(1) RPA THE SECT CDR IS STILL ATTEMPTING TO CONTACT LT-COL KAYONGA, THE RPA BDE CDR. A LETTER HAS BEEN FORWARDED TO THE RPA BDE CDR INVITING HIM FOR DINNER THIS TIME, TO INCREASE THE ODDS OF MEETING HIM SHORTLY (TUESDAY NIGHT).

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIESa. SECTOR HQ.

(1) A SPECIAL TEAM WAS SENT TO NTONGWE COMMUNE (9057) TO ATTEND THE BOURGMESTRE'S MARRIAGE CEREMONY, WITH A VIEW TO IMPROVE OUR RELATIONS WITH AUTHORITIES. THE CEREMONY WAS PRESIDED BY THE BOURGMESTRE OF TAMBWE COMMUNE (7653). APPROXIMATELY 300 PEOPLE ATTENDED THE CEREMONY. THERE WERE APPROXIMATELY FOUR TO FIVE BOURGMESTRES, INCLUDING THE GITARAMA PREFET. THE BOURGMESTRE WAS VERY PLEASED TO SEE THAT MILOBS WERE ATTENDING.

(2) KABGAYI HOSPITAL HAD REQUESTED THIS SECTOR TO ASSIST IN THE TRANSFER OF A PRISONER TO MASANGO COMMUNE BECAUSE THE PRISONER'S TREATMENT HAD BEEN COMPLETED. THE HOSPITAL HAD MADE A FORMAL REQUEST TO LT-COL KAYONGA, THE RPA BDE CDR, BUT NO WRITTEN AUTHORITY FROM THE RPA HAS YET TO BE OBTAINED TO MOVE BACK THE PRISONER TO MASANGO COMMUNE. ACCORDINGLY, A TEAM WILL CONTACT THE RPA ON THIS ISSUE.

b. TEAMS

(1) THE FIRST MILOB TEAM VISITED MUSHUBATI COMMUNE (6970) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM. THE TEAM MET THE BOURGMESTRE AT HIS RESIDENCE AND FOUND HIM VERY COOPERATIVE. HE CONFIRMED THE ARRIVAL OF 70 RETURNEES SINCE 25 AUG 95 AND NO ARRESTS HAVE OCCURRED AMONG THEM. THEY REQUIRE FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS. ACCORDING TO THE TEAM, THE LOCALS' REACTION TOWARDS RETURNEES IS POSITIVE.

(2) THE TEAM ALSO VISITED KARAMA SECTOR (6972) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM. HOWEVER, THERE ARE SHORTAGES OF FOOD AND WATER.

(3) THE TEAM ALSO VISITED GATIKABISI SECTOR (6672) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM EXCEPT FOR BANDITRY ACTIVITIES.

(4) THE SECOND TEAM VISITED BULINGA COMMUNE (6679) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM EVEN THOUGH THERE IS SOME BANDITRY ACTIVITY RELATED TO CATTLE THEFT. THE TEAM ALSO REPORTED THE ARRIVAL OF 30 RETURNEES IN THE COMMUNE. THE TEAM CONFIRMED THAT THERE ARE 40 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT, DOWN FROM THE 46 WHICH WERE REPORTED ON 16 AUG 95.

(5) THE TEAM ALSO VISITED BULINGA SECTOR (6279) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM. HOWEVER, BANDITRY ACTIVITY IS COMMON. THE TEAM ALSO CONFIRMED THAT NO ARRESTS HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN THE SECTOR IN THE LAST MONTH.

(6) THE TEAM ALSO VISITED MUSENYI SECTOR (6279) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS IN PARA 5 ABOVE.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES. NTR.

5. CIVIL AFFAIRS. WE HAVE JUST RECEIVED NEW STATISTICS FOR RETURNEES AND WE CONTINUE CONFIRMING THESE NUMBERS THROUGH VISITS

TO COMMUNE OFFICES. OUR CURRENT ESTIMATION IS THAT 702 RETURNEES WOULD HAVE ARRIVED IN THE SECTOR BUT WE CAN ONLY CONFIRM 499 SO FAR. THE BREAKDOWN BY COMMUNE IS AVAILABLE IF YOU NEED IT.

