ONUC 1478

FIELDING FROM POLAR. YOUR 1445. REPAIRABLE R-1300-30 ENGINES FOR B-19  
HELICOPTERS. OUR UNDERSTANDING DOUBTS NOT INTERESTED. RIGHT UNDESIRABLE  
ENGINE IS COMPLETE TOTAL REPAIR. A WEEK HOURS ON OPERATING HELICOPTERS RUNNING  
OUT BUT IF NOTHING UNEXPECTED COMES BY WILL SEE OPERATION THROUGH TILL  
15 JUNE 1964. IF CIV OPS DO NOT HAVE ANY HELICOPTERS ALL SPARES AND ENGINES  
AVAILABLE SHOULD BE RETAINED FOR TRANSFER TO CIV OPS AND ESSENTIAL A MINIMUM  
OF FIVE ENGINES SHOULD BE DESIGNATED FOR OVERHAUL NOW. OTHERWISE CIV OPS  
WILL HAVE HELICOPTERS WHICH WILL PROBABLY BE GROUNDING BECAUSE OF LACK OF  
ENGINES. THIS HAS BEEN ADVISED TO CIV OPS. IN EVENT NO HELICOPTERS RETAINED  
BY CIV OPS RECOMMEND ALL SPARES AND ENGINES BE OFFERED WITH AIRCRAFT

1. I would very much appreciate your making available for the current refugee programme the following surplus stores:

2. The stores are to be used for the emergency reception centre for refugees who are the concern of the UNHCR located in Léopoldville-Kelina, 37 Avenue Valcke and operated by the Central Government's Ministry of Social Affairs in cooperation with my Office and with Voluntary Agencies assisting refugees.
3. Last week an unexpected influx of 30 refugees from the South African Union rendered the accommodation problem in the centre so critical that some newcomers had to be put up in detention camps pending emergency arrangements. Further arrivals have been signalled en route for Léopoldville.
4. I will arrange for transportation of the goods selected at your earliest convenience.

Phase-out Plan for ONUC PX Service

With reference to the minutes of the meeting held in New York on 8 May, subject ONUC PX Commissary, authorizing us to dispose of surpluses as declared in our letter to you dated 27 April 1964 (Exhibit 4), I have issued the necessary instructions to the ONUC PX Depot Leopoldville and ONUC PX Sub-Depot Elisabethville to segregate the surplus stocks for disposal.

As proposed in my Phase-out Plan of 26 March 1964, I should now like to reduce the merchandise selection to the proposed stock structure for the Commissary Co-operative, and declare the phase-out items surplus for disposal at the Civilian Field PX/Commissaries in Elisabethville, Stanleyville, Albertville, Coquilhatville, Luluabourg and Bukavu.

Since the Civilian Field PX/Commissaries are under the direct supervision of Administration, I shall appreciate having your authorization to issue the necessary instructions to them.

I intend to have an ONUC PX representative visit all Civilian Field PX/Commissaries from 25 May to assist, in co-operation with the Sales Unit of Purchasing and Supply, with the segregation of surplus merchandise.



As you may know the ITU Mission is re-organizing the telecommunications School for the Ministry of Postes et Télécommunications here in Leopoldville. Proposals have been submitted for financing of the school through the Special Fund and Counterpart Funds, covering the erection of residential school for some 250 students. We have need at the school of large quantities of furniture and fittings many items of which I understand are likely to become available at the BOD as surplus UN stores.

The items required comprise bedroom, furniture-beds, mattresses, cupboards, tables, chairs, mirrors; living room furniture - easy chairs, tables, stools; kitchen equipment-crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils, cooking stoves, refrigerators, cleaning material, classroom and laboratory furniture-tables, chairs stools cupboards.

In addition it is proposed to start a small school for wives of the students along the same lines as that being run at ENDA. For this purpose we need sewing machines, tables, benches, child's cots.

I appreciate that it will be necessary to await the normal formalities in clearing these stores however it would be an advantage to us if sufficient items could be set aside to meet our coordinated requirements rather than for the items to be distributed on a more random basis.

As you have been informed by my memorandum of 11 May 1964, we intend to provide the experts and staff of the TAB office with the same medical facilities as heretofore furnished by ONUC. For this purpose, I would appreciate it if you will take the following action:

1. Contract with Danish Medical Mission: Before ONUC rescinds this contract, please enter into negotiations with the Danish Medical Mission for continuing to provide the same services if possible on the same conditions as laid down in the Agreement. In this connexion and if the Danish Med Mission wishes to keep the furniture and equipment referred to in art. 6 of the Agreement of 9 September 1963, on a loan basis, kindly make the necessary arrangements for the transfer of such material from ONUC to the TAB office. Furthermore, please look into the possibility of transferring from ONUC stocks, if available, quantity of rations sufficient to cover the needs of hospitalised patients for a period of 12 months (art. 5 of the Agreement refers).
2. Ambulance: Arrangements for the transfer of two ambulances in good operating condition to the TAB office should be made in due course. Mr. Lesmi has already made a verbal request to this effect to Mr. Wyatt-John.
3. Caskets: If caskets are declared surplus to ONUC requirements, we will appreciate receiving a number of them.
4. Contract with Levanium Clinic - Embalming: A separate contract for the TAB office should be negotiated on the same terms as that for ONUC.
