
Excellency,



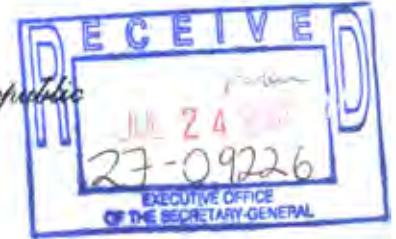

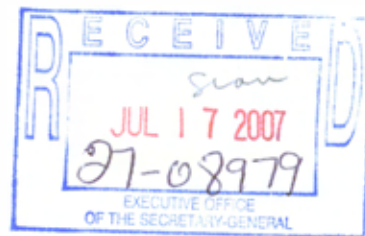