8. MISCELLANEOUS.

a. THERE HAS BEEN AN ACUTE SHORTAGE OF WATER IN THE GITARAMA PREFECTURE FOR THE LAST THREE DAYS. THIS HQ INTENDS TO SEND A MILOB TEAM TO ELECTROGAZ OF GITARAMA ON 4 SEPT TO ASCERTAIN THE CAUSE AND THE LIKELY DURATION OF THIS SHORTAGE, INCLUDING ANY ASSISTANCE THEY MAY REQUIRE.

b. THE MALICOY LEFT BEHIND A VEHICLE (UNAMIR 25865) UNIMOG EXPOSED TO VANDALISM BY LOCALS. THIS MORNING WE HAD TO INTERVENE TO PREVENT CHILDREN FROM PUSHING IT AROUND. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THIS IS A BROKEN VEHICLE AND WE CANNOT TOW IT INSIDE OUR COMPOUND WHERE IT WOULD BE MORE SECURE. WE REQUEST A TOWING AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, IF MALICOY HAS NOT ORDERED IT ALREADY.

c. THE SECT CDR WILL BE IN KIGALI FROM 1000 HRS TO 1700 HRS TOMORROW. THE ACTING SECT CDR DURING THIS PERIOD WILL BE MAJOR G. DUBE.

4. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITY:

a. KM-3 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN BUTAMWA COMMUNE. THEY FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. TEAM WAS INFORMED BY LOCALS AT KABAHIKA GR 781039 THAT AT AROUND 020800HRS 4 CIVILIANS WITH A UNAMIR VEHICLE WERE SEEN REMOVING ALL UN SIGNS FROM THE VEHICLE INCLUDING THE NUMBER PLATE. THE LOCALS REPORTED THE ISSUE TO RPA AUTHORITIES AT BUTAMWA WHO FOUND THE CULPRITS GONE HEADING TOWARDS KIGALI. THEY ONLY FOUND A TOOTH BRUSH WHICH THEY USED TO REMOVE THE PAINT. THE PLACE IS VERY CLOSE TO MR KARIMUNDIMWE STANLAS AND MR FRASIE MUKANKUSI'S HOUSES. DETAILS OF THE MAKE OF THE VEHICLE COULD NOT BE OBTAINED BUT BELIEVED TO BE THE NORMAL TOYOTA 4X4.

b. KM-6 PERFORMED A ROUTINE PTL IN KANZENZE COMMUNE. THEY FOUND THE AREA CALM AND QUIET. PTL VISITED UNHCR REP AT NYAMATA, NYAMATA HEALTH CENTRE AND NYAMATA ORPHANAGE 1.

(i) AT NYAMATA UNHCR REP. GAVE PTL FIGURES OF RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI THROUGH THE RUTETE BORDER FROM FEBRUARY '95 TO AUGUST '95 WHICH TOTALLED TO 7,840.

(ii) AT NYAMATA HEALTH CENTRE TEAM FOUND THAT THERE ARE 50 BEDS, CUAMM PROVIDES MEDICINE, IS 1 DOCTOR AND 4 ASSISTANTS AND ABOUT 200 PATIENTS ARE TREATED DAILY. THE

ONLY PROBLEM IS THAT THE HOSPITAL CAN NOT HANDLE MATERNITY CASES DUE TO LACK OF MATERIAL AND A SPECIALIST. (iii) AT THE ORPHANAGE CUAMM PROVIDES FOOD AND MEDICINE TO THE 180 ORPHANS WHO RANGE FROM AGES OF 1 YEAR TO 18 YEARS. THERE ARE 38 STAFF WHO ARE ALSO PAID BY CUAMM. THE ONLY PROBLEMS ARE CLOTHING FOR THE ORPHANS AND ELECTRICITY SINCE THEIR GENERATOR WAS BROKEN DOWN IN MARCH '95.

5. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITY: UNICEF IS TRYING TO IMPROVE THE WATER SITUATION IN BICUMBI COMMUNE. HOSPITAL AT MUSASA COMMUNE REQUIRES URGENT ASSISTANCE ON DRUGS AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE AS ONLY THE CHURCH GOOD WISHERS ARE RUNNING THE HOSPITAL WITH VERY MINIMAL RESOURCES.

6. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS: KM 5 REPORTED THAT TEAM VISITED PRISON AT THE COMMUNE OFFICES WITH A TOTAL OF 4 ROOMS. INITIALLY EACH ROOM COULD TAKE ONLY 15-20 PEOPLE BUT NOW EACH ROOM HAS APPROXIMATELY 40 INMATES. THE LIVING CONDITIONS ARE PATHETIC AND NO MEDICAL FACILITIES. ALL INMATES ARE GENOCIDE SUSPECTS.



PTL FOUND 160 RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE AT THE COMMUNE HEADQUARTERS WHO WERE WAITING FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNSELLORS AT THAT TIME ATTENDING A MEETING AT THE HQ TO TAKE THEM TO THEIR SECTURES. 2 MEN SUSPECTED TO HAVE TAKEN PART IN THE GENOCIDE WERE BEING HELD AT THE COMMUNE OFFICES. THEY HAD RETURNED WITH THE REST OF THE RETURNEES FROM ZAIRE.
