Greetings and appreciation

It's been one year since the fall of Mosul

It is no secret what is occurring in the Middle East and North Africa; Christian and Yazidi communities, as well as historically coexisting ethnicities are being targeted for extermination. Today, they are exposed to the worst attacks from ISIS; heinous acts that constitute crimes against humanity, genocide, ethnic and cultural cleansing. This is occurring across the Middle East, but particularly in the Nineveh Plains, (Mosul, Iraq) and Khabour (Syria), which are under the control of ISIS. ISIS has displaced hundreds of thousands of innocent people, destroyed historic monasteries, destroyed churches, destroyed historical artefacts, destroyed ancient Assyrian Sites (Nimrod, Assur, Dur-Sharrukin and Nineveh) and abducted defenceless woman, children and the elderly. ISIS looting has led to the displacement of more than two hundred thousand Chaldean Syriac Assyrian people from Mosul and the Nineveh Plains and more than three hundred thousand Yazidis. The Iraqi government and the international community have thus far neglected to take responsibility for the displaced in terms of providing shelter, relief and care. This has resulted in the migration of tens of thousands of families into neighbouring countries in hope of permanent migration.

Following these tragic events, the European Parliament ratified a resolution on March 12, 2015, condemning ISIS for their crimes. The international community was called to provide a protected zone and a safe haven for our people and the rest of the ethnicities that coexist in the Nineveh Plains.

Zowaa Inc, which is affiliated with the Assyrian Democratic Movement, Iraq's largest Chaldean Syriac Assyrian political party, welcomes the decision of the European Parliament and urges you to adopt the resolution. We urge the US Congress to issue a binding decision to provide international protection and a safe haven for our fellow Chaldean Syriac Assyrian people (Christians) in the Nineveh Plains. Also, we call on the international coalition to rapidly liberate our people, create conditions for the return of the displaced people, supply aid and give them reassurance of lasting stability in their areas. We hope this call harbors the attention and support of your honourable council.
