of uncertainty concerns the reaction of the eastern Baluba tribes to the virtual take-over of North Katanga by Katanga Oriental authorities and pro-Conakat forces, supported by the Central Government.

Let me say that I do not expect any violent reactions: the people of North Katanga have had more than their fair share of troubles, and Albertville itself, moreover, has a tribally heterogeneous population.

3. On balance I would say Albertville could be declared a family station. For your information the CFL and Filtisaf have authorized dependents of their European employees to return to the town.



Security - return of dependents

1. With the steady movement of the ANC toward Stanleyville, the situation elsewhere in the Congo begins to look much less tense than it once did. On his recent visit to Bukavu and Luluabourg, the Resident Representative noticed a greater sense of security in each town, though work and travel in the regions outside the towns are still only possible on a very restricted basis.
2. Having regard to all the circumstances, it is suggested that dependents of experts posted to Coquilhatville, Bukavu and Luluabourg should be allowed to return to those towns, subject to a prior check that housing accommodation was available, and that a recommendation to this effect be sent by the Resident Representative to the Secretary-General, and copies of the recommendation be sent by each mission chief to the executive head of his agency.
3. The present recommendation covers dependents of experts posted in one or other of the three towns, but not those of experts posted in the regions outside the towns. In the latter case, the situation in each duty station should be considered on its merits, as and when the state of security improves.

Objet: Retour au Congo des personnes à charge évacuées, et paiement de l'indemnité de subsistance d'évacuation

I. INTRODUCTION

A la suite d'un échange de télégrammes entre le Siège et moi-même et après consultation des Chefs de mission, il a été décidé d'atténuer quelque peu les mesures de sécurité appliquées ces derniers mois.

La question de la sécurité restera néanmoins inscrite à l'ordre du jour des réunions des Chefs de mission, afin qu'il soit possible de revoir régulièrement et officiellement les dispositions prises et notamment de déterminer les lieux où les personnes à charge évacuées pourront être autorisées à revenir.

II. AYANTS-DROIT

Les membres du personnel et experts en service à Léopoldville et Elisabethville seront autorisés à rappeler leur famille avec l'accord préalable du Siège de leur institution, ou de leur Chef de mission si celui-ci a été habilité à donner cet accord.

III. PROCEDURE

La procédure suivante sera suivie pour permettre le retour des personnes à charge:

- (a) Chaque Chef de mission
 - (i) établit la liste des personnes à charge devant revenir au Congo;

- (ii) il s'assure qu'un logement convenable sera disponible pour chaque famille au moment de son retour; dans le cas où une famille aura besoin d'un logement du BAT, l'existence d'un logement libre devra être confirmée par écrit par le Chef du service du logement, avec copie au Service du personnel;
- (iii) il invite le Siège de son institution à prendre les dispositions nécessaires pour assurer le retour des personnes évacuées.

(b) Le Chef de mission fait connaître par écrit au Chef des services généraux la N° de vol et la date d'arrivée des intéressés.

IV. ELISABETHVILLE

Pour les experts affectés à Elisabethville, l'attestation de disponibilité d'un logement sera délivrée par l'Administrateur des affaires civiles d'Elisabethville.

V. INDEMNITE DE SUBSISTANCE EN CAS D'EVACUATION

Les conditions dans lesquelles cette indemnité sera payée ont été communiquées à toutes les Institutions par le Contrôleur financier adjoint des Nations-Unies (New-York) au moyen d'une lettre circulaire datée du 13 octobre 1964 dont copie vous a été transmise sous couvert de la circulaire LEO/ADMIN/CM.114. Toutes les questions relatives au droit à cette indemnité et au montant à payer seront réglées par le Chef de mission de l'expert et le Siège de son institution. Le Siège du BAT, Léopoldville, n'interviendra en cette matière que dans la mesure où l'institution correspondante l'en aura chargé.

VI. Sur recommandation unanime des Chefs de mission, j'ai fait figurer dans un câble adressé le 22 octobre 1964 au Cabinet du Secrétaire Général de l'ONU le paragraphe suivant:

"Etant donné que l'éventualité d'une autre évacuation ne peut être entièrement écartée, il serait opportun d'encourager les personnes évacuées à rester hors du Congo jusqu'à nouvel ordre, même si elles peuvent se prévaloir de cette autorisation de retour. Nous recommandons par conséquent que tous les membres du personnel et experts dont les familles demeureront hors du Congo conformément à un plan d'évacuation en vigueur continuent de percevoir l'indemnité de subsistance en cas d'évacuation pendant une période minimale de six mois, sous réserve d'une révision ultérieure. Quant à ceux qui décideront de rappeler les membres de leur famille au Congo, ils cesseront évidemment de percevoir cette indemnité dès l'arrivée de ces derniers."

La recommandation ci-dessus étant encore à l'étude entre le BAT et les institutions, je vous ferai connaître la réponse dès qu'elle me parviendra.
