A. SECTOR HQ. THE SLOGO PAID A FAMILIARIZATION VISIT TO ASSESS THE LOGISTICS SITUATION IN THE SECTOR. HE WAS BRIEFED BY BOTH THE SECTOR CMD AND THE LOG OFFR. HE STRESSED THE NEED TO RETURN ALL NON-ESSENTIAL STORES ON CHARGE TO THE SECTOR TO THE APPROPRIATE QUARTERS.

B. TEAMS.

(1) ONE TEAM VISITED NYAKABANDA COMMUNE (6596) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION AS CALM. A FAMILY CONSISTING OF FOUR RETURNEES ARRIVED FROM ZAIRE ON 18 JAN 96. THERE ARE 96 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT OUT OF WHICH 67 WERE ARRESTED FOR SUSPECTED GENOCIDE.

(2) THE SECOND TEAM VISITED MWENDO COMMUNE (4559) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION TO BE CALM. 52 RETURNEES HAVE SO FAR ARRIVED SINCE SEP 95. OUT OF THEM 17 HAVE BEEN ARRESTED FOR TAKING PART IN GENOCIDE. (THERE HAVE

(A) THE RPA BDE MEMBERS JOINED HANDS WITH THE LOCALS AT THE STADIUM CELEBRATING THE AIDS DAY CAMPAIGN. THE CROWD WAS ESTIMATED AT 8 000 PEOPLE.

(B) AN RPA COMPANY COMMANDER AND A SERGEANT PARTICIPATED IN THE HELIPATROL AND WERE VERY COOPERATIVE.

(2) FRFC. NTR.(3) OTHERS. NTR.3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

A. SECTOR HQ. THE SECT CD ~~1~~ ATTENDED THE AIDS CAMPAIGN AND WENT ON A HELIPATROL.

B. TEAMS

(1) ONE TEAM VISITED COMMUNE BULINGA (6679) INCLUDING SECTORS RUGENDABALI (6685), GASAVE (6582), BULINGA (6679),

UN RESTRICTED

MUSENYI (6679), REMERA (6380) AND NYARUTOVU (6381). THE SITUATION IS REPORTED AS CALM, EXCEPT FOR COW LIFTING ON 25 NOV 95. THERE ARE INDICATIONS THAT THE THIEVES MAY BE FROM MUSHUBATI COMMUNE.

(2) AS THE BOURGMESTRE AND HIS ASSISTANT JOINED THE AIDS FUNCTION AT GITARAMA STADIUM, THE TEAM LEARNT FROM THE SECRETARY THAT 2 RETURNEES ARRIVED ON 28 NOV FROM TANZANIA. CACHOT FIGURES 80 (72/17 NOV 95) GENOCIDE 71.

(3) IN GASAVE SECTOR, THE COUNSELLOR REQUESTS SUPPORT FOR REPAIRING THE WATER LINES.

(4) IN NYARUTOVU SECTOR, THE BRIDGE (630 806) IS BROKEN AND DIFFICULT TO BE CROSSED.

(5) THE SECOND TEAM VISITED NTONGWE (9057) AND MURAMA (6749) BY HELICOPTER IN NTONGWE COMMUNE. THE BOURGMESTRE (FORMER MUGINA BOURGMESTRE WHO WAS RELIEVED OF HIS DUTIES BECAUSE HE HAD BEEN INVOLVED IN A MURDER AFFAIR) GAVE A POSITIVE PICTURE OF HIS COMMUNE EVEN THOUGH HE HAS 469 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT. HE EXPLAINS THE RECENT WAVE OF ARRESTS BECAUSE OF A CHAIN REACTION OF ACCUSATIONS. HE REFUSED SOME OF THE STATISTICS THAT WERE ACTUALLY GIVEN BY THE IPJ. THE TEAM DID NOT GET A POSITIVE FEELING THAT THIS BOURGMESTRE TELLS THE TRUTH, ALL THE TRUTH, NOTHING BUT THE TRUTH.

