U.N. Celebrates Birth of World's 5 Billionth Baby

—ZAGREB, Yugoslavia, July 11— U.N. Secretary General Javier Perez de Cuellar took newborn Matej Gaspar in his arms today and proclaimed him the world's 5 billionth person.

"It's a beautiful baby and I want to congratulate you," he told parents Sanja and Dragutin Gaspar shortly after Matej was born today.

No one knows for sure who the world's 5 billionth person really is, but the U.N. Fund for Population Activities had predicted that global population would reach 5 billion at about the time Matej came into the world.

More than 80 countries celebrated the United Nations' Day of the 5 Billion. Perez de Cuellar noted that 9 out of 10 children in the world are born in developing countries.

The U.N. population fund was trying to draw world attention to the growth in global population, which is speeding toward 6 billion by the year 2000.

—The fund said world population is growing at about 150 a minute, or 220,000 a day.
