1. GEN SITUATION

a. THE SITUATION IN KIGALI WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. DISPLACED PERSONS ARE STILL LEAVING THE CAPITAL FOR THEIR VILLAGES. MANY MORE DISPLACED PERSONS AND REFUGEES ARE RETURNING TO KIGALI IN SMALL GROUPS.

b. MANY RETURNEES CROSSED THE BORDERS WITH HEAD-LOADS INTO THE COUNTRY DURING THE PERIOD.

c. WITHIN THE CAPITAL, LIFE IS GRADUALLY PICKING UP. WATER STILL FLOWS TO SOME HOMES AT FEW SUBURBS DURING THE PERIOD. ROAD REPAIRS IS ALSO BEING CARRIED OUT IN THE CAPITAL.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. THE GOVERNMENT CONTINUED TO ENCOURAGE RWANDESE REFUGEES OUTSIDE THE COUNTRY TO RETURN HOME. THE GOVERNMENT ALSO REFUTED RUMOURS THAT RPA ELEMENTS HAVE BEEN CARRYING OUT RETALIATORY KILLINGS AND SAID THAT ANY CAUGHT OR REPORTED OF INVOLVING IN THIS ACT WILL FACE THE FULL RIGOURS OF THE LAW.

a. THE SITUATION IN KIGALI WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. DISPLACED PERSONS ARE STILL LEAVING THE CAPITAL FOR THEIR VILLAGES. MANY MORE DISPLACED PERSONS AND REFUGEES ARE RETURNING TO KIGALI IN SMALL GROUPS.

b. MANY RETURNEES CROSSED THE BORDERS WITH HEAD-LOADS INTO THE COUNTRY DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN THE SECTOR DURING THE PERIOD. ABOUT 3,000 DISPLACED PERSONS MAINLY FROM KIGALI WERE FOUND IN THE RUTARE CAMP STILL AWAITING TRANSPORT TO RETURN TO KIGALI.

c. KIGALI MILOB SECTOR

(1) MILOBS ESCORTED AMERICAN DELEGATION TO KIBUNGO TO MONITOR THE REFUGEE SITUATION IN THE AREA. MANY DISPLACED PERSONS AND REFUGEES WERE FOUND LIVING IN THE AREA WHILE SOME ARE STILL ON THE MOVE ALONG THE ROADS.

(2) MILOBS ESCORTED TWO AMERICANS TO RUSUMO AND THE REFUGEE CAMP AT NGARA IN TANZANIA. ABOUT 5,000 REFUGEES WERE REPORTED TO BE LIVING IN THE CAMP. MANY MORE REFUGEES WERE REPORTED TO BE ENTERING THE CAMP. SERIOUS SHORTAGE OF WATER WAS REPORTED IN THE CAMP. UNREOS WERE REPORTED TO BE ATTENDING TO THE REFUGEES IN THE CAMP.

d. MILOB SECTOR 4 - CYANGUGU. THIS SECTOR WAS REPORTED TO BE CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

1. GEN SITUATION

a. THE SITUATION IN KIGALI WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. DISPLACED PERSONS ARE STILL LEAVING THE CAPITAL FOR THEIR VILLAGES. DISPLACED PERSONS AND REFUGEES ARE RETURNING TO KIGALI IN SMALL GROUPS.

b. THERE WERE REPORTS OF THOUSANDS OF RETURNEES CROSSING THE BORDERS WITH HEAD-LOADS ENTERING THE COUNTRY DAILY.

c. WITHIN THE CAPITAL, LIFE IS GRADUALLY RETURNING TO NORMAL. WATER FLOWED TO SOME HOMES AT FEW SUBURBS DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RECCE PLANNED FOR SECTOR 3 (GITARAMA/BUTARE AREA) WAS CARRIED OUT ON 01 AUG 94 IN PREPARATION FOR MILOBS DEPLOYMENT.

b. MILOB SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN THE SECTOR DURING THE PERIOD. PEOPLE WERE SEEN RETURNING TO THEIR VILLAGES. ABOUT 2,000 DISPLACED PERSONS ARE STILL AT MUHURA AWAITING SECURITY CLEARANCE TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMES.

(3) KIZINGURO HOSPITAL IS NOW TURNED INTO A MILITARY HOSPITAL AND ENTRY INTO THE HOSPITAL PREMISES IS RESTRICTED.

(4) MURAMBI CAMP TO BE CLOSED SOON BECAUSE THE OCCUPANTS HAVE GONE BACK TO THEIR HOMES.

