FAMILY MEMBERS WERE GIVEN TO THE PATROL.

SUSPECTED INTERHAMWE ENTERED BUTAKA SECTOR 3120. ONE OF THEM WAS APPREHENDED BY THE RPA. IN KABATWA SECTOR 3327 RUMARANUONI CELLULE 3327 THE RPA CLASHED WITH SOME INFILTRATORS ON 02/03 NI NOV. HOWEVER NO ONE WAS APPREHENDED. THE INFILTRATORS ARE FORCIBLY DEPRIVING THE LOCALS OF CATTLE AND FOOD. THE TEAM ALSO NOTICED THAT THE LOCALS ARE VERY APPREHENSIVE ABOUT TALKING TO MILOBS IN THE PRESENCE OF THE RPA.

THE NGO COMMUNITY AT GOMA HAVE RESTRICTED THEIR ACTIVITY AFTER THE LATEST MINE INCIDENTS. HOWEVER THERE IS PROGRESS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CERTAIN DECISIONS OF THE TRIPARTITE MEETING IN THAT AN AGREEMENT HAS BEEN REACHED TO PERMIT VISITS TO THE REFUGEE CAMPS IN ZAIRE TO BRIEF THEM ABOUT THE FAVOURABLE SIT IN THE COUNTRY AND THE PREFECTURE. THE TEAM LEARNT OF ARRESTS OF LOCALS FROM NYAGASOZI 5501 AND MUHARORO 5700 CELLULES OF HINDIRO SECTOR 5701 OF SATINSYI COMMUNE. SOME OF THESE PERSONS ARE NOT HANDED OVER TO THE GENDAMERIE BUT DETAINED IN THE HOUSES OF

THE HEADMAN / RESPONSIBLE. THE RPA IS ALSO INDULGING IN TAKING AWAY HOUSEHOLD EFFECTS FROM THE HOUSES OF THE LOCALS. THE DETAILS OF THE ARRESTS INCLUDING NAMES OF THOSE ARRESTED WILL BE HANDED OVER TO HUMAN RIGHTS FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION. THERE HAS BEEN NO CASE OF MINE INCIDENT AFTER THE LAST ONE TWO WEEKS AGO. IN BUSUMBA SECTOR (2727) THERE WERE REPORTS OF AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE ON THE NIGHT 01/02 NOVEMBER. THE PATROL WAS UNABLE TO DETERMINE HOW MANY CASUALTIES OR NATURE OF THE FIREFIGHT. IN THE MUHANDA SECTOR (2420) ON 1 NOV 95 A MAN NAMED BAGAYI WAS ARRESTED AND PUT INTO THE GISENYI PRISON. ANOTHER MAN NAMED JYABO WAS KILLED OUTRIGHT BY THE RPA WHEN HE RAN FROM SOLDIERS, LOCALS

TOLD THE PATROL THE MAN WAS MAD. IN THE MURARA SECTOR (2015) LOCALS REPORT THAT SINCE 15 OCT THERE HAS BEEN AN INCREASE IN THE PRESENCE OF ARMED PEOPLE IN UNIFORM WHO STEAL FROM THEM.

(2) ONE TEAM CONDUCTED A HELI PATROL INTO THE AREA OF KIBILIRA. OVER ALL THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED AS CALM. HOWEVER ON THE NIGHT OF 31 OCT IT WAS REPORTED THAT FOUR SUSPECTED INTERHAMWE ROBBED A MALE LOCAL OF 133,000 FRANCS. THE LOCAL WAS SHOT IN THE ARM AND IS PRESENTLY IN THE KIBILIRA HOSPITAL. THE LOCALS HOWEVER REPORTED THAT ON MONDAY 30 OCT 95 A MAN BY THE NAME RUKIRA WAS ARRESTED BY THE RPA IN NYABIRASI SECTOR (2705) AND IS SUSPECTED TO BE AN INTERAHAMWE WHO PARTICIPATED IN LAST YEAR'S GENOCIDE. THE MAN IS BEING HELD IN KANAMA COMMUNE PRISON. THE TEAM ALSO REPORTED THAT THE LOCALS INTERACT VERY WELL WITH THE NEWLY DEPLOYED RPA IN THE AREA.

(2) ANOTHER TEAM ON B1 PATROL TO KAREBA (4224) GASESERO (3925) AND KABATWA (3228) IN THE MUTURA COMMUNE (3223)

REPORTED THE SECURITY SITUATION AS CALM IN THE AREA. THE TEAM HOWEVER REPORTED THAT ON THE NIGHT OF 26 OCT 95, TWO PEOPLE MR BAMENYA AND HIS SON MR HASHAKIMANA WERE ATTACKED AND SERIOUSLY INJURED BY UNKNOWN ARMED PEOPLE IN GAKARARA SECTOR (3921). THE TWO INJURED PERSONS WERE TAKEN TO RUHENGARI HOSPITAL FOR TREATMENT. IN GASESERO SECTOR (3925) THE LOCALS REPORTED THAT THEY ARE OCCASIONALLY SUBJECTED TO BEATINGS AND THEIR CATTLE STOLEN BY THE RPA. THIS MATTER WILL BE RELATED TO THE HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM IN OUR SECTOR. IN KABATWA (3228) THE TEAM WAS STOPPED AT AN RPA CHECK POINT AND TOLD THE ROAD WAS NOT SAFE AHEAD SO THEY COULD NOT PROCEED. THIS INFORMATION WILL BE VERIFIED WITH THE RPA LO TOMORROW IN THE MORNING BRIEFING.

(3) ONE TEAM WENT ON D PATROL TO KIGALI FOR ADMINISTRATION PURPOSES. NO PROBLEMS REPORTED ALONG THE ROUTE.
