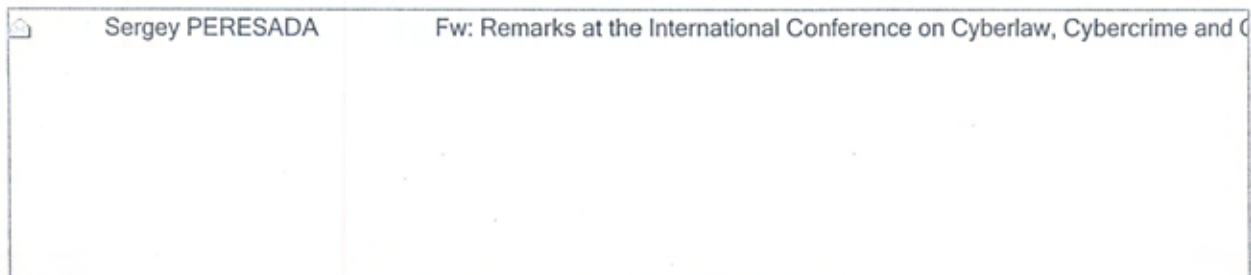

Dear Mattia,

After having consulted with relevant colleagues who deal with the issues cybercrime and cybersecurity as well as with UNODC Regional Office in Delhi, we would recommend not to designate a representative or to send a message, but just to politely decline the invitation for the following reasons.

Mr. Duggal is known to UNODC. He is a private lawyer who runs these conferences. Although, according to the latest conference report, he has the ability to attract important and international personalities, such as then SG of International Telecommunications Union, but that does not make his conference valuable in terms of outcomes.

On several occasions colleagues who deal with cybercrime/cybersecurity issues have requested Mr. Duggal to provide UNODC with impact reports of the outcomes of his Conferences. So far no response was received.

UNODC also gets invited to his annual Conferences in November. However they traditionally coincide with our own high-level conferences, meetings and events. This was also more than once indicated to Mr. Duggal.
