 - B. NYAMASHEKE SUB-SECTOR: 14 1030B JUL: AN AIRCRAFT (BN-2 ISLANDER) OBSERVED FLYING EAST TO WEST AT 2,500 FEET AGL, FLIGHT PATH APPEARED TO BE TOWARDS KAMAEMBE SECTOR (7825). RPA TOOK NO ACTION.
 - C. BUGARAMA SUB-SECTOR: RUMOURS THAT BANDIT ELEMENTS ARE COMING TO THE AREA TO KILL DESIGNATED PEOPLE. TWO INCIDENTS IN ONE WEEK: ON WEDNESDAY (12 JUL) AT 2200B, FIVE ARMED BANDITS KILLED A MAN, HIS WIFE AND TWO CHILDREN. THE MAN KILLED WAS THE "RESPONSABLE" OF THAT CELLULE. PRIOR TO THAT, ON 06 JUL AT 2300B, FOUR ARMED BANDITS KILLED THE CONSEILLER OF MUHEHWE (8608).
 - B. **SECTOR 5:** KIVUMU AREA: FOLLOWING TWO ARMED BANDIT RAIDS, BELIEVED TO BE ORIGINATING FROM WITHIN RWANDA, THE BOURGEMESTRE OF KIVUMU HAS REQUESTED THE DEPLOYMENT OF RPA SOLDIERS TO THE AREA.

(2) GHANBATT REPORTED THAT 104 DPs ARRIVED AT BARE GR 5549 FROM BURUNDI ON 11 JUL 95.

(3) UN SECRETARY-GENERAL ACCOMPANIED BY DEFENCE MINISTER OF RWANDA AND KIBUNGO PREFECTURE VISITED NYARABUYE MASSACRE AREA GR 8459 ON 14 JUL 95. GHANBATT PROVIDED SECURITY.

(4) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE SECTOR WAS ASSESSED AS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS VISITED THE NYARABUYE CHURCH MASSACRE SITE. THE MILOB TEAM, RPA BDE CDR, LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND OTHER RPA OFFICERS WERE PRESENT.

(5) GHANBATT MED STAFF TREATED 50 LOCALS IN AOR.

(3) ONE MILOB TEAM VISITED BYAMANANA HEALTH CENTRE AND REPORTED THAT THE CLINIC AUTHORITIES REQUESTED FOR ANTIBIOTIC DRUGS, WATER PUMP, GENERATOR, AMBULANCE, LABORATORY EQUIPMENT AND BEDDINGS. THE HEALTH CENTRE AT MUGINA COMMUNE, ALSO REQUESTED FOR INFANT FOOD, PORTABLE WATER, GENERATOR, AMBULANCE AND STATIONERY.

(4) MILOBS IN KIBUYE REPORTED THAT IN THE MONTH OF JUN FOUR PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED AND ANOTHER SIX LAST WEEK FOR ALLEGEDLY PARTICIPATING IN THE GENOCIDE. THEY ARE CURRENTLY IN KIVUMU PRISON.

 - A. IN SECTOR 4C: 13 0723B: KAMEMBE: ONE UNIDENTIFIED AIRCRAFT OVERFLEW THE AREA FROM SOUTH TO NORTH.
 - B. SECTOR 5: NIGHT OF 12/13 JUL 95: RUGARAGARA (2195): REPORTS OF A FIREFIGHT BETWEEN SUSPECTED INTERHAMWE AND RPA. SOME OF THE BANDITS APPEAR TO HAVE SUCCESSFULLY ESCAPED TO ZAIRE BY BOAT FROM GASHINGAMUTWE (2099). THE CONSEILLER OF THE SECTEUR WAS SUBSEQUENTLY ARRESTED ON CHARGES OF COLLABORATION AND FAILING TO INFORM THE RPA. COMMENT: THIS AREA IS ONE OF THE SHORTEST DISTANCES TO THE GISHWATI FOREST, WHERE IT IS SUSPECTED FRFG/MILITIA HAVE PREPOSITIONED STORES AND STAGE SOME OPERATIONS.
 4. REFUGEES/IDPS. NSTR.
 5. POLITICAL. NSTR.
 6. REGIONAL. ZAIRE: PANZI AREA: INVESTIGATION INTO THE EVENTS OF 12 JUL 95 SUGGEST THAT UNHCR INITIAL REPORTING OF THE INCIDENT WAS EXAGGERATED AND MISLEADING. ALTHOUGH MILOBS CONTINUE TO PURSUE THE MATTER, INITIAL INVESTIGATION INDICATES THAT:
 - A. FIRE WAS EXCHANGED ACROSS THE BORDER;
 - B. ZAIRAN TROOPS INITIATED THE EXCHANGE AT 1100 WITH HMG. RPA BORDER UNITS RESPONDED WITH MG AND SMALL ARMS FIRE. EXCHANGE OF FIRE CONTINUED UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 12 1700B;
 - C. THREE CASUALTIES WERE CONFIRMED ON THE ZAIRAN SIDE. ALL WERE TREATED BY ICRC AT BUKAVU HOSPITAL, INFORMATION ON SURVIVAL, AGE AND GENDER WERE NOT DISCOVERED.
 - D. YESTERDAY 13 JUL 95 THE LOCAL RPA COMMANDER (MAJOR KAGAME) MET WITH A SENIOR ZAIRAN MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE TO REVIEW THE SITUATION. THE RPA POSITION REMAINED THAT THE PANZI CAMP MUST BE MOVED. THE RESULTS OF THAT MEETING ARE NOT YET KNOWN.
- COMMENT: PANZI IS KNOWN AS AN FRGF/MILITIA CAMP. ALTHOUGH

