MEDICAL SUPPORT

1. Medical Treatment INDBATT treated 240 medical and 30 dental patients.

ENGINEERING SUPPORT

2. FORCE ENGINEER COMPANY

- a. Deployed one dozer for transit camp in CYANGUGU from 12 Feb to 14 Feb 96.

~~b. Deployed one dozer and two dumpers to UNHCR and MILOBS in GISENYI on 13 and 14 Feb 96.~~

- c. Deployed one excavator cum digger and two dumpers for RPA in KIGALI from 12 to 14 Feb 96.

- d. Provided three vehicles to RPA for transporting food stuff from KIGALI to BUTARE on 13 Feb 96.

- e. Provided one vehicle to ARDEC for transporting wood and bricks from 12 to 17 Feb 96.

- f. Provided two vehicles to Milobs in GITARAMA for transporting wood for the prefecture on 14 Feb 96.

- g. Deployed a team for erecting security fence and lighting in BUTARE prison from 12 Feb to 15 Feb 96.

- a. Provided two vehicles to RPA to transport 6 tons of rations from KIGALI to BUTARE on 12 Feb 96.

- b. Provided two vehicles to KIGALI prefecture for distribution of 4 tons of food stuff to various communes in KIGALI prefecture on 15 Feb 96.

c. Provided two vehicles to CONCERN WORLD WIDE on 14 and 17 Feb 96 for the distribution of 12 tons of blankets,beans,food stuff,cooking utensils and farming implements from KIGALI to various communes in BUTARE. Two vehicles also transported beans andfood stuff from KIGALI to Nyakabanda commune in Gitarama prefecture on 15 Feb 96.

SUBJECT: FINAL REPORT ON HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

GENERAL SITUATION

1. Although isolated infiltrations continue to occur through the borders, the overall situation in the Prefectures remains calm. However, of late there has been sporadic incidents of sabotage in the form of explosives planted to destroy a vital transformer which supplies electricity to Gisenyi brewery and a bridge on the Kayove road, and incidents of killings and armed robberies by uniformed miscreants in both Prefectures.
2. Spontaneous returnees continue to trickle in consisting mainly of 59/60 caseloads and in an attempt to reduce the congestion at Nkamira Transit Camp, UNHCR in collaboration with IOM and MINIREISO continue to transport families to their communes. Generally, the returnees are settling at Giciye (5111), Gaseke (4904), Satinsyi (5800) and Karago (4416) communes of Gisenyi Prefecture and in Ruhengeri Prefecture they are being settled at Kinigi (5341), Mukingo (5029), Nkuli (4724) and Cyeru (8035) communes.
3. The anticipated mass repatriation from Kibumba Camp has not yet occurred but is expected to take place at any time due to the presence of Zairean troops who were sent to cordon the camps. Other reports state that these soldiers are looting the refugees' properties.
4. Overall, the relationship between RPA and returnees has now improved. RPA in this area has initiated a grass-roots effort to "win hearts and minds" of the local population. Their effort centres on joint security operations, especially in those areas near the frontier to repel the infiltrators' activities.
5. On the border, the flow of humanitarian aid to Goma camps through the Gisenyi corridor still remains suspended.

OWN HAC ACTIVITIES

6. In spite of limited resources due to the termination of the current mandate, there has been great strive in humanitarian

assistance. Apart from routine help offered by NGO's, some of the services rendered through MILOBS from HAC included:

a. Jan 96

- i. Co-ordinated with HAC for the provision of a truck and a crane support for the movement of a storage container for COOPI in Gisenyi and the removal of a scrapped vehicle from the street to the junk yard.
- ii. Co-ordinated the delivery of stationery to Rambura Secondary School (4514) in Karago commune (4416).
- iii. Through the MILOBS provided escort patrols to IOM vehicles going to Kayove (2792) and Nyamyumba (2106) during transportation of returnees.

b. Feb 96

- i. Co-ordinated with Hac for the provision of two dumper trucks and a dozer support for the improvement of the road from BP4 (Mutovu 2829) to Nkamira Transit Camp.

GENERAL LIVING CONDITIONS

7. No change.

NGO'S


8. Still on alert for the anticipated massive repatriation of returnees from Zaire.

UN AGENCY

9. Maintains close co-operation with other NGO's through joint briefings and meetings and planning sessions. Also continues with the normal repatriation process.

LOCAL AUTHORITIES

10. Relations between UNAMIR and the local authorities still remain cordial and co-operative.

HUMANITARIAN WEEKLY SITREP - 12 TO 18 FEB 1996

GENERAL SITUATION

1. The situation remains stable. However, minor security incidents have continued to occur in the outlying areas of the prefectures. Despite these incidents, the security situation continues to be relatively calm.