(5) GAHINI HOSPITAL IS NOW OPERATING AS THE MAIN HOSPITAL IN THE EASTERN SECTOR OF RWANDA. THE COMMONEST DISEASES IN THE AREA ARE MALARIA AND DYSENTERY. NGOS ARE STILL OPERATING IN THE AREAS.

c. KIGALI MILOB SECTOR

(1) MILOBS ESCORTED FRENCH LIAISON OFFICER TO PLACES WITHIN KIGALI DURING THE PERIOD.



(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT RECCE TO THE SOUTHERN AND SOUTH-WESTERN AREAS OF RWANDA DURING THE PERIOD. THE TEAMS COVERED KIBUNGO TO TANZANIA BORDER AREAS IN THE SOUTH AND BUGESERA TO BURUNDI BORDER AREAS IN THE SOUTH-WEST. THE AREAS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN SPARSELY POPULATED AND ONLY A FEW PEOPLE WERE SEEN IN THE HITHERTO THICKLY POPULATED CENTRES LIKE KIBUNGO AND BUGESERA.

(3) ONLY FEW PEOPLE HAVE RETURNED HOME. THE RETURNEES SAY THAT THE MILITIAS ARE STILL HIDING IN THE BUSHES AND THIS IS PREVENTING THEM FROM RETURNING TO RWANDA. IN ADDITION, THE RETURNEES SAID THAT THE REFUGEE CAMPS IN TANZANIA ARE SITED NOT LESS THAN 100 KMS FROM THE BORDER AND THERE IS NO TRANSPORT AND FOOD AND WATER SUPPLIES ALONG THE ROUTE. RETURNING TO RWANDA IS EXTREMELY DIFFICULT FOR THEM.

(4) IN KABUKUBA REFUGEE CAMP, THERE WERE ABOUT 7,000 REFUGEES WHO SAID THEY WERE FROM KIGALI, KIBUNGO AND KABUGA. MOST OF THEM SAID THEY ARE WAITING FOR THE SECURITY SITUATION TO IMPROVE BEFORE THEY RETURN. THE HUMANITARIAN SITUATION IN THE CAMP IS BEING HANDLED BY NGOS IN THE AREA.

d. MILOB SECTOR 4 - CYANGUGU. THIS SECTOR WAS REPORTED TO BE CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

e. MILOB SECTOR 5 - GISENYI. THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.



SUBJECT: SITREP COVERING THE PERIOD 010600B AUG TO 011800B AUG 94

1. **GEN SITUATION.** THE SITUATION IN KIGALI AND ITS SUBURBS REMAINED CALM. SOME TAXIES AND MINIBUSES APPEARED IN THE CITY. MANY TRADERS RETURN TO THE CITY. THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ANNOUNCED THROUGH RADIO THAT WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE ARRIVED GERMAN SPECIALISTS THE PROBLEM OF ELECTRICITY SUPPLY WOULD BE SOLVED WITH IN A MONTH.

2. **FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.**

a. **POLITICAL.** ACCORDING TO THE LOCAL RADIO THE NEW RWANDESE GOVERNMENT AGREED WITH ZAIRE AUTHORITIES ON RAPID RETURN OF THE REFUGEES FROM GOMA TO RWANDA.

b. **MILITARY.** THE LOCAL RADIO BROADCAST THAT ZAIRE AGREED TO DISARM THE FORMER RGF TROOPS IN ITS TERRITORY. THEY WILL ALSO HAND OVER THE ARMS AND AMMO COLLECTED FROM THE DISARMED SOLDIERS AND LATER ON MAKE THE FORMER SOLDIERS RETURN HOME.

3. **OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.**

a. **MILOB GP HQ.**

(1) COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOB ACTIVITIES CONTINUED DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) 1 X MILOB TEAM WAS SENT TO BUTARE AND GITARAMA TO CARRY OUT RECONNAISSANCE OF THE GENERAL AREA PRIOR TO THE DEPLOYMENT OF MILOBS IN THAT AREA. THE TEAM LEFT KIGALI IN THE MORNING AND RETURNED SAFE AND SOUND.

b. **MILOB SECTOR 1- ~~BYUMBA.~~**

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED TO BE CALM.



(2) PATROL CARRIED OUT IN BYUMBA, KISARO, KIVUYE, NYAMBARE. INFO RECEIVED ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(a) IN KISARO DISPLACED PERSONS NUMBERING APPROX 8000 MAINLY FROM COMMUNE NEAR KIGALI ARE WAITING TO RETURN TO THEIR HOMES. THE ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF HAVE REQUESTED TO PROVIDE TRANSPORT FOR THE PERSONS TO RETURN AND TO START THE EXERCISE.

