

SUBJECT: Mr. S. Khan's Family Visit Travel and Mission

In regard to your query yesterday, I am pleased to attach the following copies of correspondence for your immediate information, hoping that these will clarify Mr. Khan's travel claim of January/February 1995.

- (a) Mr. Khan's code cable of 24 December 1994 requesting authorization for his travel plans, mission to Geneva/Paris and his family visit;
- (b) Mr. Annan's code cable of 12 January 1995 providing the authorization;
- (c) Mr. Hansen's code cable of 2 February 1995 requesting him to be present for Ms. Ogata's visit to the Great Lakes Region and more specifically to accompany her to Kinshasa, Zaire.

As you will note, Mr. Khan had to return from his family visit and travel directly from Nairobi to Kinshasa to meet with Ms. Ogata. The interruption of his family visit was at the specific request of Mr. Hansen.

In addition, the Security Council decided on 31 January 1995 to field a mission to Bujumbura and Kigali. By Mr. Annan's code cable of 6 February 1995, also attached, Mr. Khan was alerted that his presence was required in Kigali on 13 February 1995.

SUBJECT: ROUND TABLE CONFERENCE IN GENEVA - JANUARY 17-18

1. My 6-month home passage will become due on January 4th and I would like to visit Pakistan with 2 weeks leave and home passage in late January.
2. The UNDP Round Table Conference on Rwanda will take place in Geneva on 17th and 18th January. I have been invited by UNDP and the Rwandese government to attend the Conference and to make a brief address. I feel it would be important for me to attend the Conference.
3. Moreover, the next meeting of the Rwanda Contact Group will also be held in Geneva on 16th January i.e. on the eve of the Round Table Conference. It would be specially useful for me to attend that meeting as well.
4. Accordingly, I would be grateful for your approval for me to attend the above meetings in Geneva from 16-18 January. Thereafter I would like to pay a one-day visit to France which was the only country I could not cover during my last tour of Europe. I had indicated to the French government that I would visit the Quai d'Orsay during my next visit to Europe. I need to redeem my commitment.
5. After these visits, I would like to take my leave and home passage to Pakistan and would return to Kigali on the expiry of leave.




1. This is to inform you that the High Commissioner for Refugees, Mrs. Sadako Ogata, plans to visit the region of the Great Lakes to express her gratitude for the assistance Zaire, Uganda, Rwanda and Burundi have given to the UNHCR over the past months. While in Kinshasa, Mrs. Ogata will formally sign the agreement reached with the Government on arrangements to improve security in the refugee camps.

2. Mrs. Ogata will visit Kinshasa, Bukavu, Goma, Kigali, Kampala and Bujumbura from 9 to 14 February 1995. The Secretary-General wishes you, as his Special Representative for Rwanda, to accompany her to these places. We will let you know later the exact time of Mrs. Ogata's arrival in Kinshasa so that you can join her there.

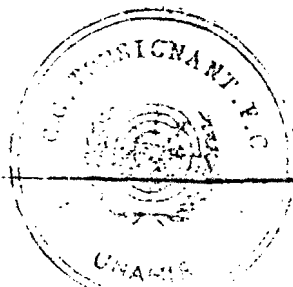

SUBJECT: Visit of Security Council mission

MS EIB-B-P 9-30

1. As a follow-up to its Presidential Statement of 31 January on Burundi (S/PRST/1995/5, copy of which was faxed to you on 1 February), and in order to underscore its concern about the deterioration of the situation in the country, the Security Council has decided to send a mission to Bujumbura. The mission is tentatively scheduled to depart New York on 8 February and to visit Bujumbura from 10 to 12 February.

2. Thereafter, the mission plans to pay a short visit to Kigali on 13 February, where it will expect to be briefed by you and the Force Commander on UNAMIR operations and to hold meetings (which you should tentatively schedule with information to HQ) with senior Government officials. Since no representative of this Department will be travelling with the mission, we trust that UNAMIR will make the necessary arrangements to support the mission during its visit to Kigali, providing whatever information they may require. A copy of the terms of reference for the mission's visit to Bujumbura and Kigali is attached for your information. The details of the mission ETA and ETD Kigali will be communicated to you as soon as they are finalized.



