1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE TENSE SITUATION PRESENT IN THE SOUTHERN COMMUNES ALONG THE COAST APPEARS TO BE SPREADING INWARD(COMMUNE OF MWENDO); HOWEVER, IN THE NORTH(RUTSIRO AND KIVUMU COMMUNES) THE SITUATION REMAINS CALM.
2. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES. NTR.
3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.
  - A. RPA.
    - (1) CONTINUING WITH DAY AND NIGHT FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS.
    - (2) TRAINING IS IN PROGRESS IN KIBUYE.
    - (3) THE STRENGTH OF THE RPA DEPLOYMENT IN BOTH MUBUGA(GR 2463) AND NGOMA(GR 2159) HAS INCREASED DURING THE PAST TWO WEEKS. THE EXACT NEW STRENGTH IS NOT KNOWN BUT BOTH MILOBS AND LOCALS HAVE NOTICED THIS INCREASE.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.
  - A. DUE TO LACK OF VEHICLES(SEE PARA 7) ONLY ONE PATROL WAS SENT OUT TODAY. THIS PATROL WENT SOUTH TO THE SECTEUR OF MPEMBE(GR 1766). ENROUTE THE TEAM STOPPED IN AND MET WITH THE NEW BOURGEMEISTER OF GISHYITA. AS WELL AS USUAL COMMUNE INFORMATION THEY ASKED HIM ABOUT THE TWELVE PEOPLE ARRESTED SOME DAYS AGO. HE SAID THAT HE WAS ONLY AWARE OF SIX AND WHILE HE WAS CORDIAL HE WAS NOT OVERLY FORTHCOMING WITH INFORMATION. ON ARRIVAL IN KAMALIB(GR 1861) THEY OBSERVED A GATHERING OF PEOPLE THAT WERE TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE LOCAL RPA COMPANY COMMANDER. HE WAS ATTEMPTING TO RECONCILE A DISAGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SECTEUR OF NGOMA AND MPEMBE. THE TEAM PROCEEDED TO THE END OF THE PENINSULA AND WERE STOPPED BY THE RPA

COMMANDER IN THE AREA WHO SAID THAT THE TEAM HAD TO HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM HIS COY COMD TO TRAVEL THERE. THIS WAS SORTED OUT AND THEY PROCEEDED. THE LOCALS IN THE AREA EXPRESSED A LOT OF CONCERN FOR THEIR SAFETY WITH RESPECT TO THE RPA. THEY SAY ARRESTS ARE VERY COMMON NOW AND THEY ARE LIVING IN FEAR.

THE LOCALS EXPRESSED WHAT CAN BE TERMED AS A RUMOUR THAT THE RGF ARE GOING TO RETURN ON 7 APR AND RECOMMENCE THE WAR.

B. THE OPS 0 AND ONE OTHER RETURNED FROM THERE INTERSECTOR PATROL TO GITARAMA. THE PRESENT DETERIORATING SITUATION IN THIS SECTOR WAS DISCUSSED IN ADDITION TO HUMANITARIAN ISSUES. THE SECTOR COMD IN GITARAMA NOW HAS ALL THE REQUIRED DETAILS TO TAKE OVER KIBUYE PREFECTURE AS A SUB-SECTOR OF SECTOR 3.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THE ORPHANS THAT WERE MOVED TO THE TWO LOCATIONS OF KIBUYE AND NGOMA YESTERDAY WERE VISITED BY THE HUMANITARIAN OFFICER TODAY AND WERE FOUND TO BE IN GOOD SPIRITS.

6. CIVIL AFFAIRS. THE PREFECT OF KIBUYE WAS TO ATTEND A MEETING WITH RPA IN CYANGUGU TOMORROW HOWEVER HIS VEHICLE IS BEING REPAIRED AND NO HELICOPTER WAS AVAILABLE. HE WILL TRY AGAIN NEXT WEEK.

7. LOGISTICS. UNAMIR VEH'S 1080, 1084, 1118 AND 1278 ARE IN THE WORKSHOP AWAITING MAINTENANCE/REPAIR. YESTERDAY, VEH 1082 WAS TAKEN TO KIGALI WORKSHOP TODAY FOR OIL CHANGE. THE BATTERY FROM VEH 1004 WHICH BELONGS TO VEH 1084 WAS TAKEN TO KIGALI TOO TO EQUIP THAT VEH 1084. TODAY THE SECTOR HAS TWO VEHs: ONE TOYOTA 4-RUNNER AND ONE TOYOTA PICK-UP. AS A RESULT ONLY ONE PATROL COULD BE SENT OUT.