OWN HAC ACTIVITIES

2. On 13 Feb 96 two dumper trucks reported to the transit centre to carry out improvement on the road from BP4 to Nkamira Transit Camp. The dozer in location also started to fill up the garbage pit at Gisenyi as requested.

3. A general humanitarian meeting was held on 15 Feb 96 at Gisenyi Prefecture. The meeting was attended by the local authorities, NGO's and the MILOB representative.

4. The meeting was held to discuss measures to handle anticipated massive repatriation from Kibumba Camp. The issues considered were mode of transport, provision of medical facilities, food, security, info, reception, accommodation and rehabilitation.

5. Inflow of 2 000 returnees per day is expected. Two Zairean forces have been sent to the camps. One commando force to cordon the camp to ensure no inmates leave the camp and the second force employed by UNHCR to prevent intimidation of inmates.

6. In order to facilitate the move of returnees the Zairean Govt has asked Rwanda authorities to increase the number of entry points. RPA will be responsible to provide security. One resettlement area in Mutura (3124) has been identified by COOPI and this can accommodate 500 families.

GENERAL LIVING CONDITIONS

7. a. Housing - NTR.

c. Healthcare/problems - Both MSF/MERLIN remain ready to support both Transit Camps should a sudden influx occur.

8. All NGO's continue preparations for this anticipated massive repatriation of returnees.

9. Continues with the repatriation process and preparations and co-ordination with other NGO's in readiness of the anticipated massive repatriation.

10. Relations between UNAMIR and the Local Authorities still remain cordial and co-operative.

MEETING THE MEETING was called by MINRESO to discuss the handling of the anticipated massive repatriation of Rwandan refugees from Kibumba Camp.

MEASURES anticipated and discussed were:

- 1/ Mode of Transport
- 2/ Provision of Medical facilities
- 3/ Feeding of the returnees
- 4/ Information
- 5/ Security
- 6/ Reception, accommodation, Rehabilitation.

A flow of about 2000 a day is anticipated.

So far on the Zairean side the government of Zaire has made available for this OPS two groups of military personnel to maintain order on their side. These are:

- a) A Commando force which has encircled the camp to prevent the inmates fleeing out.
- b) A special guard force, paid by the HCR which has entered the camp to prevent the operation of intimidation.

TRANSPORT.

UN HCR has a total of 173 vehicles available for the operation. 19 of these have been provided by UNAMIR for Gisenyi area.
154 of these have been provided by UN HCR for

Rwanda country.

In order to facilitate the movement, the Zairian government has asked the HCR to open up more entry points, in addition to BP1 BP2 and BP4.

It was also recalled (stated) that the Rwandan Government has asked UNAMIR to make available more vehicles, in addition of the 19, available in case of emergency.

Route from the three entry points BP2 BP4 would lead to the N'kamura camp. If full the colony (MUNDU) would take about 10.000 persons.

HEALTH.

Enough Ambulances have been requested for the question so are medicines.

The Gisenyi hospital has been earmarked for serious cases.

Feeding

Currently WFP has in stock rations for 50.000 persons, extra 22 tons of biscuits available in Gisenyi and another 20 tons at N'kamura. Further food items can be easily brought ^{down} from Kigali.



2. The Secretary read out the minutes of the last UHAAG meeting.

ITEM III - REQUESTS CONSIDERED BY UHAAG

3. **Repair of Roads Between Border Posts and Transit Camps**. MILOBS Sector 1 and UNHCR have projected the requirement of road repairs from border posts to transit camps in Kibungo and Byumba prefectures, in view of the likely influx of a large number of returnees. The roads requiring urgent attention are from Rutete border post to Dihiro transit camp (16 kms) in Kibungo prefecture and Nyagatare border to Tabagwe (3 kms) in Byumba prefecture. The Group decided that Engineers should carry out a recce of the roads and repairs may be undertaken depending on the task involved and resources available.

Action - FEO

4. **Land Levelling for Sports Field**. Kirehe Secondary School in Kibungo prefecture has requested, through MILOB Sector 1, for land levelling for a sports field. The school has recently reopened as it was earlier being used as a transit centre. The Group decided that Engineers may undertake the task as and when the dozer is available on completion of the priority tasks.

Action - FEO

5. **Repair of Generators at Nsinda Prison**. Rwandan Ministry of Justice has requested for repair of two generators at Nsinda prison. These generators were earlier installed by UNAMIR. The request was accepted and the task would be undertaken by the UNAMIR Generator Unit, as and when possible.


7. **Provision of Vehicles, Building Materials and Office Equipment.** An NGO "ATEDEC" has requested for two vehicles, a photocopier, a typewriter, three computers, and some building materials. The request was not accepted as UN HQ is yet to give out its policy on disposal of UNAMIR equipment on termination of the mission.