As a follow-up to its Presidential Statement of 31 January on Burundi (S/PRST/1995/5, copy of which was faxed to you on 1 February), and in order to underscore its concern about the deterioration of the situation in the country, the Security Council has decided to send a mission to Bujumbura. The mission is tentatively scheduled to depart New York on 8 February and to visit Bujumbura from 10 to 12 February.

2. Thereafter, the mission plans to pay a short visit to Kigali on 13 February, where it will expect to be briefed by you and the ~~Force Commander~~ on UNAMIR operations and to hold meetings (which you should tentatively schedule with information to HQ) with senior Government officials. Since no representative of this Department will be travelling with the mission, we expect that UNAMIR will make the necessary arrangements to support the mission during its visit to Kigali, providing whatever information they may require. A copy of the terms of reference for the mission's visit to Bujumbura and Kigali is attached for your information. The details of the mission ETA and DTD Kigali will be communicated to you as soon as they are finalized.

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Amnesty International calls for commission of inquiry for Burundi.
- Tanzanian army was reportedly ready to stop Burundian border violations.
- 10,000 Rwandans refugees were blocked at the Burundi-Tanzania border.
- The petrol strike in Rwanda ended.

## POLITICAL

On 14 June, Rwandan Prime Minister Twagiramungu issued a communique stating that he had not received a formal letter of resignation from his former director of cabinet, he learnt about his defection through the press. The Prime Minister reportedly added that Rwanda's problems could only be resolved through truth and political realism, he regretted the lack of courage and patience demonstrated by such a high ranking political leader.

## MILITARY

On 14 June, the Malawi Company reported that RPA soldiers killed eleven persons coming from Zaire, at 2000 hours (local time) on 12 June, at RWARAMBA. Increased patrolling by the RPA was reported in BURGAMBA Sector along the Burundi border by MILOBS. Reports regarding banditry continued from all over Rwanda.

On 15 June, Zairian News Agency *AZAP* reported that more than 100 Zairians have been killed since the start of June, by Hutu extremist militias and the former Rwandan army exiled in the country. "More than 100 people, all locals, have been slain in cold blood by former soldiers and the Interhamwe (militia) in the WALIKALE district". (AFP)

On 16 June, Tanzania's Prime Minister Msuya said that Tanzania's armed forces have been put on a state of readiness to counter any further incursions into its territory by the Burundian army. "Our defence and security forces are firmly in position and we are going to send reinforcements, our decision to close the border still stands and we will continue repatriating the more than 700,000 Rwandan and Burundian refugees in the country", Msuya told parliament. (AFP)

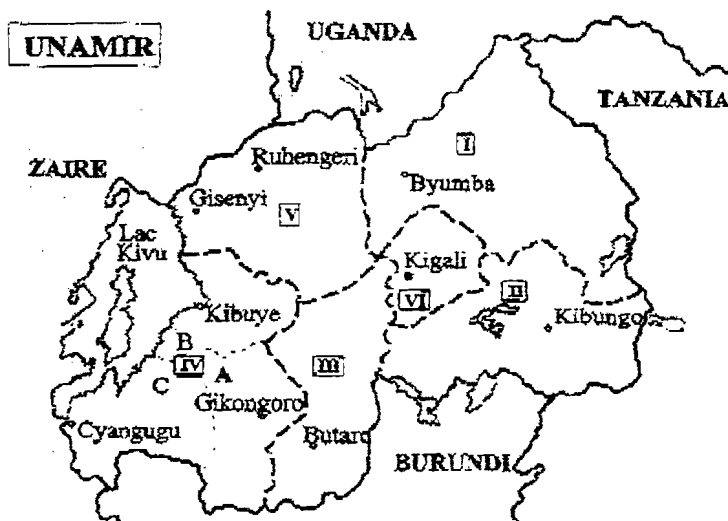

On 15 June, the International Scientific and Technical Committee, supported by the WHO team in Zaire, reported a slight increase in the number of cases of Ebola hemorrhagic fever. The total now stands at 280 confirmed or suspected cases, including 220 deaths, since the start of the epidemic.

