

Subject: OPERATIONS TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE INDONESIAN CONTINGENT

Reference attached signal No.94/63 of 14 Jan 63, from Commander, Sector 'A' to you.

1. The Air Commander has already indicated to you his inability to photograph the bridges on the AVILLE/JADOTVILLE road, as, at this long range, S29 aircraft cannot operate. The Air Commander has accordingly advised Commander Sector 'A' to use his C47 aircraft at a minimum height of 3,000 ft to carry out road reconnaissance. At this height, with visual aid, we would only be able to know the number of bridges on the road and have a rough idea of their dimensions and capacity. It is impossible, therefore, for me to acquire adequate bridging equipment until such time as detailed information on the subject is made available.
2. Even if bridging equipment is made available for this operation, there are no engineer personnel that we can spare from our own resources. The only Field Coy with the Indian Bde is fully committed at present, and it has already detached a Section for operation with the Nigerian Brigade. As regards additional transport, we have already issued instructions for 15 3-ton vehicles, at present at KONGOLO, to be moved by road to KABALO and thereafter by train to AVILLE. I do not yet know the date on which these vehicles will reach AVILLE. Lt Col Negga has indicated the possibility of obtaining barges and assault boats locally at AVILLE. We have received certain information from Procurement on the subject, but this is very vague and we have asked Col Negga to obtain more specific information from AVILLE.
3. I must bring to your attention that, so far as we are aware, there is very little bridging equipment left with the ANC that we can get hold of at this moment. Therefore, should additional equipment be required, this must of necessity be obtained from N.Y. In addition, as it would not be possible for us to obtain air photographs, the local authorities should, if possible, obtain the necessary information from local bridging authorities. You may wish to inform Comdr Sector 'A' of the above.