(6) IN MURAMA, NEITHER THE BOURGMESTRE NOR THE RFA WERE AVAILABLE. AN RPA NCO ESCORTED US TO THE COMMUNE CACHOT WHICH CONTAINS 340 PEOPLE IN ONE ROOM. THESE DETENTION CONDITIONS ARE THE PROOF THAT THE HUMAN BODY IS A VERY RESILIENT MACHINE. A THIRTEEN YEAR OLD BOY WAS SPOTTED IN THIS INFERNO AND THE CASE WILL BE HANDED OVER TO HR OFFICERS. THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES WERE INFORMED THAT NO PRISONERS WILL TRANSFERRED TO THE GITARAMA PRISON (THEY HAD ASKED TO MOVE 150 OF THEM).

A. THE RECCE OF THE WORK TO BE DONE AT THE GITARAMA PRISON BY INDBATT ENGINEERS HAS BEEN DELAYED TO MONDAY 4 DEC 95 AT 1000 HRS.

B. AS REQUESTED IN OUR LAST TWO SITREPS, 95 CMSG IS REQUESTED

UN RESTRICTED

TO PROVIDE A CRANE (THE ONE ON THEIR WRECKER COULD SUFFICE) FOR THE MOVEMENT OF A 1400 KG GENERATOR WITHIN THE SCHOOL COMPOUND OF GATAGARA (7046). A RECCEE THROUGH THIS HQ WOULD BE ADVISABLE.

5. CIVIL AFFAIRS. AS PER THE LATEST INFORMATION, THE TOTAL NUMBER OF RETURNEES SINCE 26 AUG 95 IN SECTOR 1B IS 1507, BUT WE HAVE ONLY CONFIRMED 1301 SO FAR. THE BREAKDOWN BY COMMUNES HAS BEEN SENT SEPARATELY AS PART OF THE WEEKLY REPORT.

9. MISCELLANEOUS

A. 95 CMSG IS REQUESTED TO RECCE THE SITE WHERE THE MASANGO D6 CATERPILLAR IS (534 558). OUR INITIAL RECCE IS THAT THE RECOVERY DOES NOT PRESENT PARTICULAR DIFFICULTIES. ITS MOVEMENT TO KIBUYE, HOWEVER, COULD BE A REAL CHALLENGE. THE LETTER SIGNED BY COMMANDER SECTOR 5C (DATED 1 DEC 95) INCLUDED THE REQUEST MADE BY THE KIBUYE PREFET WHO NEEDS THIS CATERPILLAR IN KIBUYE. HIS REQUEST SEEMS TO IMPLY THAT UNAMIR WILL ALSO FIX THE CATERPILLAR.

B. A REPLY IS REQUESTED ON THIS SECTOR'S REQUEST DATED 23 NOV 95 (IN DISCUSSION WITH DCMO) TO HAVE AN ARMED SECTION AT THE PETIT SEMINAIRE FOR THE TURBULENT DAYS OF A POSSIBLE WITHDRAWAL.

10. SECTOR COMMANDER'S ASSESSMENT. THE COMMUNE CACHOT OVERCROWDING IS BECOMING A PROBLEM OF EVEN LARGER MAGNITUDE THAN THE GITARAMA PRISON. I VISITED TODAY TWO OF THESE CACHOTS WHICH TOGETHER HOLD ALMOST 800 PRISONERS. THEY DO NOT HAVE THE VISIBILITY OF THE GITARAMA PRISON AND THEREFORE RECEIVE MUCH LESS SUPPORT FROM NGOs. THERE ARE FOUR OR FIVE OF THESE TIME BOMBS IN SECTOR 1B, NAMELY NTONGWE, MURAMA, RUNDA,

MASANGO AND MUGINA. THE CIVILIAN AUTHORITIES KEEP ON ARRESTING PEOPLE DURING WEEKDAYS AND THE RPA "TAKES THE SLACK" DURING WEEK-ENDS. AT OUR LEVEL, WE ARE ATTEMPTING TO EXPLAIN TO THEM THAT THE ARRESTS HAVE TO BE DELAYED SO THAT THE DETENTION SYSTEM CAN ORGANIZE ITSELF OR SO THAT THE JUSTICE SYSTEM CAN START ITS WORK. THIS IS TO NO AVAIL. IT WOULD BE APPRECIATED IF A PARALLEL NEGOTIATION WOULD HAPPEN AT YOUR LEVEL.