THE PURPOSE OF THAT MEETING IS UNKNOWN.  
THE TEAM MANAGED TO VISIT THE DETENTION CENTRE IN BWAKIRA. THERE WERE ABOUT 55 PRISONERS IN THREE CELLS IN VERY BAD CONDITIONS. WITHIN THEM THE FIRST WERE PUT INTO JAIL TWO MONTHS AGO, THE LATEST WERE ARRESTED LAST WEEK. THE PRISONERS ARE AWAITING THE TRANSPORT FOR DELIVERING TO

GITARAMA. THE POLICE WHICH RUNS THE CENTRE COULD NOT PROVIDE FOOD FOR PRISONERS. THEY SUFFER OF THE EYE DISEASE. THE TEAM REPORTED THAT MANY PRISONERS HAVE SIGNS OF TORTURES. THE INSPECTOR OF THE CENTRE ASKED UNAMIR FOR HELP IN DELIVERING PRISONERS TO GITARAMA.

36 POLICEMEN IN BWAKIRA WERE PAID RECENTLY FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY.

THE TEAM REPORTED THAT RETURNEES WERE QUEUING IN THE COMMUNE OFFICE FOR REGISTRATION FOR HOUSES AND HOES AND SEEDS. THE LOCAL POPULATION FACES THE LACK OF FOOD AND HOES. LOCAL AUTHORITIES REQUESTED TO DELIVER 8 TONS OF PAM FOOD FROM KIBUYE (2772) TO BIRAMBO (4673).

B. ANOTHER TEAM WENT FOR INTERSECTOR PATROL TO GITARAMA AND IS EXPECTED TO RETURN TOMORROW.

MILOBS AND MALAWI COY ASSISTED IN TRANSPORTING CHILDREN TO THE ORPHANAGES OF KIBUYE (2772) AND NOMA (2159). THE TRUCKS WHICH ARE TRANSPORTING THE CHILDREN HAVE NOT RETURNED SO FAR. THEREFORE EXACT FIGURES OF CHILDREN MOVEMENT WILL BE REPORTED IN TOMORROW SITREP.

SWISS DISASTER RELIEF (SDR) WAS DISTRIBUTING HOES TO THE LOCAL POPULATION IN KIBUYE FOR 200 FRANKS EACH.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE TENSE SITUATION PRESENT IN THE SOUTHERN COMMUNES ALONG THE COAST APPEARS TO BE SPREADING INWARD (COMMUNE OF MWENDO); HOWEVER, IN THE NORTH (RUTSIRO AND KIVUMU COMMUNES) THE SITUATION REMAINS CALM.

3. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.
  - A. RPA.
    - (1) CONTINUING WITH DAY AND NIGHT FOOT AND MOBILE PATROLS.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES.
  - A. ONE PATROL WENT NORTH TO THE COMMUNE OF RUTSIRO. THEY VISITED THE HEALTH CENTRE IN KABONA (GR 4385) AND FOUND THEM IN NEED OF MEDICINE, WATER, ELECTRICITY AND RENOVATIONS. THIS HOSPITAL IS RUN BY MEMISA. THEIR FOOD IS DELIVERED TO THE CARITAS HEALTH CENTRE IN RUTSIRO BUT CANNOT BE DELIVERED DUE TO LACK OF TRANSPORT. FOLLOWING THAT THEY VISITED TWO SCHOOLS; ONE WAS IN GAKETI (GR 4285) AND THE OTHER WAS IN MACUCA (GR 4282). BOTH SCHOOLS LACK EVERYTHING

AND THE TEACHERS HAVE NOT BEEN PAID SINCE DECEMBER.

