Dear Professor Honnefelder,

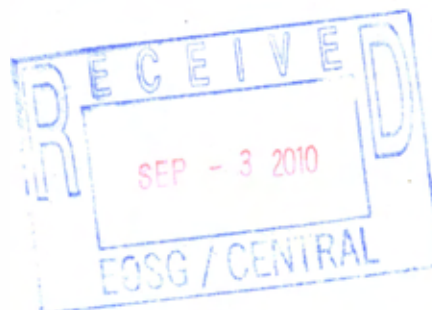

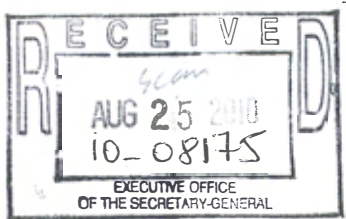