**BURUNDI:** On 15 June, Amnesty International called for a commission of inquiry for Burundi and said that immediate international action is vital to stop Burundi's army and gunmen massacring civilians. "The fact that killings continue with no one brought to justice is fueling the tensions and setting the stage for more human rights abuses." (REUTER)

On 16 June, UN official informed the press that Tanzanian troops have stopped up to 10,000 Rwandan refugees attempting to cross the border from troubled north-eastern Burundi. The official added that the exodus of refugees from MUGANO camp in north-eastern Burundi started on 14 June. By 15 June, the numbers had swelled to between 8,000 and 10,000 on the road and at the border. (REUTER)

**LOGISTICS**

The petrol strike in Rwanda ended, UNAMIR has received four days of petrol stocks and further supplies are expected within the next two days.

GENERAL

1. Mr Aldo Ajello, Special Envoy of the Secretary General, is tentatively scheduled to arrive in Kigali on the UNAMIR flight Tuesday 20 June 95. The Chief of Protocol is currently making arrangements for him to meet with VP Kagame at the earliest opportunity.
2. I have also requested that the Executive Director begin establishing liaisons with the governments of Zaire, Burundi, Uganda and Tanzania to prepare meetings between Mr Ajello and these four Heads of State.
3. Mr Ajello also desires to meet with Mr Ian Douglas (UNHCR) in Nairobi on Monday 19 June 95 and arrangements have been made to that effect.

INFORMATION PACKAGE

4. Upon Mr Ajello's arrival in Kigali on Tuesday 20 Jun 95, I request that he be handed a reading package that will contain the following information:
  - a. Current operational situation in Rwanda (OPI is Maj Pitre);
  - b. Current situation in the Refugee Camps in neighbouring countries (OPI is Maj Ndiaye);
  - c. Documentation from UNHCR (OPI is Mr Khassime Diagne);
  - d. Reports from the previous rounds of consultations in Zaire and

*Review to provide info.*

Tanzania (OPI is ~~Mr~~ Buo, the political officer assigned to Mr Ajello); and

- e. Estimate of personnel and equipment required for the establishment of Military Observers in neighbouring countries (OPI is Col Nelson).

5. Lt-Col Blanchette, the military officer assigned to Mr Ajello, is tasked to coordinate the preparation of this reading package. Accordingly, OPIs are requested to provide these documents to Lt-Col Blanchette (MA to FC) no later than 1000 hrs, Monday 19 June 95.

#### BRIEFING

6. The briefing to Mr Ajello is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday 20 June 95 at a time to be determined. The briefing, in the main conference room, should take approximately one and a half hour and will include the following:

- a. Word of welcome (FC - 5 min);
- b. Scope of the presentation (Lt-Col Blanchette - 5 min);
- c. Current operational situation in Rwanda (Maj Pitre - 15 min);
- d. Current developments in the Refugee Camps in neighbouring countries (UNHCR representative - 15 min);
- e. G2 estimate of the situation in Refugee Camps in neighbouring countries (Maj Ndiaye - 15 min);
- f. Review of past political negotiations and humanitarian aspects related to refugee situation in neighbouring countries (Mr Dao - 15 min); and
- g. Estimate of personnel and material requirements to establish a viable observer group outside of Rwandan territory (Col Nelson - 10 min).

7. This briefing should not be a repetition of the written material that Mr Ajello may or may not have had time to read. Rather, it should be aimed at outlining the most important factors that Mr Ajello should be aware of before embarking on his mission. Heads of Departments and personnel with specific interest in Mr Ajello's mission are requested to attend.

#### SCHEDULE

8. The schedule will remain flexible since Mr Ajello's preferences are yet to be known and will depend on appointments with other dignitaries. Timings will be promulgated as soon as possible. Your cooperation is appreciated.
