

In the light of NATO's Partnership for Peace (PfP) initiative, courses and seminars have been conducted by the PfP Training Center/Turkey to increase confidence and cooperative efforts, contribute to friendly relations and provide qualitative education and training support to Partner Nations to reach NATO standards.

Since its inauguration in June 1998, Turkish PfP Training Center has conducted 239 courses and 9 seminars with the participation of 6,897 attendees.

One of the main activities of the PfP Training Center is annual "SILK ROAD Flag Officers Seminar". The primary aim of the Seminar is to enhance cooperation and common understanding in global issues between NATO and Partner Nations' Flag Officers and increase existing contributions to the partnership programs. 66 high level Generals/Admirals and Ambassadors took part in the Seminar last year. "SILK ROAD-2007 Flag Officers Seminar", which has the main topic of "The future of NATO's partnership programs and relations with Contact Countries (in view of the Riga Summit outcomes and roadmap to 2008 Summit)" will be conducted between 02 and 06 July 2007 in Antalya, Turkey. 147 Generals/Admirals and Ambassadors have been invited to take part in the Seminar.

The Seminar language is English and simultaneous interpretation will be only available in Russian.

There will also be a cultural tour in Antalya region in the scope of social functions of the Seminar Programme. Arrival and departure will be to/from Antalya, thus flight itinerary shall be arranged accordingly.

It will be a pleasure for us if you could participate in the Seminar and give a lecture on 05 July 2007 on "Potential for enhanced cooperation between NATO and UN to foster international peace and security" scheduled for 60 minutes including a question and answer period of 30 minutes.

You are kindly requested to inform us of your participation in the Seminar by 13 April 2007. Attached you will find the draft Seminar Programme, the list of the invited personnel, and the attendance form. Please do not hesitate to contact us for any further questions.
