Have reasons to suspect materials purchased by congolese government may fall in hands of third party. Captain Molongya head of ANC delegation here left Usumbura unexpectedly early hours this morning to be flown to Shangugu by two Belgian individuals. Exact purpose of trip to Shangugu not known but from general discussions with MR NISSE feel UN intervention necessary to ensure road material arrives safely. At the moment sixty percent of convoy at Uvira awaiting rest of material for marshalling and eventual despatch to Bukavu sometime monday. Complete convoy will consist to seventy jeeps 34 loaded trucks and one car. Recommend Malaysians at Uvira Bukavu and at point where road enters ~~Emk~~ Rwanda border be warned of situation and requested to patrol and - or escort convoy throughout journey.
