Further to our letter 7434 of August 16, 1973, we would like to raise again the question of the transportation costs for equipment delivery.

The decision of the Bulgarian authorities to bear the transportation costs for delivery of the equipment envisaged under the projects included in the Country Programme is aiming at the more efficient utilization of the funds under our country IPF.

In this connection it is considered that there exist the possibilities to include the transportation costs for equipment delivery as government counterpart contribution thus releasing some amounts to cover the various needs for the programme implementation.

The procedure of charging the transportation expenses as government counterpart contribution will not in any way cause difficulties to the Executing Agencies. They will be requested only not to include the transportation costs in the price of equipment.






