In this connection I have taken note of your decision of 26 May that the price to be paid by Sedes and the other companies which will use these planes is the same as previously, namely C.F. 81,250 each one-way flight Leo-A'ville.

1. With regard to your letter of 24 May concerning the request from Amato Freres for aircraft to use in transporting food round-trip between Elisabethville, Luluabourg and Leopoldville, I have been informed by Air Operations that due to the refugee evacuation program, it is impossible to commit aircraft on a regular basis as requested.

2. On the other hand I have been informed by Air Operations that if they know in advance of aircraft which will be flying empty to Elisabethville, they will notify me as far in advance as possible. In practice I would think that this would mean not more than  $1\frac{1}{2}$  or two days notice, however, you might alert Amato Freres to this possibility.

3. Similarly, Dr. Jerkovic this morning has discussed with me the need for food to be transported to Albertville during the next few months and has indicated that Sedec has some sixty tons of food which it is prepared to fly to Albertville. Should this operation be considered to be desirable by Civilian Operations, I can undertake the same arrangement with Air Operations, i.e., that they would advise me of any aircraft flying to Albertville empty. On previous shipments for Sedec to Albertville I believe we have not collected the full rate, however, I would think that we should now endeavour to collect at least the amount which it costs us to fly the aircraft, if not the full Air Congo rates. You may wish to discuss this possibility with Sedec and advise me.

Les conditions auxquelles est soumise l'utilisation des appareils ONUC ne sont pas d'application pratique :

- les deux premières, à cause des formalités administratives et des délais qu'elles impliquent ;
- la troisième, parce qu'au niveau des tarifs officiels (et compte tenu de ce que la plupart des tarifs spéciaux ont été supprimés), les capacités de transport d'Air-Congo sont suffisantes.

.... Mais il n'empêche que des avions ONUC circulent à vide au dessus du Congo (Par exemple au début de cette semaine, un avion C 146, pouvant charger 6 Tonnes, est reparti à vide de Kamembe, vers Léopoldville).

Que proposer pour employer cette capacité de transport inutilisée ? Nous voyons deux solutions :

- 1/- Remplacer les 2 premières conditions par l'engagement du service aérien ONUC de rétrocéder à Air-Congo un certain pourcentage (20% par ex.) de ses recettes provenant de frets privés.  
De cette manière, l'ONUC et Air-Congo toucheraient des recettes extraordinaires. Le Brigadier S. Norstrom, Deputy Air-commander ONUC Air H.Q., que nous avons rencontré il y a quelques jours à Bukavu, nous a paru ouvert à une telle proposition. Cependant, nous craignons que cette proposition ne provoque guère de transports aériens supplémentaires (voir paragraphe b) ci-dessus).
- 2/- Remplacer les trois conditions par les propositions suivantes :
  - Etablir une liste de marchandises (produits agricoles, miniers, etc...) qui ne peuvent supporter les tarifs Air-Congo, mais dont le transport intéresse, soit une économie régionale (légumes du Kivu par ex.) ou l'économie congolaise (exportations rapportant des devises par ex.)
  - Ces marchandises pourraient être chargées sur des avions ONUC sans autre formalité.
  - l'ONUC leur appliquerait un tarif réduit.
 De cette manière, l'ONUC toucherait une recette extraordinaire, tout en ne faisant aucune concurrence à Air Congo, puisque de telles marchandises ne seraient, de toute façon, pas transportés par elle.
