c. Weapons and firearms which had been observed in the camps in the last few months have disappeared. ( It is possible that they have already been brought to RWANDA and are hidden in arms caches somewhere in the East of KIBUNGO Prefecture. )

d. UNHCR in coordination with RW and TZ authorities will be in charge of this operation.

e. UNHCR will request assistance from UNAMIR at high level.

f. Concept of operation :-

(i) During the first week, three times three thousand could be handled. Out of these only two thousand will be for KIBUNGO Prefecture and the majority of the remaining will return to BYUMBA Prefecture.

(ii) From the second week onwards, five times three thousand or even more could be taken.

(iii) Returnees will be taken directly from BUKOBA 8737 Border Post to RUSUMO Commune office. There the security check and the initial administration will take place. ( At this place the first arrests are expected. )

(iv) From there returnees will be taken to NYAKARAMBI TRANSIT CAMP for medical check, vaccination and provision of rations and personal articles. There they will stay overnight.

(v) Most of the returnees will be transferred on the day after to their home communes. Further arrests are expected there.

g. Additional Information.

(i) Transport: All transport will be provided by UNHCR and IOM.

(ii) During this operation UNHCR will cease all activities for returnees coming from ZAIRE to either GISENYI or CYANGUGU.