THE INCIDENT APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN SPONTANEOUS, ALARMIST REPORTING OF THE INCIDENT TO THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY COULD BE DETRIMENTAL TO REGIONAL PEACE. IT IS KNOWN THAT, ALREADY, SOME DIPLOMATIC CHANNELS HAVE INFORMED THEIR HOME GOVERNMENTS OF THE UNHCR REPORT OF 12 JUL 95 AND APPEAR TO SUGGEST A RWANDAN INITIATED ATTACK (USING HMG AND MORTARS) WHICH RESULTED IN HEAVY CASUALTIES AND INVOLVED LARGE NUMBERS OF WOMEN AND CHILDREN. THE FRGF ENJOY FEW OPERATIONAL ADVANTAGES OVER THE RPA, ONE IMPORTANT ONE IS THAT RWANDA REMAINS UNDER AN ARMS EMBARGO. IF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY WERE MISINFORMED, THEY WOULD BE MOTIVATED TO DELAY THE LIFTING OF RWANDA'S ARMS EMBARGO. ON THE OTHER HAND, IT ALSO BROUGHT ATTENTION TO THE FRGF CAMP RIGHT ON THE RWANDAN BORDER.

THE CENTRE HAS SHORTAGE OF TOOLS AND RAW MATERIALS FOR MAKING ARTIFICIAL LIMBS. THE LIST OF PRIORITIZED ITEMS WILL BE GIVEN TO MILOBS LATER. NGOS IN POSITION TO HELP SHALL BE APPROACHED BY UNAMIR. AT THE SAME LOCATION THE TEAM VISITED THE LABORATORY SCHOOL. IT HAS 12 TEACHERS, 24 STUDENTS IN FIRST AND SECOND GRADE. THEY HAVE A PROBLEM OF QUALIFIED TEACHERS TO OPEN THE THIRD AND FOURTH GRADE. SOME NGOS PROVIDED SUCH HELP IN THE PAST. THE HR INTERVIEWED THE LABORATORY SCHOOL DIRECTOR WHO SAID HIS PERSONNELS WERE AT RISK DUE TO RUMOURS OF GENOCIDE ACCUSATION.