8. **Provision of Vehicles, Generators and Office Equipment.** Nyungwe Forest Conservation Project has requested for two Toyota Hilux pick-ups, a generator, VHF radios, a photocopier, a typewriter, two computers, refrigerators, stoves and tents. The request was not accepted as UN HQ is yet to give out its policy on disposal of UNAMIR equipment.

9. **Request for Septic Truck.** Banque Nationale du Rwanda has requested for sewage clearance by the UNAMIR septic truck. The request was not accepted due to the heavy commitment of the only available septic truck for UNAMIR tasks.

HUMANITARIAN WEEKLY SITREP - 05 TO 11 FEBRUARY 1996

GENERAL SITUATION

1. The situation remains generally calm. Nevertheless, there has been a definite increase in security related incidents during the last two weeks. This could be as a result of increased infiltrations in the recent past. The FRGF leaders may be attempting to create an unfavourable situation in the country and thus forestall the normal returnee movement and shift the focus of the international community from the refugee camps.

OWN HAC ACTIVITIES

2. a. The following requests have been made by UNHCR and IOM:
- i. A dump truck to transport gravel to improve the eroded road from MUTOVU (2829) to NKAMIRA Transit Camp. This road will be extensively used should the returnees' influx occur through Border Post 4 (MUTOVU)
 - ii. 600 m of barbed wire for the new office complex of UNHCR, Gisenyi.
 - iii. 50 m of power cable 4/16 for illumination of the IOM compound which houses the transport fleet.
- b. The septic tanks of the college transit camp are full and need to be emptied. The matter is of dire operational necessity as we expect large numbers of repatriation which could begin at any time from now. It is requested that a septic truck be made available for this purpose.

GENERAL LIVING CONDITIONS

3. a. Housing - In KIDAHO Commune (7047) 72 houses are under construction for resettlement of the Old Case Load (OCL) returnees.
- b. Education - NTR.

c. Food - WFP has confirmed of enough stocks of rations to cater for the returnees in case of the influx.

d. Healthcare/Problems - Both MSF/MERLIN are still remaining on the alert to support both transit camps should a sudden influx occur. The returnees of KINIHIRA (2896) camp in the Gishwati Forest, complained that due to lack of good water, there was a large number of gastro-intestinal problems.

4. All NGO's continue to be on the alert for the possibility of a sudden large influx.

UN AGENCY

5. Still continuing with the repatriation process and preparations and co-ordination with other NGO's in readiness for a sudden influx.

LOCAL AUTHORITIES

6. Relations between UNAMIR and the Local Authorities still remain co-operative and cordial.

2. They have requested the Milobs to provide assistance for the following :-

(a) A dump truck to transport gravel to improve certain patches on the road from Mutovu 2829 to Nkamira transit camp. This road will be extensively used if the returnees come in large numbers through BP 4.

(b) 600 m of barbed wire for the new UNHCR office complex.

(c) 50 m of power cable 4/16 for illumination of the IOM compound which houses the transport fleet.

GENERAL SITUATION

1. The situation remains stable. However, the incidents of killings and explosions have been on the increase of late in MUTURA (3123), NYAMYUMBA (2106), KAYOVE (2792) and GICIYE (5011) Communes. Despite these incidents, the security situation continues to be relatively calm as the mentioned incidents are well-known by the RPA and they are constantly modifying their tactics to contain the situation.

OWN HAC ACTIVITIES

2. On 31 Jan 96 I attended a meeting with the Sector's NGOs which was organised by UNHCR Gisenyi and the following points were discussed:

a. UNHCR Gisenyi has received unconfirmed reports from Goma that a mass influx may take place at any moment from KIBUMBA Refugees' Camp. Unconfirmed reports stated that about 250 Zairean soldiers have been deployed in Kibumba for this forced repatriation process.

b. Following these unconfirmed reports, the meeting discussed how the assistance could be provided to returnees in case of forced repatriation from Zaire.

c. However, there is yet no confirmed reports regarding the arrival of Zairean soldiers to Kibumba Camp. Another report states a meeting is being arranged with local authorities of Kibumba at the KINSHASA Capital on 06 Feb 96.

3. On 02 Feb 96 the Sect HQ received a request to provide assistance to Heli transport the Bishop of Gisenyi and Kibuye to Kigali as he was advised not to travel by road due to his heart problem. This was co-ordinated by the Sector with positive assistance from Air Ops and NORMED.

GENERAL LIVING CONDITIONS

6. Continues with the repatriation process and preparations and co-ordination with other NGO's in readiness for a sudden influx.
