SUBJ: SITREP COVERING PERIOD 251800B APR TO 261800 APR 95.

1. GEN SIT: AT KIBEHO NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE IDPS BARRICADED INSIDE SINCE THE MORNING. THE IDPS INITIALLY HAVE AGREED TO SEND 10 IDPS PER COMMUNE TO MONITOR THE SECURITY SITUATION. 5 OF THESE SHALL RETURN TO KIBEHO TO PASS ON THEIR ASSESSMENT TO THE REMAINING IDPS ALTHOUGH AT THE LAST MOMENT WHEN THE OFFICIALS OF THE GOVERNMENT CAME AND NEGOTIATED WITH THEM AGAIN, THE ABOVE PLAN COLLAPSED AND THE IDPS ARE NOW REFUSING ANY COMPROMISE. MEANWHILE 42 DEAD BODIES HAVE BEEN TAKEN OUT OF THE BUILDING AT KIBEHO. ON THE HAND UNHCR AND CIVPOL BUTARE REPORTED THAT 28 DEAD BODIES WERE FOUND IN RUSATITA PRISON GR7431 WHILE ABOUT 10 OTHERS WERE TOO WEAK EVEN TO STAND UNPRESONABLY THE DETENEES WERE BEATEN UP TO DEATH.

SEQUAL TO INTELLIGENCE REPORT RECEIVED, IT HAS BEEN RELIABLY LEARNED THAT THE RPA IS PLANNING TO INCREASE ITS PRESENCE AROUND KIBEHO CAMP SHORTLY WITH THE MOTIVE OF CLOSING DOWN THE CAMP FORCIBLY, CONSEQUENCE UPON THIS UNPRECEDENTED DEVELOPMENT THE CPMT'S BUTARE AND GIKONGORO WERE TASKED TO INCREASE PRESENCE GRADUALLY IN KIBEHO BY CONSTANT PATROLLING AND MONITORING ACTIVITIES WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT FROM 1800H ON 27 FEB 95 TO 0800 HRS ON 02 MAR 95 WITH A VIEW TO MONITORING THE SITUATION.

FROM 27 FEB 95 TO 02 MAR 95 THE CPMT BUTARE AND GIKONGORO WERE IN KIBEHO AND CONDUCTED PATROLS, MONITORING, SURVEILLANCE AND INTELLIGENCE GATHERING IN THE CAMP. DURING THE EXERCISE THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT ON SUNDAY 26 FEB 95 THERE WAS DISTURBANCE OF PUBLIC PEACE AND LOCAL ASSEMBLY IN THE CAMP BY THE IDP'S WHICH LED TO THE SHOOTING OF 3 DP'S TO DEATH BY THE RPA. THE DECEASED INCLUDE - KAMBANA TOFIL 'M' MUKABAGANWA CHRISTINE F AND HELILIMANA SAMUEL 'M'. THE TEAM WAS INFORMED THAT WHAT BROUGHT ABOUT THE SHOOTING WAS THAT SOME RPA SOLDIERS LED BY LT KAMANDANA WANTED TO ARREST 2 FORMER RWANDAS GOVT. FORCES (RGF) ONE NDAMIMANA ABOBOVKAR FORMALLY WITH COMMUNAL POLICE AND KUBISMANA JAKUES A FORMER SOLDIER WHOM THEY STRONGLY SUSPECTED TO HAVE PARTICIPATED DURING APRIL/MAY 1994 GENOCIDE AND ARE ALSO THE ONES COMMITTING CRIMES IN AND OUTSIDE THE CAMP. BASED ON THIS ALLEGATION THEY WOULD WANT THE SUSPECTS TO BE ARRESTED AND BE TAKEN TO THEIR CAMP, BUT THE ZAMBATT PLATOON COMDR DIRECTED THAT THE RPA SHOULD FOLLOW THE UN REGULATION, THEY SHOULD CHANNEL THEIR COMPLAINT THROUGH THE NORMAL CHANNEL, THE PLATOON COMMANDER CPT N FRANCIS DETAILED THIS PLATOON SGT WHO INVITED THE 02 SUSPECTS AND BROUGHT THEM TO THE PLATOON BASE. BUT THE RPA INSISTED THAT THEY HAVE RECEIVED AN ORDER FROM THEIR CO THAT THEY MUST GO WITH THE SUSPECTS IN THIS PROCESS THE DP'S BECAME ANNOYED AND CORDONE-OFF THE PLATOON BASE AND REQUESTED FOR THE RELEASE OF THEIR COLLEAGUES AND ALSO REQUESTED THAT THEY DON'T WANT TO SEE THE PRESENCE OF THE RPA IN THE AREA ANY LONGER SUBSEQUENTLY THE DP'S STARTED STONING THE RPA AND SAT FIRE ALONG THE ROAD TO BUTARE. THE TEAM ALSO MONITORED THE MOVEMENTED THE DP'S FROM CHENIKA AND RWIMOKO CAMPS BACK TO KIBEHO WHICH LED TO THE ERECTION OF MORE NEW TENTS ALSO SOME OF THE DP'S INTERVIEWED SAID THAT THEY WILL NEVER COME BACK THEIR COMMUNES FOR FEAR OF BEING ARRESTED BY THE RPA. THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE CAMP IS CALM. SEQUEL TO INTENSIVE PATROL BEING CONDUCTED BY THE ZAMBATT PLATOON. IN THE CAMP.