(1) ONE TEAM VISITED THE COMMUNES OF MUGINA 9267 AND RUNDA 9882 REPORTED THE SITUATION TO BE CALM. EIGHT (8) PERSONS OUT OF WHICH 05 ARE CONNECTED WITH GENOCIDE, WERE ARRESTED IN MUGINA COMMUNE DURING THE LAST WEEK. THE TOTAL NO OF PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT HAS NOW BEEN INCREASED TO 326 OUT OF WHICH 21 ARE WOMEN.

(2) THE SECOND TEAM VISITED BWAKIRA COMMUNE (5161) AND REPORTED THE SITUATION TO BE CALM. THERE ARE 60 PRISONERS IN THE COMMUNE CACHOT INCLUDING ONE WOMAN. OUT OF THEM, 59 HAVE BEEN ARRESTED FOR TAKING PART IN GENOCIDE. ONLY FOUR RETURNEES SO FAR HAVE ARRIVED IN THE

COMMUNE IN THIS MONTH.





CARITAS (READ KARCAYI DIOCESE) IS LAUNCHING A PROJECT TO BUILD A ROOF THAT WILL COVER THE CENTER AREA OF THAT CENTRAL YARD. THIS IS ONE OF THE REASONS WHY THESE LITTLE HOUSES WERE DISMANTLED. INTERESTINGLY, THESE LITTLE HOUSES HAVE STARTED TO APPEAR IN THE NEW PART. THIS IS A WAY FOR THE INMATES TO "MARK" THEIR VITAL SPACES. THE PRISON AUTHORITIES DO NOT LIKE THEM BECAUSE OF THE POTENTIAL CONCEALMENT AREA AND ALSO BECAUSE SOME OF THEM ARE AGAINST THE OUTSIDE WALL AND REPRESENT AN EVASION THREAT. THERE ARE 6351 INMATES, INCLUDING 219 WOMEN AND EXCLUDING 32 INFANTS. THE ICRC CENSUS IS STILL AT THE PROJECT STAGE. THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT THE OVERALL DETENTION CONDITIONS ARE FAR BETTER THERE THAN IN ANY OF THE 17 GITARAMA COMMUNE CACHOTS. THE RUSH TO TRANSFER

NUMEROUS ATTEMPTS WERE MADE TO CONVINCE UNAMIR CIVILIAN AUTHORITIES NOT TO REMOVE THE 100 KW GENERATOR WITHOUT PRIOR NEGOTIATIONS WITH KABGAYI AUTHORITIES. IN TERMS OF A "LESSON LEARNT", ESPECIALLY THAT SUCH A SITUATION COULD OCCUR AGAIN IN THE UPCOMING PULL OUT PHASE, SOME STEPS HAVE TO BE DEVELOPED TO COORDINATE THE "PICKING UP" OF UNAMIR PROPERTY. THE FSO, WHOM I VISITED IN BUTARE TODAY, FOUND OUT ONLY YESTERDAY THAT THIS ACTION WAS ABOUT TO TAKE PLACE. MY LOGISTIC OFFICER WAS INFORMED THIS MORNING THAT A TEAM WAS ON ITS WAY WITH AN ARMED ESCORT TO PICK UP THE GENERATOR. SO THE FIRST PHASE TODAY WAS TO CONVINCE UNAMIR CIVILIAN AUTHORITIES TO AT LEAST DELAY THE PICK UP SO THAT THE KABGAYI AUTHORITIES COULD BE WARNED ON WHATEVER ACTION UNAMIR WANTED TO DO (REPAIR, REPLACE OR REMOVE) BUT THIS WAS TO NO AVAIL. IN THE FUTURE, IT IS REQUESTED THAT PRIOR CONSULTATION BE DONE BETWEEN UNAMIR CIVILIAN AUTHORITIES AND BENEFICIARIES OF EQUIPMENT ON LOAN. 