1. OVERVIEW. THE GENERAL SITUATION REMAINED CALM EXCEPT ON SECTOR 3A WHERE HARASSMENT OF THE LOCALS BY RPA CONTINUES.
2. RPA.
 - A. SECTOR 3A: MALAWICOY REPORTS THAT RPA SOLDIERS IN FUMBA GR 2255 ARE EXTORTING MONEY FROM THE LOCALS. THOSE WHO CAN NOT OR WILL NOT PAY ARE ALLEGEDLY HARASSED AND/OR ARRESTED.
 - B. SECTOR 4C: RPA ARE REPORTED TO HAVE ENGAGED A GROUP OF MILITIA IN THE VICINITY OF CYETE GR 7618. ALTHOUGH MANY SHOTS WERE FIRED, THERE WERE NO REPORTS OF CASUALTIES.
3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 4C: AT MUGANZA GR 9106, A LOCAL WAS ROBBED OF 80,000 RWF BY BANDITS SUSPECTED OF BEING MILITIA.
4. REFUGEES/IDPS. SECTOR 5: THE FORMER TUNBATT CAMP AT MUTURA GR 3223, HAS BEEN HANDED OVER TO UNHCR FOR USE AS A TRANSIT CAMP.
5. POLITICAL. NSTR.
6. REGIONAL. SECTOR 4C: AT 0740 HOURS 10 JUL, AN UNIDENTIFIED AIRCRAFT WAS HEARD OVERFLYING THE KAMEMBE AREA GR 7823. COMMENT: IT APPEARS THAT THESE OVERFLIGHTS NO LONGER WORRY OR INTEREST THE RPA OR LOCAL AUTHORITIES. ALTHOUGH THEY APPEARED TO BE PANICKED WHEN THE AIRCRAFT WERE FIRST SIGHTED ON 16 JUN. COMMENT ENDS.
7. MISC.
 - A. THE US COUNSELLOR AND VICE COUNSELLOR HAD A MEETING SCHEDULED ON 10 JUL WITH THE PREFECT OF CYANGUGU BUT FOR SOME UNKNOWN REASON, THEY DID NOT KEEP THE APPOINTMENT. RATHER THEY VISITED KIRAMBO GR 3844 AND SPENT SOME TIME WITH THE MILOBS IN NYAMASHEKE SUB-SECTOR GR 9841.
 - B. THE NEW YORK TIMES ON 7 JUL PUBLISHED AN ARTICLE THAT A CATHOLIC PRIEST, NOW LIVING IN FRANCE, HAS BEEN UNOFFICIALLY ACCUSED OF INVOLVEMENT IN THE GENOCIDE. THE TIMES ALSO QUOTED A FRENCH MAGAZINE WHICH CLAIMS IT WILL PUBLISH THE NAMES OF A FURTHER 27 PRIESTS AND 4 NUNS WHO ALLEGEDLY PARTICIPATED IN ONE FASHION OR ANOTHER IN THE KILLINGS.

ANTIBIOTICS AND ANTIMALARIAL TABLETS. THE CENTRE RUN BY THE "ADRA" REQUESTED FOR ABOUT 50 MATTRESSES, ONE TYPEWRITER, ONE REFRIGERATOR FOR VACCINES AND ONE WEIGHING SCALE FOR CHILDREN AND ADULTS. THEY ALSO REQUESTED FOR 10 WINDOW FRAMES, 5 DOORS AND ONE BIG WATER TANK. HAC INFORMED.

1. OVERVIEW. THE SITUATION REMAINED QUIET THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SECTOR 4C WHERE INCURSIONS FROM ZAIRE AND ACTS OF BANDITRY CONTINUE.

(1) AT SHARA GR 9111 ON 8 JUL, A GROUP OF MEN, REPORTED TO BE FRGF, ROBBED A WOMAN OF 1 MILLION RWF AND OTHER EFFECTS.

(2) AT MURURU GR 7521, A MAN WAS SHOT AND WOUNDED BY UNKNOWN GUNMEN.

1. OVERVIEW. THE SITUATION REMAINED QUIET THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SECTOR 4C WHERE SEVERAL INCURSIONS FROM ZAIRE OCCURRED.

2. RPA.

A. IN SECTOR 6: THE RPA HAVE BEEN SET UP CHECKPOINTS AT VANTAGE POINTS WITHIN THE CITY. RWANDAN VEHICLES ARE SUBJECTED TO INTENSIVE SEARCHES, PRESUMABLY FOR WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION. THERE HAVE BEEN NO REPORTS THAT UN OR NGO VEHICLES ARE BEING STOPPED OR SEARCHED.

B. IN SECTOR 4C: THE RPA INTERCEPTED TWO GROUPS OF ARMED MEN REPORTEDLY COMING FROM ZAIRE. ALTHOUGH FIRE WAS EXCHANGED, NO CASUALTIES WERE CLAIMED:

(1) THE FIRST OCCURRED AT 1000 HOURS NEAR CHITE AND ALLEGEDLY INVOLVED A MILITIA GROUP; AND

(2) THE SECOND NEAR THE ZAIRE BORDER AT BURAROKA AND ALLEGEDLY INVOLVED FRGF SOLDIERS.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECTOR 4C: ETHIOBATT REPORTED THREE INCIDENTS OF BANDITRY ALLEGEDLY BY MILITIA ELEMENTS. FIVE LOCALS WERE KILLED, 12 CATTLE TAKEN AS WELL AS AN UNDETERMINED AMOUNT OF HOUSEHOLD PROPERTY AND MONEY.