B. A SECOND PATROL WENT SOUTHEAST TO MUTUNTU (GR 3553). THE SITUATION THERE HAS BECOME WORSE THROUGHOUT THE LAST THREE WEEKS. THE TEAM SPOKE TO A VERY RELIABLE SOURCE WHO GAVE THEM THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

i) THERE HAS BEEN A NOTICEABLE MOVEMENT OF PEOPLE FROM GISOVU AND GISHYITA COMMUNE INTO MWENDO COMMUNE FOR FEAR OF THE SITUATION IN THESE COMMUNES. MOST OF THESE PEOPLE ARRIVE WITH ACCUSATIONS OF HARASSMENT FROM THE RPA.

ii) TWO DAYS AGO FOUR LADIES WERE ABDUCTED BY THE RPA AND RAPED. NAMES WERE NOT GIVEN.

iii) FOUR OR FIVE DAYS AGO, DURING THE EVENING SEVEN PEOPLE WERE ABDUCTED BY THE RPA AND TAKEN INTO THE FOREST AROUND MUTUNTU. ONE OF THEM ESCAPED AND REMAINED IN THE AREA FOR TWO HOURS. HE HEARD THE RPA SHOT THE OTHER SIX PEOPLE. UPON RETURN TO MUTUNTU HE SPOKE ABOUT THE INCIDENT AND THEN FLED IN FEAR OF HIS LIFE.

iv) THE NUMBER OF ARRESTS IN THE AREA HAS RISEN DRAMATICALLY IN THE PAST FEW WEEKS. ALTHOUGH THE LOCALS WERE WILLING TO SAY THAT THERE WERE A LOT OF CLANDESTINE PRISONS IN THE AREA THEY WERE NOT WILLING TO SAY WHERE THEY WERE OR WHO HAD BEEN ARRESTED.

C. THE MALAWI COY ARRIVED LAST NIGHT AND ATTEMPTED TO OCCUPY THE ACCOMMODATION OF SENBAT. THE TECHNICAL SCHOOL THAT THEY WERE IN WAS CLOSED TO THE COY BY THE PREFECT. IN ADDITION IT APPEARS THAT THIS HEADQUARTERS WILL HAVE TO USE A WEATHER HAVEN AS ITS OFFICE AS THE PREFECT SAYS THERE IS NO AVAILABLE HOUSE OR BUILDING IN KIBUYE FOR US. THE PREFECT HAS BECOME A LOT MORE INFLEXIBLE REGARDING ANY ISSUES BROUGHT TO HIM IN RECENT WEEKS.

AS A RESULT WE HAVE HAD A VEH IN THE WORKSHOP FOR THREE DAYS SITTING IDLE. THIS TYPE OF ACTION IS UNACCEPTABLE.

WELL WITH THE GUIDANCE OF MEMISA. THEY NOW HAVE TWO DOCTORS AND ARE FUNCTIONING SUPERBLY. THEY HAVE SAID THAT THEY ARE GOING TO ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CLINIC IN RUTSIRO WHICH IS IN DESPERATE CONDITION. AT BWIZA, THE TEAM DID NOT TOUCH DOWN AS TIME WAS SHORT BUT AN OVERFLIGHT OF THE AREA REVEALED THAT THERE WAS VERY LITTLE ACTIVITY IN THIS SECTEUR.

B. A SECOND PATROL WENT TO THE TOWN OF RWAMATAMU(GR1557). AS THE BOURGEMEISTER WAS NOT THERE THEY WENT SEE THE ASSISTANT BOURGEMEISTER. AGAIN HE WAS UNCOOPERATIVE AND ASKED THE TEAM TO WAIT OUTSIDE. THE TEAM THEN WENT INTO THE TOWN AND ATTEMPTED TO TALK TO THE LOCALS. THEY WERE FAR MORE UNCOOPERATIVE THAN EVER BEFORE. THERE IS AN INCREASED NUMBER OF RPA IN THE TOWN. THERE ARE NOW APPROXIMATELY A COY(+). THE TEAM THEN MOVED INTO THE TOWN TO TALK TO THE LOCALS. AGAIN THEY MET WITH MORE SILENCE. THE LOCALS SEEMED TO BE QUITE SCARED TO TALK TO THE MILOBS. LATER THEY GAVE LIFT TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO STATED THAT THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 3-5 ARRESTS IN RWAMATAMU PER DAY AND THEY ARE DONE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF SOME PEOPLE FROM KIGALI. APPARENTLY THE PEOPLE ARRIVE AND DETAIL WHO IS TO BE ARRESTED. THE MAJORITY OF THESE ARRESTS HAPPEN ON THE COASTAL AREAS. THE RPA FEEL THAT THESE PEOPLE ARE AIDING THE RAIDERS FROM IJWI ISLAND. IN AND AROUND THIS COMMUNE IS ALSO A GENERAL FEELING OF APPREHENSION OF THE ANNIVERSARY OF 06 APR. THE PEOPLE FEEL THAT THERE WILL BE AN ATTACK FROM IJWI AND IN ADDITION TO THAT THE RPA WILL KILL SOME PEOPLE TO MARK THIS DATE.

