1. This visit to UNOSOM is in relation with the offer of Germany to provide a contingent of 1 500 all ranks for UNOSOM.
2. The contingent could include logistic units.
3. The German offer has to be confirmed and could depend on the mandate of UNOSOM II.
4. It is so far the only proposal including self-sufficient logistic units. That is why we believe this preparatory technical visit is of the greatest importance.
5. The two officers do not need any assistance for their travel to Somalia.