5. POLITICAL. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT THE VICE PRESIDENT AND MINISTER OF DEFENCE, MGEN KAGAME TOLD REPRESENTATIVES ATTENDING THE DONOR COMMUNITY CONFERENCE THAT THE RWANDAN GOVERNMENT HAD DONE EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO FACILITATE THE VOLUNTARY RETURN OF RWANDAN REFUGEES AND TO ENSURE THEIR SECURITY UPON RETURN TO THEIR HOMES. FURTHER, HE WAS QUOTED AS SAYING THAT THERE WAS NO LONGER ANY ETHNIC ANIMOSITY AMONG RWANDAN NATIONALS DUE TO THE CORRECTIVE POLICIES UNDERTAKEN BY THE CURRENT GOVERNMENT.

1. OVERVIEW. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED TO BE CALM THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY ALTHOUGH THERE ARE REPORTS OF GENERAL FEAR AND APPREHENSION IN NYARUMBUYE, SECTOR 3A.

2. RPA. SECTOR 5: THE RPA ARE REPORTED TO HAVE MINED THEIR CHECKPOINT ASTRIDE THE RUHENGARI-GISENYI ROAD. AS WELL AT 0622 HOURS, A HAND GRENADE WAS THROWN AT A CIVILIAN TRUCK WHICH FAILED TO STOP AT THE CHECKPOINT.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. SECTOR 4C: ARMED MILITIA FROM ZAIRE ARE REPORTED TO HAVE KILLED THE ADMINISTRATOR OF MUHEHWE GR 8508 AT ABOUT 1900 HOURS 7 JUL.

(3) ON 10 JUN AGAIN IN GITABURA, A MAN WAS SEVERELY BEATEN AFTER HAVING ASKED THE BOUGERMEISTER AT A PUBLIC MEETING WHY THE MAN'S SON WAS BEATEN IN THEIR HOME IN THE MIDDLE OF THE NIGHT. ALLEGEDLY BOTH BEATINGS WERE DONE BY THE SAME GROUP.

1. OVERVIEW. THE SITUATION REMAINS GENERALLY QUIET THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN BUTARE PRAISED UNAMIR FOR THE ASSISTANCE BEING PROVIDED IN THE PREFECTURE.

2. ~~RPA. IN SECTOR 2. AN RPA COMPANY HAS DEPLOYED IN NYARABUYE~~ SECTEUR AND ESTABLISHED THREE CHECKPOINTS AT GR 845598, GR 845590 AND GR 839586. THE CHECKPOINTS ARE ALONG THE ROAD TO THE NYARABUYE CHURCH/MASSACRE SITE.

THE GOVERNMENT, PEOPLE OF RWANDA AND THE RPA QUIETLY CELEBRATED 4 JUL, THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE LIBERATION OF KIGALI, WITH PARADES, GATHERINGS, TRADITIONAL DANCING AND SPORTS COMPETITIONS. IT IS ANNOUNCED THAT THIS WILL BECOME RWANDA'S NATIONAL DAY VICE THE FORMER 1 JUL. LOCALS IN SECTOR 4A COMPLAINED OF RPA HARASSMENT AND AN AIRCRAFT OVERFLEW SECTOR 4C.

A. SECTOR 4A: LOCALS IN RWAMIKO COMMUNE GR 4914 ALLEGE THAT THEIR LIVESTOCK ARE BEING SEIZED BY RPA SOLDIERS ACCOMPANYING TUTSI CIVILIANS FROM BUTARE. THE CIVILIANS IDENTIFY CATTLE WHICH THEY CLAIM TO OWN AND THEN THE SOLDIERS SEIZE THE ANIMALS. THERE IS NO APPEAL OR HOPE OF RECOVERY OF THE ANIMALS TAKEN.

B. SECTOR 3B LOCALS IN GISHYITA COMMUNE CLAIM THAT ON 2 JUL, RPA SOLDIERS SHOT 14 PEOPLE FROM MARA SECTEUR GR 2068 WHILE ATTEMPTING TO FLEE TO ZAIRE BY BOAT. THE SHOOTING TOOK PLACE AT GISORO GR 1868. SEVEN OF THE VICTIMS ARE REPORTED BURIED AND THE REMAINING SEVEN ARE MISSING. THE BOAT HAS BEEN SEIZED BY THE RPA.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. BUKAVU ZAIRE: AN AIRCRAFT BEARING THE RWANDAN FLAG ON ITS TAIL WAS SEEN PARKED AT THE BUKAVU AIRPORT. THE AIRCRAFT WAS IDENTIFIED AS A R235 GUERRIER; A TYPE FLOWN BY THE FORMER GOVERNMENT FORCES.

