
Dear Mr. Succar:



L. OCEAN TRANSPORTATION

Ocean Transportation

1. The cost of ocean transportation (Code 950) on U.S. flag vessels, and the cost of other services (Code 940) furnished in connection with the shipment of the commodities authorized herein, although not paid by the suppliers of the commodities, are also eligible for reimbursement hereunder.

2. 
