3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. RPA the RPA continued to conduct patrols and mount road blocks throughout the country.

(1) TAC HQ reported that an RPA patrol arrested an RPA soldier who had escaped from custody. The man was arrested in BUTARE at 060955B Nov 94 after a warning shot had been fired.

(2) MILOBs in Sector 3 investigated reports that RPA soldiers had robbed a shop in NTOGWE (GR 9157) on 05 Nov 94. RPA provost troops have arrested an RPA section cmd in connection with the offence.

c. MILITIA MILOBs have reported that 2 men were wounded in an attack in KABURAMERA (GR 6111, Sector 3). The attack is suspected to have been carried out by the militia.

4. MISCELLANEOUS INCIDENTS

a. GHANBATT reported that about 18 locals and 5 RPA soldiers from MBASA (GR 5410) killed a shepherd in CYAFURWE (GR 5317) on 051514B Nov 94. The group then stole 39 cows

and 31 sheep that had belonged to the dead man.

b. In Sector 4A a young man was reported to have been killed by unknown assailants between KIBEHO (GR 5007) and RWAMIKO (GR 9913) on 052000B Nov 94. An investigation into the incident is ongoing.

5. ASSESSMENT

a. The number of reported incidents involving the RPA carrying out robberies and other attacks remains fairly constant. These incidents will continue to create an atmosphere of mistrust and fear among the inhabitants of the areas concerned. The RPA would appear to be taking steps to improve the discipline of its troops (See Para 3a) which should lead to an improvement in relations between locals and the RPA.

FLAGS

1. Various matters affecting the operation and administration of UNAMIR and relations between the Force and the Government of Rwanda are governed by a Status of Mission Agreement. This Agreement gives UNAMIR certain rights but also imposes certain responsibilities. If we expect to enjoy the rights and privileges accorded to us, it follows that we must scrupulously observe the duties and responsibilities placed upon us.

2. Article IV, paragraph 8 of the Agreement states:

The Government recognizes the right of UNAMIR to display within Rwanda the United Nations flag on its headquarters, camps or other premises, vehicles, vessels and otherwise as decided by the Special Representative. Other flags or pennants may be displayed only in exceptional circumstances. In these cases, UNAMIR shall give sympathetic consideration to observations or requests of the Government.

3. It has been noted that a number of contingents have adopted the practice of flying their own national flags on their locations, in addition to the United Nations flag; this clearly falls outside the terms of the Agreement and is to cease.