1. OVERVIEW. SECTOR 5 IS BECOMING INCREASINGLY ACTIVE WITH INCURSIONS, SABOTAGE AND INCREASED RPA PRESENCE IN THE VOLCANIC PARK AREA. THE REMAINDER OF THE COUNTRY CONTINUED TO BE RELATIVELY PEACEFUL.

2. RPA. RPA HAVE INCREASED IN ALL WESTERN BORDER AREAS, ESPECIALLY IN SECTOR 5 AS OF LATE.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

A. IN SECTOR 5.

(1) CONCERNING THE ELECTROGAZ INCIDENT REPORTED YESTERDAY AT GISENYI, INVESTIGATION HAS DETERMINED THAT THE ACTUAL LOCATION OF THE INCIDENT WAS THE ELECTROGAZ WATER TREATMENT PLANT IN RUBAVU COMMUNE GR 210135. TWO NIGHT WATCHMEN WERE KILLED BY KNIVES AND EXPLOSIVE CHARGES WERE DELIBERATELY SET. THE MOTOR OF THE WATER PURIFICATION PUMP WAS DAMAGED WHILE THE MAIN POWER JUNCTION BOX OF THE PLANT WAS UNDAMAGED WHEN THE ATTACHED CHARGE FAILED TO EXPLODE. THE WATER PLANT IS STILL OPERATIONAL BUT AT A REDUCED CAPACITY.

(2) THERE IS AN UNCONFIRMED REPORT THAT 25 FRGF SOLDIERS LANDED BY BOAT AT KAYOVE GR 2093 AND THAT A BOAT CONTAINING MINES AND GRENADES HAD BEEN FOUND IN THE GENERAL AREA. TWO MEMBERS OF THE GROUP WERE APPREHENDED IN MUTURA GR 3223 FOLLOWING AN EXCHANGE OF FIRE WITH THE RPA. THE REMAINDER OF THE GROUP IS ALLEGED TO BE HIDING IN THE GISHWATI FOREST WHERE THEY MAY HAVE JOINED ANOTHER GROUP IN HIDING. THIS REPORT IS UNDER INVESTIGATION. COMMENT: THIS MAY BE THE SAME ARREST REPORTED BY SECTOR 3A ON 27 JUN AS HAVING OCCURRED ON 26 JUN AND ON 29 JUN, A LANDING ON 24 JUN. IN THESE REPORTS AN UNSPECIFIED NUMBER OF FRGF HAD INFILTRATED KAYOVE COMMUNE AT GR 2792 BY BOAT, LEFT A QUANTITY OF GRENADES AND MINES IN THEIR BOAT(S) AND TWO MEMBERS WERE CAPTURED.

(3) COMMENT: THE ACT OF SABOTAGE AND A LANDING IN FORCE BY THE FRGF MAY BE THE BEGINNING OF A CAMPAIGN TO DESTABILIZE THE CURRENT GOVERNMENT BY THE FRGF AND ITS MILITIA.

MOTOR OF THE WATER PURIFICATION PUMP WAS DAMAGED IN THE EXPLOSION. ANOTHER EXPLOSIVE ATTACHED TO MAIN JUNCTION BOX OF THE PLANT FAILED TO IGNITE. WATER PURIFICATION PLANT IS STILL OPERATIONAL AT A REDUCED CAPACITY. **COMMENT:** IT IS ASSESSED THAT THE EXPLOSIONS MAY BE PART OF A CAMPAIGN OF DESTABILISATION OF GOVT FORCES BY FRGF THROUGH THE USE OF TERROR AND SABOTAGE. INVESTIGATIONS STILL IN PROGRESS.

(3) MILOBS PATROL TO THE KARAGO COMMUNE (GR 4516) REPORTED THE RELUCTANCE OF LOCALS TO SPEAK TO THEM DUE TO THE FEAR OF RPA RETRIBUTION. THEY ALSO COMPLAINED THAT THEY WERE BEING NEGLECTED BY THE GOVT BECAUSE THEY HAD SUPPORTED THE PREVIOUS GVT.