(b) ICRC IS EXPECTED TO DISTRIBUTE FOOD TODAY IN KISARO. ALL OTHER CAMPS IN THE AREA ARE CLOSED.

(c) IN KIVUYE SITUATION WAS NORMAL AND PEOPLE ARE RETURNING TO THEIR HOMES.

c. KIGALI MILOB SECTOR. 1 X MILOB WAS SENT TO MIRAMA HILLS TO ESCORT APC CONVOY TO KIGALI.

d. MILOB SECTOR 5 - CYANGUGU. THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED TO BE CALM.



1. GEN SITUATION

1. WITNESS/VICTIM THAT DID ESCAPE THE KILLING REPORTED TO GIKONGBORO AND WAS QUESTIONED BY FF AND UNAMIR OFFICERS.

2. FACTS ARE THE FOLLOWING:

A. 26 JULY 0900 8 PERSONS WERE TRAVELLING IN VEHICLE FROM GIKONGBORO TO BUTARE, ONE OF THEM BEING KNOWN AS A FORMER INTERAMUE. AVERAGE AGE OF THE GROUP IS 25.

B. 26 JULY 1000 STOPPED AT ROADBLOCK, OTHER PEOPLES MAINLY WOMEN AND CHILDREN DID NOT HAVE DIFFICULTY TO CROSS. THEY WERE SEARCHED, ARRESTED AND THEIR ARMS TIED WITH A ROPE INDIVIDUALLY. THEIR DOCUMENTS LIKE ID WERE SEIZED.

C. 26 JULY 1030 AN OTHER GROUP OF FOUR SOLDIERS CAME WITH A TOYOTA ILUX TRUCK TO PICK THEM UP AND PLACE THEM LYING IN THE TRUCK. THE TRUCK WAS MOVING VERY SLOWLY AND IN THE MEAN TIME THE PRISONERS WERE BEATEN WITH RIFLES BUTT AND THE SOLDIERS WERE WALKING ON THEM. THE GROUP COMMANDER WAS WEARING A CAMOUFLAGE UNIFORM, COMBAT BOOTS AND A PISTOL THE OTHERS HAD RIFLES AND WERE WEARING RUBBER BOOTS. THEY DID TRAVEL MOST OF THE DAY UNTIL 2100 AND THEN STOPPED AT GAKO GRID 6618

D. THEY WERE BROUGHT INTO A HOUSE UNDER CONSTRUCTION AS WELL AS OTHERS IN THE VICINITY. THE HOUSE HAD METAL BARS AT THE WINDOWS. IN THAT HOUSE THEY JOINED IN A ROOM A GROUP OF ABOUT 20 OTHER PERSONS ALSO WITH ARMS TIED. A NEW GROUP OF ABOUT FOUR SOLDIERS WERE GUARDING THE PLACE. THEN ROCKS AND BRICKS WERE THROWN AT THEM THROUGH THE WINDOWS BY SOLDIERS INITIALLY AND AFTER BY GIRLS AGED BETWEEN 18 TO 25. THEY SPEND THE NIGHT AND THE DAY IN THAT ROOM WITHOUT BEING FED

E. 27 JULY 2300 SOME OF THE OTHER PEOPLES WERE TAKEN OUT OF THE ROOM IN GROUP OF TWO. IN THE GROUP OF THE WITNESS FOUR WERE TAKEN AWAY WITH THE PRETEXT OF BRINGING THEM TO BUTARE. THE WITNESS AND THE LAST THREE OF HIS GROUP WERE ALSO BROUGHT OUTSIDE LATER LEAVING INSIDE ABOUT TEN PERSONS. WHILE THEY WERE ESCORTED OUTSIDE THE WITNESS HEARD THE SOLDIERS SAYING WHILE THEY WERE NEAR AN OUTSIDE TOILET THAT THEY WOULD NEED TO GO TO THE NEXT ONE BECAUSE THIS ONE WAS FULL OF BODIES. THEY WERE SITTED ALL THE FOUR OF THEM NEAR A 3 METERS DEEP HOLE WITH A DIAMETER OF 1.5 METERS. AT THAT MOMENT ONE SOLDIER WITH AN AXE START HITTING THEM ON THE HEAD WITH THE DULL SIDE OF THE AXE WHILE TWO OTHERS WERE HOLDING THEM. THEY WERE THROWN IN THE HOLE, THE WITNESS BEING LAST.