C. A THIRD PATROL WENT TO MABUGA(GR2463) AND GISHYITA (GR2062) TO INVESTIGATE SOME ALLEGED MURDERS. DISCUSSING THESE PROBLEMS WITH THE LOCAL OFFICIALS WAS UNSUPRISINGLY FRUITLESS; HOWEVER, UPON TALKING TO SOME LOCALS THIS INFORMATION WAS GAINED. THERE WERE TWO INDIVIDUALS KILLED IN THE MABUGA PRISON. THEY WERE BEATEN WITH HAMMERS AND HACKED WITH MACHETES. THE DATE OF THIS INCIDENT WAS NOT ASCERTAINED(APPROX 07 MAR). LAST NIGHT THE LOCAL RPA PLATOON WAS PAID AND WENT ON A DRINKING SPREE WHICH INVOLVED GOING AROUND THE TOWN TELLING EVERYONE THAT THEY INTENDED TO KILL PEOPLE IN THE AREA.

FOUR RETURNEES(FAMILY OF TWO ADULTS AND TWO CHILDREN) FROM 59/60 WERE ARRESTED AND BEATEN IN MABUGA. TO DATE ONLY THE CHILDREN HAVE BEEN RELEASED.

ARRESTS, HARASSMENT AND BEATINGS IS BECOMING MUCH MORE COMMONPLACE IN THIS AREA, AND THE PEOPLE ARE BECOMING RESTLESS AND ARE TALKING OF LEAVING.

D. MALAWI COY ARRIVED TODAY TO RELIEVE SENBAT. THEY ARE OCCUPYING THE SAME AREAS AS SENBAT UNTIL THEIR LOCATION IN KIBUYE CAN BE CONSTRUCTED.

E. THE INCOMING SECTOR COMMANDER, CB9, WENT TO MWENDO AND BWAKIRA COMMUNE. HE VISITED THE CLINIC IN KALINDA AND THE SENBAT TROOP LOCATION IN BIRAMBO.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. THE MEASLES OUTBREAK IN KALINDA PREVIOUSLY REPORTED AS APPEARING TO CALM DOWN HAS KILLED FOUR CHILDREN LAST NIGHT. CONTRARY TO PREVIOUS REPORTS THE BREAKOUT IS STILL VERY MUCH PRESENT.

THOUGH BOUGEMESTRES DENIED TO CONFIRM THE SAME, HOWEVER, BOUGEMESTRE OF MABANZA MENTIONED THAT A FEW PERSONS WHO WERE INVOLVED IN THE GENOCIDE HAVE BEEN APPREHENDED BY THE LOCALS THEMSELVES AND HANDED OVER TO THE COMMUNE. AS A RESULT OF THIS 80 SUSPECTS ARE PRESENTLY DETAINED IN THE PRISON OF MABANZA AS OF DATE. THE INITIAL HEARING HAS BEEN COMPLETED BY THE BOUGEMESTRE AND HE IS AWAITING TRANSPORT TO MOVE THEM TO KIBUYE. LOCAL SOURCES HAVE CONFIRMED RISE IN THE NUMBER OF ARREST IN KIRAMBO 3565 AND ONE SUCH ARREST OF TWO PERSONS ON 21 FEB 95 HAS BEEN WITNESSED BY THEM. LOCALS ARE REPORTEDLY APPREHENSIVE OF MORE ARRESTS TO FOLLOW. WHEN BOUGEMESTRE WAS CONTACTED FOR FURTHER INFORMATION HE COMPLAINED THAT THE NGO'S WERE ONLY CONCERNED WITH ARRESTS AND PRISONERS WELFARE AND WERE NEGLECTING THE ACTUAL NEEDS OF THE PEOPLE WHICH NEEDS TO BE ADDRESSED BY ALL THE ORGANISATIONS. THE MILOB TM WAS NOT PERMITTED TO VISIT THE PRISON.

B. THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE COMMUNES OF KIBUYE AND MABANZA WAS FOUND TO BE CALM WITH IMPROVED MARKET ACTIVITIES AND ABOUT 50% ATTENDANCE IN THE SCHOOLS. THE HEALTH CENTRES AT RUBENGERA 3374 AND MUSHUBATI 3379 ARE FUNCTIONING WELL EXCEPT WATER SITUATION. WATER PIPELINES REQUIRE MAJOR REPAIRS. ABOUT 40% PEOPLE WHO FLED DURING THE WAR HAVE REPORTEDLY RETURNED TO THEIR HOMES IN MABANZA COMMUNE .

C. ANOTHER TEAM ACCOMPANIED THE HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM TO GIAHANGO 2560 WHERE SITUATION WAS FOUND TO BE CALM BUT TENSE REPORTEDLY OWING TO THE HARASSMENT CAUSED BY THE RPA. THE LOCALS REPORTED THAT THE WHEREABOUTS OF SEVEN PEOPLE ARRESTED IN THE MONTH OF JAN 95 WAS STILL NOT KNOWN TO THEM. THEY COULD NOT GIVE THE EXACT DATE OF ARREST.

REMARKS: ALTHOUGH IT MAY SEEM LAVISH AND EXCESSIVE IT WOULD BE MUCH MORE EFFICIENT AND PRODUCTIVE TO PATROL THESE SHORE REGIONS WITH BOATS. THIS CONCEPT IS NOT NEW AND HAS BEEN RAISED BY OTHERS. WE ARE AWARE THAT THE BOATS ARE IN THE COUNTRY AND IF THEY ARE NOT BEING USED BY OTHERS CONSTRUCTIVELY THIS SECTOR COULD UTILIZE THEM PROPERLY. THIS WOULD SAVE A LOT OF WEAR ON THE VEHICLES (OF WHICH WE HAVE VERY FEW) AND ENABLE US TO ACTUALLY GET TO THE AREAS INVOLVED (SOME CAN NOT BE REACHED BY ROAD).

ONCE THEY REALISED UNAMIR WAS THERE THE BEATINGS STOPPED. FURTHER INVESTIGATION AS TO WHAT WAS HAPPENING WAS USELESS.

B. A SECOND PATROL WENT TO GACUMBI (GR 1050). EN ROUTE THEY STOPPED IN TO SEE THE BOURGEMEISTER IN RWAMATAMU. THERE THEY WERE KINDLY GIVEN A GUIDE BY THE BOUREMEISTER. GATHERED INFORMATION REGARDING A SHOOTING IN THIS AREA. IT APPEARS THE RPA HAVE BEEN WORKING TOGETHER WITH THE LOCALS AND HAVE FORMED A TYPE OF CIVIL DEFENCE GROUP. THIS GROUP PATROLS WITH THE RPA NIGHTLY. ON THE NIGHT OF 7 FEB 95 ONE OF THE LOCAL LEADERS, NAMED NKEJEMUTO, OF GITSIMBWE (GR 1052) PATROL GROUP DECIDED HE WOULD GO OUT ON PATROL IN SPITE OF BEING TOLD NOT TO DO SO BY THE RPA. FOR THIS ACTION HE WAS SHOT, POINT BLANK, IN THE CHEST. THIS SHOOTING HAS BEEN CONFIRMED BY TWO LOCALS AND THE HEALTH CENTRE STAFF. THIS INDIVIDUAL IS ALIVE AND WAS EVACUATED TO KIBUYE HOSPITAL.

AT THIS HEALTH CENTRE INFORMATION WAS GATHERED REGARDING AN ATTACK BY BANDITS IN THE AREA OF KILIMBI (GR 1049). THIS INCIDENT HAPPENED AT 240300 JAN 95. AN INDIVIDUAL, NAMED BYUMUHORE, WAS SHOT IN THE HAND AND EVACUATED TO CYANGUGU. HIS THREE COWS WERE TAKEN AWAY. CONSEQUENTLY THE RPA HAS ESTABLISHED AN RPA SENTRY POST IN THIS LOCATION.

IN ADDITION, ONE LOCAL WAS ARRESTED ON 3 FEB IN NYABINAGA FOR STEALING LIVESTOCK DURING THE GENOCIDE. HE REFUSED TO REPAY THE COST OF THE STOLEN LIVESTOCK AND WAS ARRESTED FOR THEFT. HE IS NOW BEING HELD IN THE TRANSIT PRISON IN RWAMATAMU.
